<b>Alex Martin</b>	Senior at Beauregard High School; released to go back to sports but lymph nodes still swollen; he will go back in January & if the swelling has not gone down, they will do another biopsy; <b>pray specifically for the swelling to go down so they don't have to do another biopsy</b> Stephanie Tidwell
