<b>Bob Daniel</b>	multiple myeloma; infusions & meds weekly, PT @ RMC Thursdays; Cheryl having a lot of back pain but managing she said; Bob's immune system is so low they are discouraged from going out
<b>Betty K Dyson</b>	heart ablation, precursor to AFIB, BP meds & blood thinner & took off Celebrex; <b>moving slowly, MRI on back &amp; another on neck &amp; x-rays on feet showed severe arthritis in neck &amp; back, put her back on Celebrex &amp; feels better &amp; is moving better, epidural scheduled for Aug. 12<sup>th</sup> if she is not much improved</b>
<b>Glen &amp; Connie Elmore</b>	cancer has spread to lymph nodes and hip; MDA July 7-9, made it to Texas but appointments were cancelled due to Hurricane Beryl & power outages, did not reschedule, returned home; <b>new appt. Aug. 27-28</b>
<b>Bill &amp; Debra Francis</b>	PT 3 times a week for back & hips, cardiologist due to high BP, EKG was good, will test for more blockages; gout flare up, after shot & 2 meds, much better; <b>Debra</b> recovering from knee replacement, doing PT, still having issues with cramps, doctor prescribed muscle relaxer
<b>Vicki Griffin</b>	Fell, surgery for 7 breaks in left hand went well, had to fix with an external fixator (screws in the bones attached to an outside device), home recovering, <b>doing ok</b>
<b>Christy Harrison</b>	No Cirrhosis, No cancer, praying for Leishmaniasis to be gone too; iron level really low, had 2 infusions, waiting a few weeks before doing labs again, <b>appt. with Mockler later this month</b>
<b>Robert &amp; Gayle Hawkins</b>	Prayers for health; <b>Robert doing better; Gayle</b> severe sinus infection; culture results showed need for PICC line for specialized meds & 2 strong oral antibiotics for 42 days, <b>this is the 5<sup>th</sup> week</b> , home health comes Thursdays to change dressing & do blood work
<b>Brenda Hughes</b>	Lost sight in right eye due to stroke; watchman procedure healed as expected but did have AFIB & her BP was very high, had more fluid on her heart, doing pretty good
<b>Nancy Iacobella</b>	<b>Hip replacement July 22<sup>nd</sup> EAMC</b>
<b>Mike Jones</b>	Nuclear stress test, possible-ablation in near future, <b>ECHO July 16<sup>th</sup> ; will know the results in about a week</b>
<b>Julie Kline</b>	Lungs okay; CT scan showed significant calcium build up in arteries, <b>pulmonologist July 17<sup>th</sup>, cardiologist August 12<sup>th</sup> ; pulmonologist switch her inhaler; could be mold in her apartment after it was flooded, management will check for mold under the carpet</b>
<b>Debra Knight</b>	Torn meniscus, arthritis & a few bone spurs, <b>shot &amp; meds Monday, back in 3 weeks, if it's not better he will schedule a scope, not bad enough for a replacement</b>
<b>Frances Long</b>	Her daughter, Ellen, passed away <b>Indigo Pines Rm. 127 110 Gardner Drive Hilton Head, SC 29926</b>
<b>Cindy McGill</b>	Breast needle biopsy positive, surgery went well, a year of chemo will be finished in November; finished radiation
<b>Jimmy &amp; Brucile Peoples</b>	severe pain from hip to below knee; shot & prednisone did not work, Ortho doc (Gomez Columbus) looked at MRI, back is a mess with numerous problems, got epidural, not hurting as much, <b>another shot 17<sup>th</sup>; Brucile fell &amp; fractured kneecap, in immobilizing brace</b>
<b>Billie Nell Sanford</b>	prayers also for Harriet & Scoon as her caretakers
<b>Bill &amp; Marie Tidwell</b>	<b>doing well from open heart surgery, has neuropathy</b>
<b>Ellen Wright</b>	back surgery last Thursday went well, had a herniated disc that was grinding on a nerve, recovery going well, pain is much better, good report at follow up, has been dealing with severe headache & nausea, treated with a cocktail of

	drugs via IV but not working, <b>cervical MRI Thursday; Joe's stepdad passed away.</b>

<b>Carol Carter</b>	Carolyn Alexander's DIL's Mother brain tumor that was not malignant, had surgery, removed 90%, right leg still paralyzed, <b>doing rehab</b>

<b>Rick Cole</b>	Cancer continues to spread, good report from his tests Kile's friend

<b>Shelby Deaton</b>	Ann C's sister-in law cancer spread to bones, cancer has not grown
<b>Robert Eason</b>	Crystal Gullede's Father esophageal cancer metastasized into gastric cancer; tumors decreased by 50% after initial round of chemo, struggling with neuropathy, hoping it is a short-term side effect from one of his meds, still has swelling & still losing weight, has no feeling in fingers & toes which is very frustrating, scheduled 6-month scans
<b>Kris Eddins (Kelly)</b>	Stage 4 melanoma in lungs, esophagus & lymph nodes; started immunotherapy infusions, <b>running fever &amp; has a bad rash from infusions</b> , has lost from 187 down to 158 Betty Hamby's SIL
<b>Elaine Floyd</b>	Had Abdominal reconstruction surgery Monday at UAB, surgery went well, <b>home recovering</b>
<b>Shelia Fuller</b>	2 shots a month for cancer treatment, partial remission, COVID Holly's SIL
<b>Kristie Garduno</b>	Recovered from mastectomy, reconstruction & hysterectomy, then broke foot, not healing properly, <b>back in cast, CT scan of leg &amp; foot showed it was trying to heal</b> Sue Weldon's daughter
<b>Kellie Gilliland</b>	5 cm cyst on right ovary and a smaller one on the left; <b>gynecologist said cyst has grown 2 centimeters, surgery 18<sup>th</sup> to remove; Susan left today to go be with her for the surgery</b> Susan T.'s daughter
<b>Betty Goodman</b>	Mayor's wife Alzheimer's, good days & bad days
<b>Garner Graham (Patrick &amp; Hollin)</b>	Still doing therapy & hyperbaric oxygen therapy treatments, showing improvement, eyes look great, still some issues with the part of brain healing that controls his sight; back on seizure meds doing good Graham's Grandson

<b>Matthew Hood</b>	17 yrs. old Car accident, 50% of body burned, amputated both legs; measured for prosthetics but needs to heal first, <b>doing rehab</b> pray for all the adjustments he has to make Jeff G
<b>Jessica Hudson</b>	Cosby's daughter, still in remission, still has heart monitor, good report from Nephrologist, back in 6 months (Dec.)
<b>Ed Huey</b>	Cancer on back of tongue, finished chemo & radiation; working from home, CT scan showed cancer is gone, neuropathy, doing PT, will have another MRI & more tests Huey's son
<b>Hayes Hunter</b>	Around 10 diagnosed with leukemia, at Children's Hospital in Bham, finished first round of chemo & tolerated well, will have 4-6 months of chemo depending on how he responds to treatment; <b>needs a bone marrow transplant; pray they find a match</b> Belinda Daugherty
<b>Ronnie &amp; Gail Jones</b>	Ronnie has brain cancer deciding if treatments that will give him another 7 months are worth it; <b>not doing well</b> Marie Tidwell's sister
<b>Amber Logan</b>	major gastro issues & other related issues, can't eat solid foods & even liquids make her sick, inserted PICC line, on 24/7 feeds & blood thinners to prevent clots; had gained 4 pounds at check up
<b>Ellie Matthews</b>	<b>hand foot &amp; mouth is much better, no more bumps, tubes 19<sup>th</sup> Ann C.</b>
<b>Krista McGukin</b>	Health issues
<b>Laura Miller (Stephen)</b>	stage 4 lung cancer that has spread, stopped chemo, after clinical trial cancer has spread to 2 ribs & tumors are larger, cancer is progressing through treatment, time to try something else, putting her on a tried & true chemo, <b>first treatment tomorrow</b> , 2 more clinical trials available in next 2 months, she can switch depending on how treatment is going; <b>prognosis is not good</b> Jean M's DIL
<b>Karen Mills</b>	Breast cancer, <b>waiting on oncologist &amp; plastic surgeon to coordinate their schedules to schedule surgery</b> Belinda's niece
<b>Randy Moran (Leanne)</b>	Carotid artery surgery for 90% blockage went well, home recovering, <b>doing better each day, got staples out Monday, needs to take it easy for another week</b> Sharon Patterson's nephew
<b>Jim Murray</b>	Pacemaker, will have to replace aortic valve end of July or beginning of August, still waiting for decision on how to do procedure (carotid artery or groin) because he has an aortic aneurysm as well Whitney's Dad
<b>Kay Nix</b>	in remission, taking chemo as a precaution Holly
<b>Thad Pate</b>	Lung cancer metastasized to back; started chemo 14 <sup>th</sup> once a week, still can't work, 2 <sup>nd</sup> surgery on mouth to remove screws & metal postponed
<b>Ronnie Peach</b>	Stage 4 cancer has spread everywhere, chemo is making very sick, speech is slurred Debra Francis' brother
<b>Maddy Petite</b>	Stage 4 lung cancer metastasized to brain, 28 years old, doctors decided to forgo her 4 <sup>th</sup> round of chemo & send her to MDA (appt. July 8 <sup>th</sup> ) to discuss other treatment options, <b>Hurricane Beryl caused appt. to be cancelled, she extended her stay hoping to get answers this week</b> Tracy Robbins (Facebook Jennifer Jo: her Mom)
<b>John Phillips</b>	Cancer, diabetic on 2 shots a day, not doing well; <b>could not do stomach surgery due to his health, gave 2 mega doses of IV antibiotics &amp; will go back for 3<sup>rd</sup> dose, had AFIB but got heart back in rhythm, home last Thursday</b> Ann Clark
<b>Sharon Phillips</b>	good report from kidney doctor, heart doc appt. coming up Jim C's sister
<b>Wesley Phillips</b>	denying God, prayers for salvation Ann C's nephew
<b>Susan Price</b>	Cancer has spread to brain, <b>treatments at MDA in August</b> Nita Kendall's daughter
<b>Lillian Robbins</b>	Jim White's sister <b>nursing home</b>

<b>Warren Thomas</b>	5-year-old leukemia, bone marrow biopsy results were good, doing good Jane Kile

<b>William Ware</b>	Dorothy Holdridge's brother Alzheimer's

<b>Philip Wilkins</b>	Cancer, numbers are improving Dirk's friend
<b>Tiffany Rice Womble</b>	<b>at 28 weeks gestation baby Hazel is only 8% on the growth percentile chart, the doctors now consider her high risk, she will have weekly check-ups &amp; they may take the baby early if they think she will thrive better outside the womb</b>
<b>Cynthia Wombles</b>	Breast cancer, <b>double mastectomy with reconstruction July 3 went well</b> in LaGrange Donnie Teel's friend's wife
<b>Javeon Young</b>	ATV accident, fell on his legs, completely reconstructed knee, started therapy, long recovery ahead; walked for the first time Brownie
