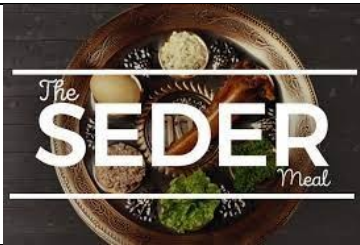

<b>Bob Daniel</b>	<b>Diagnosed with multiple myeloma; bone marrow test today</b>
<b>Belinda Daugherty</b>	<p>CT of chest was normal; allergist said she is allergic to grass &amp; dust mites, <b>scan of sinuses was clear, diagnosed with "silent reflux". Treating her with meds for 3 months then back for follow up</b></p> <p><b>Jaime Farmer</b> (daughter) gall bladder symptoms, scan was negative, <b>still hurting but working, gastroenterologist is sending her for an EGD on Friday &amp; a HIDA scan next Wednesday to rule out gastric ulcer &amp; gallbladder issues</b></p>
<b>Glen &amp; Connie Elmore</b>	Test showed cancer spread to lymph nodes and hip
<b>Bill Francis</b>	having heart issues; heart cath last Thursday showed 2 blockages of 100% and 2 that can be helped with a stent; he is not a candidate for open heart surgery due to his health & age; <b>did great, he got 2 balloons &amp; 1 stent, he is a bit stronger &amp; will do rehab for 12 weeks</b>
<b>Lucy Fuller</b>	diagnosed with auto-immune disease, 2 meds she has been on not working, doctor is still trying to get approval from insurance for infusions
<b>Bubba &amp; LuCile Gibson</b>	LuCile had foot surgery Mar. 3 <sup>rd</sup> ; she will be in a boot for a while. As a byproduct to aneurysm surgery, Bubba experienced damage to his lower body control, specifically basic functions of standing & walking, not paralysis but strength & mobility; <b>Bubba is home &amp; they are both doing pretty good</b>
<b>Eleanor Gilbert Family</b>	her uncle (Bill Gunter) passed away from pancreatic cancer
<b>Shelia Gullede</b>	Doing pretty well, sleeping less during the day, still very weak, working to build up her strength
<b>Cale Hanks</b>	Fracture in elbow; looking at 6 weeks recovery time and PT for his shoulder & elbow; great report at the doctor, there is new bone growth & the gap between his bone & growth plate is closing, he is officially allowed to go without his sling & start using his arm some; back to doctor in 3 weeks from 3/17/23
<b>Pete Harris</b>	PSA was down to .03 at most recent check-up; going to take the pills another 3 months & he will get one more shot in 3 months, then the doctor may take him off the meds
<b>Christy Harrison</b>	has cirrhosis, probably caused from treatments for leishmaniasis and chemo, not a candidate for liver transplant; EGD showed various varices that are swollen; liver enzymes were down a little; scans showed cancer is still suppressed; oncologist did an iron infusion; <b>still waiting on appointment with liver specialist</b> (hepatologist) at UAB; will continue EGD's until she swaps doctors
<b>Robert &amp; Gayle Hawkins</b>	Gayle still fighting infection after sinus surgery; procedure to wash out sinuses went well, <b>she is better but not well, cleaned out her sinuses again Tuesday &amp; going to try a sulphur drug for a month</b>
<b>Bill &amp; Jan Holland</b>	Jan has Health issues, good days & bad days; <b>Bill</b> has COVID again; doing better finally

<b>Judy Irvin</b>	Recovering from diverticulitis, <b>not a lot better, still so weak &amp; nauseated, had phone visit with the doctor Monday, took off one med that was making her sick &amp; gave her something for nausea; started on Pedialyte Monday and she feels a little stronger</b>
<b>Herman Kile</b>	<b>Squamous cell carcinoma on his face , head, and hand; spots are healing well where they removed cancer; more surgery tomorrow</b>
<b>Mike Kilgore</b>	Continue prayers; latest blood work good
<b>Lucy Little</b>	Thyroid biopsy & CT scan on her lungs; second thyroid biopsy still inconclusive but will need surgery to remove a nodule that we pray is not malignant; has to see neurologist due to numbness in arm before surgery can be scheduled
<b>Frances Long</b>	Fell, staples in head and fractured hip but no surgery necessary; recovering at home, PT 3 times a week & a helper that comes in 3 times a week to help with baths, etc., <b>doing pretty good, walking without cane</b>
<b>Preston Lutley</b>	Having migraines; CT scan showed a spot; <b>got a great report from the doctor, diagnosed with pineal cyst in his brain but it is not malignant &amp; of no immediate concern, he is to continue his migraine meds &amp; they will keep a watch on the cyst.</b>
<b>Margaret Matthews</b>	congestive heart failure
<b>Elizabeth McGukin</b>	Dermatologist removed more spots on her leg, stitches out yesterday & it's doing better; <b>rotator cuff surgery last Friday went well, got her stitches out Monday, due to her bones being a little soft doctor wants her to wait 2 more weeks before she starts therapy</b>
<b>Meg Melton</b>	<b>admitted to LMCH Friday night with pneumonia, treating with fluids &amp; antibiotics, gave her 2 units of blood; bad night Monday with acid reflux, a few baby steps backwards today, x-rays showed a little improvement but she is still wheezing &amp; cracking</b>
<b>Jimmy Peoples</b>	Carpal tunnel surgery & rebuilding joint surgery went well; wearing a hand splint that is molded to fit his hand so he can't move his thumb, follow-up went well, stitches out but has to wear cast for 4 more weeks 3/15/23
<b>Whitney Rice</b>	Ruptured abscess in colon; surgery to remove part of colon went well, home recovering; <b>reconnection surgery Thursday April 6<sup>th</sup></b>
<b>Danna Roach</b>	Fell & broke her hip, surgery to put in rods; last x-ray showed a new fracture in thigh, great report, the bone is growing back, can add weight as tolerated
<b>James Smith</b>	Released from PT, sciatic pain & numbness in legs & feet is better but not gone  Pray for a meeting room/space that would provide a place for people in the new development off Hwy. 63 to begin meeting until a church could be built, there is lot of community interest in a church plant
<b>Karla Teel</b>	Surgical procedure to figure out why she can't get over pneumonia, not supposed to take steroids because overuse has caused a bone disease but going to try them short term; short term steroids have not helped, back to pulmonologist last Thursday, they did a CT scan last time for comparison
<b>Jason Tidwell</b>	<b>Back surgery (microdiscectomy) Tuesday April 11<sup>th</sup> , hoping it will relieve some of his pain</b>
<b>Marcia Ware</b>	Back pain & leg pain
<b>Ellen Wright</b>	got the pin out of her finger, bent at 15-degree angle; PT considered it a failed surgery; only option is to have it permanently fused with a screw, keeping joint splinted to let it heal, probably won't do surgery until Joe gets back from his next trip (April 2 <sup>th</sup> - May 15 <sup>th</sup> ) <b>epidural &amp; trigger point injections for lumbar &amp; cervical spine last Thursday, some pain relief but takes up to 2 weeks for full benefit; going to PT for her finger to get middle knuckle mobility going</b>

<b>Lawrence Benson (Laurie)</b>	Doug Reid's brother-in-law <b>continuing to get stronger, busy with rehab &amp; dialysis</b> ; his wife Laurie is getting help regularly now several times a week; resources help get him get to dialysis 3X a week, VA offering benefits

<b>Linda Cambre</b>	<b>Brain bleed, surgery this afternoon</b> Dorothy McKelvey's friend
<b>Mary Crosby</b>	87 treated for 2 infections in the hospital, doing better, moving her back to her room at St. Augustine Chris's mom
<b>Pat Cutts</b>	Many health issues; has 3-4 fractures of her spine; procedure to put cement in these areas did not help; symptoms of scleroderma which are hard to keep at bay; still struggling Jean Gravette's cousin
<b>Sophie Grace Doane</b>	Premature; was in prenatal unit for 6 months; has trac to help breathing & a feeding tube; doing well but trac may have to be in for 3 years; celebrated her first birthday Joel R.'s great-niece
<b>Mildred East</b>	Cancer in other breast; surgery went well; oncologist thinks prognosis is good, NO CHEMO, finished her radiation 27 <sup>th</sup> ; doing good right now, pray she has minimal side effects when she starts the new estrogen lowering drug Jean Gravette's sister-in-law
<b>Dolly Flowers</b>	Linda Kilgore's sister mass between her ribs & heart, pray it's not malignant; PET scan shows the mass is most likely malignant & must come out, it is sitting next to her heart, <b>had bone biopsy Tuesday, will get results next week; please pray her bones are cancer free</b>
<b>Peggy Foreman</b>	Lizz Spencer's Mom EAMC ICU kidney failure; coded & was put on a vent, she is off the ventilator & all tubes have been removed, the swelling in her throat literally went down overnight, Home with Home Health & PT, trying to get stronger & better
<b>Shelia Fuller</b>	Still doing chemo even though she is in remission Holly's sister-in-law
<b>Virginia Fuller</b>	had another TIA, got heart monitor off, <b>MRI Friday &amp; meet with cardiologist next Wednesday to go over test results</b>
<b>Kristie Garduno</b>	Breast cancer, mastectomy; still doing infusions; redid reconstruction surgery Mar. 21 <sup>st</sup> and it went well, she will have to be out of work 6 weeks
<b>Baby Garner Graham (Patrick &amp; Hollin)</b>	<b>4 months old! Still having lots of therapy but showing good signs of improvement</b> ; will still be several more months before we know if there will be any lasting effects but PTL he may be totally fine with more time Max Graham's Grandson
<b>Tom Hall</b>	kidney transplant surgery went well, <b>all staples &amp; stent out, creatinine levels continue to come down (from 7 before surgery to 1.6), port removed Tuesday</b> Jenny Hall's son
<b>Mickey Hamby</b>	<b>Prostate cancer</b> Virginia Fuller
<b>Charles Harmon</b>	Cancer has returned; it is very aggressive Jane Kile's brother
<b>Edith Hathcock</b>	87, fell & hit her head & could not get up so she was on the floor for over 20 hours; transferred to nursing home for rehab, too weak to go home & probably should not live independently anymore, pray she will be accepting of the situation & make the best of it; still in rehab, pray she will get stronger Jeff's mother
<b>Martha Hayes</b>	Having complications since surgery to remove cyst, she aspirated & got pneumonia; <b>improving, tube out &amp; trying liquids</b> Barbara Reid's Aunt
<b>Bucky &amp; AJ Heard</b>	AJ's breast cancer is stage 1, non-aggressive and treatable; <b>lumpectomy March 24<sup>th</sup> went great, lymph nodes were clear of cancer, sent lump off for further testing, meet with oncologist</b>

<b>Allison Holbrook</b>	Brenda Hughes niece traveling OR nurse in KY in an accident, vehicle hit her & went under passenger side of her SUV; face & head hit steering wheel, has a concussion, face swollen, eyes swollen shut, getting better but needs prayer
<b>Terry Holdridge</b>	<b>had heart cath last Friday, they put in one stent in an artery that had a 90% blockage, he has 2 more with 50% blockage they will check in a year</b>
<b>Donna Hornsby</b>	Shannon Dark's mom; cancer; PET scan showed cancer is no better but no worse, she will start radiation soon to help relieve her back pain; please pray for her daughter Shannon as she helps care for her
<b>Jessica Hudson</b>	Cosby's daughter, still out of remission; finished infusions, weaning off steroids
<b>Gene Huff</b>	heart procedure to replace a valve cancelled due to bleeding around pacemaker; pacemaker removed for 3 <sup>rd</sup> time due to complications; <b>some healing but not well, antibiotics he can take are very limited, trying sulfur drug, back in a month</b> 4/4/23
<b>Ann Johnson</b>	<b>Biopsy came back no cancer, they will just keep a check on it</b> Gloria
<b>Edna Jones</b>	David's Mom COPD issues, treating with O2 & meds; doing better
<b>Jessica Jones (Bo &amp; Sharon Jones)</b>	Cervical cancer; surgery went well, cancer is grade 1A2-contained, oncologist is 95% sure he got it all, planning hysterectomy soon after she is healed from initial surgery Lizz Spencer
<b>Carol Kuykendall</b>	Spot discovered on lung; biopsy showed cancer; doing ok; taking chemo pill & shots; NO cancer in breast and cancer in lung is much smaller!!! Charlie's Mom
<b>Joshua Lanford</b>	20's PANDAS (Pediatric Autoimmune Neuropsychiatric Disorders Associated with Streptococcal Infections) diagnosed when Obsessive-compulsive disorder (OCD), tic disorder, or both suddenly appear following a strep infection Linda McGuirt
<b>Dewayne Ledbetter</b>	Holly's cousin's son 45 years old hit by a car, making progress; home from rehab
<b>Laura Miller (Stephen)</b>	3 <sup>rd</sup> round with Cancer; MD Anderson proposed: surgery: removed all lymph nodes but one, it had grown between 2 blood vessels and removing it could cause paralysis; started clinical trial chemo 3/13 at Piedmont instead of having to go back to MD Anderson, 2 weeks on & 1 week off for 2 months, then a scan; then 6 ½ weeks of targeted radiation; Jean Miller's daughter-in-law
<b>Frank &amp; Rosanne Modugno</b>	Roseanne's heart surgery went great; <b>got home Tuesday and is so grateful to be there. She needs to stay isolated for now to avoid any sickness. Please continue to pray for her recovery.</b>
<b>Shelley Moore</b>	Stage 3 non-small cell lung cancer, last chemo was Feb. 13 <sup>th</sup> , <b>had surgery to remove tumor &amp; affected lymph nodes; got a great pathology report; has some damage to left vocal cord which is affecting swallowing &amp; talking, ENT doctor did an injection to her vocal cord that will hopefully get her voice back</b> Debbie Thompson's friend (Shannon Nelson Smith - sister)
<b>Benford &amp; Judy Morgan</b>	Jerry Hughes neighbors need knee replacement but health prevents surgery
<b>Thad Pate</b>	Diagnosed with cancer in mouth, 12-hour surgery went well; removed some of his jaw bone & replaced it with bone from his arm, biopsy report showed they got all the cancer; <b>doing really well, had an appt. Tuesday to discuss radiation schedule;</b> PET Scan found an aneurysm in his aorta; they are going to watch the aneurysm and check it every 6 months Bea Pate
<b>Bryce Patten</b>	leukemia, <b>finished 2 years of chemo this month</b> , he is in remission; bringing home all A's from school, doing great June C.
<b>Baby Jackson (Cullen &amp; Lauren Peppers)</b>	Baby Jackson had a stroke during pregnancy, sent him to Montgomery, put him in a "cooling" state to keep brain from swelling and to slow body functions; <b>he is home from the hospital</b> Jennie Peoples
<b>Linda Kay Peters</b>	Gayle Hawkin's cousin has been in remission but blood work came back bad, back on chemo; had another stroke & is in rehab, not doing good
<b>Bubba Phillips</b>	Surgery on leg got infected; <b>doing good, working all day</b> Ann C nephew

<b>Sharon Phillips</b>	Jim Clark's sister back pain, had a light stroke due to BP being too low, wearing a heart monitor, <b>swallowing test tomorrow, scheduling an ablation for her back because the blocks are not controlling the pain</b>
<b>Peggy Prewett</b>	Stage 3A cancer; had double mastectomy; removed 7 lymph nodes, 5 had cancer cells; started chemo Oct 5 <sup>th</sup> ; will have to take for a year; now doing radiation in addition to chemo; has had reconstruction surgery and it went well; doing better with her chemo since they changed the dosage Linda M
