<b>Hindman's</b>	<b>Honour was released from the hospital Tuesday (RSV), she was rechecked today &amp; is doing good, Phin still feels bad &amp; is fighting off RSV, Joey has the flu and an ear infection &amp; Caleb doesn't feel good, Elizabeth is starting to feel better, please pray the flu does not spread through the house</b>
<b>Bill &amp; Jan Holland</b>	Jan diagnosed with frontal lobe dementia; still having issues from CDIF; mobility issues
<b>Brenda Hughes</b>	<b>Brenda still has a long way to go but she is doing much better, home Tuesday</b> <b>Jerry shoulder &amp; neck pain</b>
<b>Lisa Kidd</b>	Biopsy on end of thumb came back positive; surgery went well, lymph node biopsies were negative! Setback with pain, still has total numbness in left upper arm & arm pit – it's a numbness that hurts constantly, nurse said it could take quite a while for it to go away & it's possible it may never go away
<b>Lucy Little</b>	<b>flu</b>
<b>Cindy McGill</b>	Breast needle biopsy came back positive, cancer is stage 2 & very treatable; treatment plan is surgery followed by a year of chemo then radiation; first chemo Monday 30 <sup>th</sup> , went well but Wed. she had a dramatic BP drop (vagus response) which caused her to pass out & start vomiting, please pray it was a one-time thing, one med every Monday & all 3 every 3 <sup>rd</sup> Mon.; <b>recovering from Bronchitis, no treatment Monday due to low white cell count, getting better every day</b>

Linda McGuirt	rotator cuff surgery, pain is better, exercises to do at home, back in 2 weeks
Jerry McGukin	hand surgery went well even with tough tendons & hard bones, doing great, stitches out & has a splint, can't use that thumb for 21 days <small>end Nov</small>
Jimmy & Brucile Peoples	Results of biopsy showed spot on prostate, <b>finished radiation treatments;</b> <b>Brucile's</b> surgery went well, the doctor thinks the bones are strong enough to hold the hardware, he removed the collapsed disk & filled the spot with polymer, the pain should get better
Whitney Rice	Surgery for ruptured abscess in colon; complications required a 3 <sup>rd</sup> surgery 5/23, <b>surgery to do repairs will be November 28 at UAB</b> , reversal surgery 6-8 weeks after repair surgery
Karla Teel	heart disorder called SVT (heart beats super-fast); Numbness in feet degenerative nerve damage from shin to toes; lump under arm is excessive scar tissue from the dozen plus surgeries, PT is brutal but she can tell it's going to help; appt. with UAB Neuromuscular Clinic for neuropathy mid-November

Kathy Williams	Surgery went well & she can tell a difference already (overgrowth of bone on spine, they will grind it down); <b>fell out of her chair, headed to EAMC ER to get checked out;</b> <b>David</b> knee replacement November 16 <sup>th</sup>
Joe Wright	Tentative surgery scheduled for hiatal hernia Nov. 29 with heart doctor's ok, Ellen sinus infection getting better, neck & back telling her it's time for another round of injections

Shelby Deaton	Ann C's sister-in law cancer has spread to bones; on a new clinical trial, she is stable
Randy Defoe	Diagnosed with esophageal cancer, had a PET scan 28 <sup>th</sup> , waiting for results, treatments will depend on whether it is localized or has spread, feeding tube, will likely do radiation 5x a week for 7 weeks; <b>gets tired later in the week after treatments; has lost a few pounds which the doctor is not happy about, hopefully he will use the feeding tube more</b> Sonya's brother

<b>Jessica Hudson</b>	Cosby's daughter, <b>pray she stays in remission; saw Nephrologist last week &amp; all was good, will be through with heart monitor end of this week then will see cardiologist</b>
