<b>Bob Daniel</b>	Back pain, Diagnosis is degenerative disc disease so no magic pill; home from rehab due to pain preventing him from doing what he needed to; saw Dr. Jones said osteoporosis is so bad his bones keep cracking; basically pain management is all they can do; <b>another issue we saw a hematologist about last Friday don't know anything yet; Bob's pain is much better and he is trying to walk more to gain strength; has help with his baths and that really helps</b>
<b>Glen &amp; Connie Elmore</b>	Test showed cancer spread to lymph nodes and hip
<b>Bubba &amp; LuCile Gibson</b>	LuCile had foot surgery Mar. 3 <sup>rd</sup> ; she will be in a boot for a while. As a byproduct to aneurysm surgery, Bubba experienced damage to his lower body control, specifically basic functions of standing & walking, not paralysis but strength & mobility were impacted. He is working hard at Spain Rehab at UAB & is making good progress daily. He will not be good as new but hopes to function in a mainstream manner going forward. Your continued prayerful support is appreciated; <b>LuCile is home but foot is extremely painful; daughter went home Monday; she needs meals twice a week Lucy Little is taking care of this. LuCile gets her stitches out Monday, March 13<sup>th</sup> Bubba walked a good ways Monday; doctors met Tuesday to discuss his discharge date; He has a discharge date of no later than March 23<sup>rd</sup> could be sooner.</b>
<b>Shelia Gulledege</b>	Doing pretty well, sleeping less during the day, still very weak, working to build up her strength
<b>Cale Hanks</b>	Fracture in elbow; no cast, just a sling but he has to be super careful for a while, if all goes well for a couple of weeks, no surgery will be needed; looking at 6 weeks recovery time and PT for his shoulder & elbow
<b>Pete Harris</b>	PSA was down to .03 at most recent check-up; going to take the pills another 3 months & he will get one more shot in 3 months, then the doctor may take him off the meds
<b>Christy Harrison</b>	has cirrhosis, probably caused from treatments for leishmaniasis and chemo, not a candidate for liver transplant; <b>EGD showed various varices that are swollen, he banded some; liver enzymes were down a little, gastroenterologist sending her to a liver specialist; scans showed cancer is still suppressed, she will do another scan with contrast in 3 mo. then back to oncologist</b>
<b>Gayle Hawkins</b>	sinus surgery; <b>she still has a lot of sinus problems after her surgery</b>
<b>Bill &amp; Jan Holland</b>	Jan has Health issues, good days & bad days; <b>Bill has COVID again</b>
<b>Evelyn Huey</b>	Neck pain, high BP issues; x-rays and a CT scan with contrast showed bone spurs & compression @ the top of her neck, can't have surgery due to damage to lungs caused by COVID, doing PT twice a week; got another nerve block, doing better
<b>Mike Kilgore</b>	Continue prayers; latest blood work good
<b>Lucy Little</b>	Thyroid biopsy & CT scan on her lungs, additional blood work yesterday; please pray for good results; first thyroid biopsy inconclusive, had another one, still waiting on results
<b>Frances Long</b>	Fell, staples in head and fractured hip but no surgery necessary; recovering at home, PT 3 times a week & a helper that comes in 3 times a week to help with baths, etc., making progress, getting around pretty good inside, PT is working with her on her steps

<b>Margaret Matthews</b>	congestive heart failure; doing ok
<b>Meg Melton</b>	had to go back to doctor last week, checked for pneumonia & blood levels, she is anemic so put her back on iron and 2 antibiotics, still struggling, got hearing aids yesterday; <b>better but not well; pain in the chest area that Mrs. Meg says feel like pleurisy but x-rays didn't show anything</b>
<b>Jimmy Peoples</b>	Carpal tunnel surgery & rebuilding joint Thursday Mar. 2 <sup>nd</sup> ; rehab will begin Friday; Brucile is struggling; <b>put screw in his thumb and did something to the joint but they are unsure what; wearing a hand splint that is molded to fit his hand so he can't move his thumb at all will wear it for 4-6 weeks; will go back to Birmingham doctors March 16<sup>th</sup>; can't drive so pray for Brucile</b>
<b>Whitney Rice</b>	Ruptured abscess in colon; surgery to remove part of colon went well, home recovering; back March 22 <sup>nd</sup> to discuss reconnection; <b>prayers for continued healing</b>
<b>Danna Roach</b>	Fell & broke her hip, surgery to put in rods went well; a week of rehab at Russell then home; last x-ray showed a new fracture in thigh, recovery will be slower, but this explains excessive pain, please pray the bone will heal; pain is much better; <b>she goes back to doctor March 23<sup>rd</sup> to see what they are going to do about the 2<sup>nd</sup> fracture</b>
<b>James Smith</b>	experiencing sciatic pain & numbness in his legs & feet. PT is helping some, numbness is a little better Pray for a meeting room/space that would provide a place for people in the new development off Hwy. 63 to begin meeting until a church could be built, and a church planter to work with them

<b>Lawrence Benson (Laurie)</b>	Doug Reid's brother-in-law in the hospital in GA, had to be resuscitated twice; <b>in rehab for another week, progressing to walker</b>
<b>Glenda Brock</b>	Heart problems & health issues Jerry Hughes' sister
<b>Janet Bryant</b>	Mission Trip to Israel March 4 <sup>th</sup> - 11 <sup>th</sup> 5-hour layover in Miami, prayers for traveling safety
<b>Billy &amp; Betty Bullard</b>	Billy is not doing well Jim Cahoon
<b>Pat Cutts</b>	Many health issues; has 3-4 fractures of her spine; procedure to put cement in these areas did not help; a little better but still trying to get over the RSV, coughing still an issue, can't talk much without losing her breath, symptoms of scleroderma which are hard to keep at bay; still struggling Jean Gravette's cousin
<b>Randall Davis</b>	<b>Pray for his family he passed away Friday Holly's Uncle</b>

<b>Sophie Grace Doane</b>	Premature; was in prenatal unit for 6 months, home now; has trac to help breathing & a feeding tube; <b>doing well but trac may have to be in for 3 years</b> ; celebrated her first birthday Joel R.'s great-niece
<b>Mildred East</b>	Cancer in other breast; surgery went well; oncologist thinks prognosis is good, NO CHEMO, finished her radiation 27 <sup>th</sup> ; pray she has minimal side effects with the new estrogen lowering drug Jean Gravette's sister-in-law
<b>Peggy Foreman</b>	Lizz Spencer's Mom EAMC ICU kidney failure; coded & was put on a vent, she is off the ventilator & all tubes have been removed, the swelling in her throat literally went down overnight, Home with Home Health & PT, trying to get stronger & better
<b>Edith Fuller</b>	<b>Pray for her family; her funeral service Saturday at 10:00am at Dadeville First United Methodist Church</b>
<b>Shelia Fuller</b>	Still doing chemo even though she is in remission Holly's sister-in-law
<b>Virginia Fuller</b>	Another TIA week before last, wearing heart monitor for a month, more tests coming up
<b>Kristie Garduno</b>	Breast cancer, mastectomy, back at work but it's rough; still doing infusions; have to redo reconstruction surgery Mar. 21 <sup>st</sup> due to a hole under her arm; she will have to be out of work 6 weeks
<b>Baby Garner Graham (Patrick &amp; Hollin)</b>	glowing review from doctor, vastly improved after hyperbaric oxygen therapy: <b>positive feedback from PT, ENT, Ophthalmologist &amp; Neurologist. He will continue several therapies over the next several months. It will still be several more months before we know if there will be any lasting effects but PTL he may be totally fine with more time</b> Max Graham's Grandson
<b>Justin Gilstrap</b>	11 yr. old recovering from 3 dog attack while riding bike, missing 70% of scalp, one ear, & has lacerations & staples; he has had more than 10 surgeries since the attack happened; <b>skin graft on his head is perfect, got to go home Tuesday</b> Jerry McGukin
<b>Tom Hall</b>	Scheduled for kidney transplant and got COVID Nov. 5 <sup>th</sup> , must test negative before they can proceed, finally tested negative, pre-op March 2 <sup>nd</sup> , Surgery will be March 8 <sup>th</sup> , Praying for successful surgeries for Tom and his donor; <b>surgery for the donor, Jason, went great; kidney on way to Vanderbilt should be there by 2:30; Tom has checked into the hospital</b> Jenny Hall's son
<b>Charles Harmon</b>	Cancer has returned; it is very aggressive Jane Kile's brother
<b>Edith Hathcock</b>	<b>87 &amp; lives independently, fell Tuesday around 3pm &amp; her brother found her at noon on the floor. She hit her head &amp; could not get up so she was on the floor for over 20 hours. Severe UTI, Tests &amp; x-rays at ER in Charlotte; in hospital through the weekend then transferred to assisted living/nursing home; pray she accepts she needs help</b> Jeff's mother

<b>Jean Henderson</b>	Debbie Langley's Mother shingles are drying up and the pain is almost gone; doing better
<b>Donna Hornsby</b>	Shannon Dark's mom; cancer; <b>PET scan showed cancer is no better but no worse, she will start radiation soon to help relieve her back pain</b> ; radiation has been bad for her bottom teeth, she will need a lot of dental work; please pray for her daughter Shannon as she helps care for her
<b>Jessica Hudson</b>	Cosby's daughter, still out of remission; started infusions every 2 weeks
<b>Gene Huff</b>	heart procedure to replace a valve was cancelled due to bleeding around pacemaker; pacemaker was removed for the 3 <sup>rd</sup> time due to complications with infection & bleeding; called in a plastic surgeon to try to get it deeper (under the muscle); plan to replace it and do the procedure in about 3 weeks, home recovering

<b>Jessica Jones (Bo &amp; Sharon Jones)</b>	Cervical cancer; surgery went well, best possible news from labs, cancer is grade 1A2-contained, oncologist is 95% sure he got it all, planning hysterectomy soon after she is healed from initial surgery Lizz Spencer
<b>Katie Kennedy</b>	Glen Elmore's youngest daughter; had a stroke: doing much better; back at work; saw cardiologist Jan. 9 <sup>th</sup> ; heart monitor did not show anything abnormal; had a TEE Feb. 13 <sup>th</sup> <b>scheduled for surgery March 17<sup>th</sup></b>
<b>Carol Kuykendall</b>	Spot discovered on lung; biopsy showed cancer; doing ok; taking chemo pill & shots; <b>NO cancer in breast and cancer in lung is much smaller!!!</b> Charlie's Mom
<b>Dewayne Ledbetter</b>	Holly's cousin's son 45 years old hit by a car, making progress; home from rehab
<b>Preston Lutley</b>	<b>Having migraines; has an appointment for an MRI Wednesday in Birmingham</b>
<b>Laura Miller (Stephen)</b>	Cancer; MD Anderson has proposed: surgery in Atlanta February 20 <sup>th</sup> went well, removed all the lymph nodes but one because it had grown between 2 blood vessels and doctor was afraid removing it would cause loss of movement in that arm, he is going to reach out to MD Anderson on appropriate action, now we wait; pray for guidance for the doctors, strength & comfort for Laura & Stephen & healing for Laura; 4 ½ weeks after surgery back to MD Anderson for 6 ½ weeks of targeted radiation; then if needed, which hopefully it won't be, a chemo that is in clinical trial Jean Miller's daughter-in-law
<b>Krista McGukin</b>	Has had uterine cancer; nodules at the bottom of her lungs have not changed since the last scan; oncologist is sending her to a gastrointestinal doctor, something is going on with her intestines; <b>had breast MRI Monday; won't know results for awhile</b>
<b>Frank &amp; Roseanne Modugno</b>	<b>Roseanne's heart surgery is temporarily postponed, consulting with another team of surgeons</b>
<b>Shelley Moore</b>	Stage 3 non-small cell lung cancer (Adenocarcinoma), hopefully last chemo was Feb. 13 <sup>th</sup> ; <b>CT showed tumor has shrunk, pray the Lord will direct them to choose the right surgeon</b> ; she is supposed to have surgery to remove left lung in the next 1-2 months Debbie Thompson's friend
<b>Benford &amp; Judy Morgan</b>	Jerry Hughes neighbors need knee replacement but health prevents surgery
<b>Thad Pate</b>	Diagnosed with cancer in his mouth, <b>12-hour surgery March 8<sup>th</sup>; will also do reconstruction surgery at this time; will try to leave enough bone for him to have implants</b> ; will have radiation after surgery; PET Scan found an aneurysm in his aorta; they are going to watch the aneurysm and check it every 6 months; Bea Pate
