<b>Glen &amp; Connie Elmore</b>	cancer has spread to lymph nodes and hip; <b>new appt. MDA Aug. 27-28</b>
<b>Bill &amp; Debra Francis</b>	<b>Bill: cardiologist ran some tests last week, more heart tests at EAMC in September; Debra</b> recovering from knee replacement, PT 3 times a week, surgery on right knee early fall, on 3 <sup>rd</sup> round of meds for UTI, seems to be better with new meds, <b>follow up Tuesday</b>
<b>Vicki Griffin</b>	Fell, surgery for 7 breaks in left hand, had to fix with external fixator (screws in bones attached to outside device), good report at follow up, it's healing but may take 8 weeks instead of 6, moving around much better & pain is more manageable, <b>had a consult Mon. for "stimulator" to help back pain</b>
<b>Pete Harris</b>	<b>Great report at check-up!!</b>
<b>Christy Harrison</b>	No Cirrhosis, No cancer, praying for Leishmaniasis to be gone too; iron level really low, had 2 infusions, iron level did not go up very much, <b>had a different kind of infusion last week, praying it helps, has no energy</b>
<b>Robert &amp; Gayle Hawkins</b>	Prayers for health
<b>Brenda Hughes</b>	Lost sight in right eye due to stroke; watchman procedure healed as expected but did have AFIB & BP was very high, had more fluid on her heart, <b>B'ham Aug 19<sup>th</sup> to decide if ablation is necessary, will discuss results from heart monitor</b>
<b>Mike Jones</b>	<b>Nuclear stress test showed blockage in heart, had cardiac CT to see if nuclear stress test was accurate and it showed there was no blockage, pacemaker in the near future</b>
<b>Julie Kline</b>	Lungs okay; <b>cardiologist said calcium build up is around outside of arteries, stress test today</b> , beginning stages of COPD
<b>Cindy McGill</b>	Breast needle biopsy positive, surgery went well, a year of chemo will be finished in November; finished radiation; <b>mammogram Thursday, pray for good results</b>
<b>Dorothy McKelvey Family</b>	<b>Passed away last week</b>
<b>Jimmy &amp; Brucile Peoples</b>	severe pain from hip to below knee; (Ortho doc Gomez Columbus) <b>ortho doctor said no surgery right now, 3 discs damaged &amp; one looks like it's bulging on a nerve, pain tolerable right now, will do PT for 8 weeks unless it flares, follow up Sept. 25; Brucile</b> fell & fractured kneecap, in immobilizing brace, <b>had follow up Friday for knee, 2 more weeks in brace</b>
<b>Yvonne Petty</b>	Ultrasound on left leg, swollen & red, results showed a Baker's cyst behind knee, <b>GP put on steroids</b>
<b>Whitney Rice</b>	Admitted to Russell with bowel obstruction, blockage cleared after antibiotics, rebuilding her strength once again, <b>appt. UAB surgeon 8/14 for follow up</b>
<b>Billie Nell Sanford</b>	prayers also for Harriet & Scoon as her caretakers
<b>Carly Smith</b>	<b>Has been sick for a while, much better but still a way to go, follow up Thursday</b>
<b>Leigh Tampling</b>	<b>EAMC Auburn, running tests, may be gall bladder related</b>
<b>Mary Taylor</b>	Rehab at Tallassee Health & Rehab, <b>slow but she is making some progress with her walking, standing, &amp; sitting exercises</b>
<b>Bill &amp; Marie Tidwell</b>	<b>COVID, Bill's symptoms are mild, Marie has head cold symptoms &amp; feels pretty rough</b>

<b>Geni Abernathy</b>	treatments for Lyme disease, side effects rough; acupuncture & ozone treatments helped, will need more treatments, <b>gradually improving</b> Christy Harrison's daughter
<b>Bailey Adair</b>	Dyson's Granddaughter surgery for torn Achilles tendon, 2 <sup>nd</sup> surgery because incision wouldn't heal, <b>PT going good &amp; making steady progress, headed back to Orlando Sept. 3<sup>rd</sup></b>
<b>Matthew Alford</b>	2 strokes paralyzed stomach, being nourished by TPN through PICC line, teleconference with Memphis & Cleveland doctors, since he had gastric surgery, they need to wait to do nasogastric tube, reevaluate progress in 2 months (first part of Sept.) after using a protein nutrient, pretty stable right now which is a praise Daugherty's friend
<b>Greer Bailey</b>	3-year-old diagnosed with leukemia still in remission but a long way to go Granddaughter of Brock & Amy Hill (Ann Atkins)
<b>Spencer Barrett</b>	Jerry Stricklands 24 yr old grandson <b>5mm kidney stone, hoping it will pass, procedure Thursday morning to remove stone</b>
<b>Mike Bush (Cindy)</b>	June McClendon's SIL hernia surgery revealed cancer in stomach, <b>not doing good, on respirator</b>
<b>Shane Caldwell</b>	<b>Grandview, had surgery on esophagus Saturday for bleeding, surgery went well, moved to regular room, pray for salvation Holly</b>
<b>Baby Callan</b>	Brucile's niece's baby home but needs round the clock care
<b>Rick Cole</b>	Cancer continues to spread, good report from his tests Kile's friend
<b>Maggie Dailey</b>	Doug Atkin's Aunt health issues
<b>Junior Davis</b>	Bone cancer Holly's uncle
<b>Shelby Deaton</b>	Ann C's sister-in law cancer spread to bones, cancer has not grown
<b>Robert Eason</b>	Crystal Gullede's Father esophageal cancer metastasized into gastric cancer; tumors decreased by 50% after initial round of chemo, <b>6 mo. PET scan showed no signs of a tumor, will have to remain on chemo regimen to prevent regrowth, but all his numbers &amp; organ function are great</b>
<b>Kris Eddins (Kelly)</b>	Stage 4 melanoma in lungs, esophagus & lymph nodes; started immunotherapy infusions, has lost from 187 down to 158; could not do 2 <sup>nd</sup> infusion due to elevated liver enzymes & still has bad rash from infusions, going to do another round of steroids & will get another infusion med when approved by insurance, kidney stones in both kidneys, <b>CT scan today to check growths, colon issues, back to Tijuana for treatment Sept 22<sup>nd</sup></b> Betty Hamby's SIL
<b>Shelia Fuller</b>	2 shots a month for cancer treatment, partial remission Holly's SIL
<b>Kristie Garduno</b>	Recovered from mastectomy, reconstruction & hysterectomy, then broke foot, back in cast, CT scan of leg & foot showed it was trying to heal, it's been 9 months Sue Weldon's daughter
<b>Betty Goodman</b>	Mayor's wife Alzheimer's, good days & bad days
<b>Garner Graham (Patrick &amp; Hollin)</b>	doing therapy & hyperbaric oxygen therapy treatments, still some issues with the part of brain healing that controls his sight; back on seizure meds doing good; Doing good but still has a ways to go, he is getting stronger & the new therapist is helping Graham's Grandson
<b>Danny Hankins (Miriam)</b>	<b>Bone cancer, in his last days, in extreme pain, Hospice has been called</b> June's friend

<b>Brett Harrison</b>	Christy's son recovering from knee replacement, PT is going well, <b>back at work part time</b>
<b>Matthew Hood</b>	17 yrs. 50% of body burned in car accident, amputated both legs; measured for prosthetics but needs to heal first, <b>doing rehab</b> pray for all the adjustments he has to make Jeff G
<b>Ed Huey</b>	Cancer on back of tongue, finished chemo & radiation; working from home, gaining weight but <b>still has no taste</b> ; lump still there but cancer cells are dead Huey's son
<b>Hayes Hunter</b>	Around 10 leukemia, will have 4-6 months of chemo depending on how he responds to treatment; needs a bone marrow transplant; his brother is a match, <b>started 2<sup>nd</sup> round of chemo which is much stronger, no bad effects yet, his numbers are good</b> Belinda D
<b>Ronnie &amp; Gail Jones</b>	Ronnie has brain cancer; not doing well, did chemo & radiation, now doing immunotherapy, side effects from meds are rough Marie Tidwell's sister
<b>Amber Logan</b>	major gastro issues & other related issues, inserted PICC line, on 24/7 feeds & blood thinners to prevent clots; <b>continues to gain weight</b>
<b>Laura Miller (Stephen)</b>	stage 4 lung cancer that has spread, after clinical trial cancer has spread to 2 ribs & tumors are larger, cancer is progressing through treatment, time to try something else, putting her on a tried & true chemo, <b>had 2<sup>nd</sup> treatment last Thursday</b> , 2 more clinical trials available in next 2 months; <b>prognosis is not good, praying for a miracle</b> Jean M's DIL
<b>Karen Mills</b>	Breast cancer, <b>double mastectomy &amp; reconstruction surgery August 22<sup>nd</sup></b> , <b>hoping only radiation &amp; no chemo but it will depend on what it looks like when they open her up</b> Belinda's niece
<b>Randy Moran (Leanne)</b>	Carotid artery surgery for 90% blockage, home recovering; possible diverticulitis, B12 really low & BP low, did CAT scan, adjusted BP meds, gave antibiotics & B12 shot, side effects of antibiotics are rough but feeling better, great report at follow up, <b>doing much better</b> Sharon Patterson's nephew
<b>Jim Murray</b>	Pacemaker, will have to replace aortic valve end of July or beginning of August, still waiting for decision on how to do procedure (carotid artery or groin) because he has an aortic aneurysm as well Whitney's Dad
<b>Kay Nix</b>	in remission, taking chemo as a precaution Holly
<b>Kyle Orr</b>	<b>Brookwood, had a small stroke, will do 5-7 days in house rehab, now has COVID but no symptoms, moved to rehab floor; Sheree has COVID and is very sick</b> Carolyn Alexander's brother
<b>Thad Pate</b>	Lung cancer metastasized to back; <b>on a break from chemo &amp; radiation, PET scan in Sept. to determine plan, still in a lot of pain, had appt. with back pain doc, hoping for something to relieve pain</b>
<b>Ronnie Peach</b>	Stage 4 cancer has spread everywhere, chemo is making very sick, speech is slurred Debra Francis' brother
<b>Maddy Petite</b>	Stage 4 lung cancer metastasized to brain, 28, MDA did 4 radiation treatments & a biopsy to decide on best treatment, home & started immunotherapy; admitted to USA for pain control, doctors said it looks like fractures surrounding lesion but can't tell if it's old or new, ordered an MRI Facebook Jennifer Jo: her Mom
<b>John Phillips</b>	Cancer, diabetic on 2 shots a day, not doing well; could not do stomach surgery due to his health, gave 2 mega doses of IV antibiotics & will go back for 3 <sup>rd</sup> dose, had AFIB but got heart back in rhythm, home Ann Clark
<b>Wesley Phillips</b>	denying God, prayers for salvation Ann C's nephew
<b>Bill Ponder Family</b>	He passed away last Wednesday night, services were Monday
<b>Susan Price</b>	Cancer has spread to brain, <b>treatments at MDA in August</b> Nita K's daughter
<b>Lillian Robbins</b>	Jim White's sister <b>nursing home</b>
<b>Margaret Robinson</b>	Health issues Holly

<b>Gina Speagle</b>	Nanci's DIL closed-angle glaucoma (pressure builds because fluid isn't flowing out of eye) doctor did not feel surgery was necessary since there are concerns with side effects, gave her "watch out for" signs that could indicate an "attack" which would mean surgery needed within 24 hours, praying for no "attack"
<b>Warren Thomas</b>	5-year-old leukemia, bone marrow biopsy results good; can visit with friends and hopes to attend school in the fall Jane Kile
<b>Chase &amp; Kendall Turner</b>	Baby Catherine born early, still having lung issues, not completely developed, causing heart issues, <b>not doing good, running tests on heart</b> Kile's friend
<b>William Ware</b>	Dorothy Holdridge's brother Alzheimer's
<b>Carter Webb</b>	Found lump on arm, CT scan inconclusive, MRI couldn't get image, had to sedate & do again; MRI results showed vascular malfunction of veins or arteries in arm, <b>sending to pediatric vascular doctor as precaution, pray visit goes well</b> Daugherty's grandson
<b>Sue Weldon</b>	Cellulitis in leg is not healing, heart cath results were good; back in 6 months, <b>sleep apnea test August 15</b> , will spend night at Russell
<b>Erin Wilder</b>	emergency surgery for extensive infection, home recovering, much better but must take it easy for several more weeks Jim & Gail Wilder's daughter
<b>Tiffany Rice Womble</b>	at 28 weeks gestation Hazel was only 8% on growth percentile chart, now considered high risk, may take baby early if they think she will thrive better outside womb; <b>at about 33 weeks PRAISE Hazel is up to 38%</b>
<b>Cynthia Wombles</b>	Breast cancer, <b>double mastectomy with reconstruction July 3 went well</b> in LaGrange Donnie Teel's friend's wife
<b>Lynn Wright</b>	Holly's Uncle gout, more tests, will get him set up for infusions
<b>Javeon Young</b>	ATV accident, fell on his legs, reconstructed knee, doing PT, long recovery ahead; walked for the first time, doing good but will home school this year
