

Glen & Connie Elmore	Test showed cancer spread to lymph nodes and his hip
Bubba & LuCile Gibson	LuCile will have foot surgery Mar. 3rd; it will be outpatient, she will be in a boot for a while, family members will be with her as needed. As a byproduct to aneurysm surgery, Bubba experienced damage to his lower body control, specifically basic functions of standing & walking, not paralysis but strength & mobility were impacted. He is working hard at Spain Rehab at UAB & is making good progress daily. He will not be good as new but hopes to function in a mainstream manner going forward. Shelia Gullede	Doing pretty well, sleeping less during the day, still very weak, working to build up her strength
Cale Hanks	Fracture in elbow; no cast, just a sling but he has to be super careful for a while, if all goes well for a couple of weeks, no surgery will be needed; looking at 6 weeks recovery time and PT for his shoulder & elbow
Pete Harris	PSA was down to .03 at most recent check-up; going to take the pills another 3 months & he will get one more shot in 3 months, then the doctor may take him off the meds
Christy Harrison	has cirrhosis, probably caused from treatments for leishmaniasis and chemo, not a candidate for liver transplant, will do an EGD (Mar. 1st) every 4 weeks to hopefully prevent another bleed; oncologist wanted to start chemo but agreed she could do scans (Feb. 28th) before her next appt. Mar. 2nd and results would determine their decision; spots were smaller at scan before holidays
Gayle Hawkins	sinus surgery, back to ENT Tuesday, still lots of infection, inserted more antibiotic salve and gave her another round of antibiotics, back in 2 weeks 2/28/23; if not a lot better will put her to sleep just to clean it out
Bill & Jan Holland	Jan has Health issues, good days & bad days
Evelyn Huey	Neck pain, high BP issues; x-rays and a CT scan with contrast showed bone spurs & compression @ the top of her neck, can't have surgery due to damage to lungs caused by COVID, doing PT twice a week; got another nerve block last Wednesday, doing better
Brandon Jones	Shoulder surgery; PT is going well, he is a little sore but that's expected
