Ed Huey	Cancer on back of tongue, finished chemo and radiation; doctor said everything looked good except the knot on his neck, if it "glows" on results, they will do surgery; cancer center released him to go back to work & he is working from home right now & doing good, PET scan 16th Huey's son
Derrick Jones & Family	(Derrick is Chief of Hackneyville Volunteer Fire Dpt.) His son died in a house fire Monday morning & he was at the fire
