Bob Daniel	multiple myeloma; infusions & meds weekly, PT @ RMC Thursdays; Bob's immune system is so low they are discouraged from going out, doing pretty good & wanting to get back to SS
Betty K Dyson	heart ablation, precursor to AFIB, BP meds & blood thinner & took off Celebrex; moving slowly, MRI on back & neck & x-rays on feet showed severe arthritis in neck & back, put her back on Celebrex & feels better
Glen & Connie Elmore	cancer has spread to lymph nodes and hip; MDA July 7-9, made it to Texas but appointments were cancelled due to Hurricane Beryl & power outages, did not reschedule, returned home; new appt. MDA Aug. 27-28
Bill & Debra Francis	Bill: cardiologist ran tests Monday; Debra recovering from knee replacement, knee not so good, PT 3 times a week, surgery on right knee early fall, hoping getting both knees done will help pain in back, due to already having rods & screws not a candidate for more surgery, on 3rd round of meds for UTI, better this mornng
Vicki Griffin	Fell, surgery for 7 breaks in left hand, had to fix with external fixator (screws in bones attached to outside device), good report at follow up, it's healing but may take 8 weeks instead of 6, moving around much better & pain is more manageable, pray for stamina with school starting, consult Mon. for "stimulator" to help back pain
Pete Harris	Check up tomorrow at 10, pray those numbers are still down
Christy Harrison	No Cirrhosis, No cancer, praying for Leishmaniasis to be gone too; iron level really low, had 2 infusions, iron level did not go up very much, had a different kind of infusion Monday, praying it helps
Robert & Gayle Hawkins	Prayers for health
Brenda Hughes	Lost sight in right eye due to stroke; watchman procedure healed as expected but did have AFIB & BP was very high, had more fluid on her heart, B'ham Aug 19th to decide if ablation is necessary, will discuss results from heart monitor, off 1 of meds for AFIB but still dragging
Nancy Iacobella	Recovering from hip replacement surgery, no PT; will just walk around house
Mike Jones	tests showed blockage in heart, had cardiac CT Monday to see if nuclear stress test was accurate, results in a week, electrophysiologist they saw last Thursday is leaning toward a pacemaker more than an ablation at this time
Julie Kline	Lungs okay; CT scan showed significant calcium build up in arteries, tests showed beginning stages of COPD, cardiologist Aug 12th
Debra Knight	Torn meniscus, arthritis & a few bone spurs, shot & meds working great right now, she will make an appt. if pain starts coming back
Cindy McGill	Breast needle biopsy positive, surgery went well, a year of chemo will be finished in November; finished radiation Cindy & Mike recovering from COVID, Mike has bronchitis now
Dorothy McKelvey Family	Passed away Monday afternoon Visitation Wednesday 5:00-8:00 at Langley and at 12:30 Thursday at the church before the funeral at 2:00
Jimmy & Brucile Peoples	severe pain from hip to below knee; (Ortho doc Gomez Columbus) ortho doctor said no surgery right now, 3 discs damaged & one looks like it's bulging on a nerve, pain tolerable right now, will do PT for 8 weeks unless it flares, follow up Sept. 25; Brucile fell & fractured kneecap, in immobilizing brace, had follow up Friday for knee, 2 more weeks in brace
Yvonne Petty	Ultrasound on left leg yesterday, swollen & red, waiting to hear results

Whitney Rice	At Russell with bowel obstruction, blockage cleared after antibiotics, got home from hospital Thursday evening, had stomach bug Sunday but doing better, rebuilding her strength once again, appt. UAB surgeon 8/14 for follow up
Billie Nell Sanford	prayers also for Harriet & Scoon as her caretakers
Mary Taylor	Rehab at Tallassee Health & Rehab, pray for family's decisions about how to best care for her
Jim White	Upper respiratory infection, on the mend
Wayne Smith	has lung cancer, still waiting on biopsies to see what kind, installed port today so he will be ready for chemo as soon as biopsies come back, they are very positive & upbeat even with this diagnosis
Ellen Wright	back surgery went well, has been dealing with severe migraines, cervical MRI showed bone spurs, had a cervical epidural last Tuesday, feeling better but still struggling with sleep due to having to sleep upright which puts pressure on surgery site; waiting on results of bone density scan; hoping to travel to Maryland for a week first part of October to visit with her Mom since she was unable to go when her Dad passed away; Joe is scheduled to be out of the country 9/5-11/17

Bailey Adair	Dyson's Granddaughter surgery for torn Achilles tendon, 2 nd surgery because incision wouldn't heal, finally healed enough to start PT, PT going good & making steady progress but now has COVID
Matthew Alford	2 strokes paralyzed stomach, being nourished by TPN through PICC line, teleconference with Memphis & Cleveland doctors, since he had gastric surgery, they need to wait to do nasogastric tube, reevaluate progress in 2 months (first part of Sept.) after using a protein nutrient, pretty stable right now which is a praise Daugherty's friend

Baby Callan	Brucile's niece's baby home but needs round the clock care
Rick Cole	Cancer continues to spread, good report from his tests Kile's friend
Maggie Dailey	Doug Atkin's Aunt health issues
Junior Davis	Bone cancer Holly's uncle
Shelby Deaton	Ann C's sister-in law cancer spread to bones, cancer has not grown
Robert Eason	Crystal Gullledge's Father esophageal cancer metastasized into gastric cancer; tumors decreased by 50% after initial round of chemo, struggling with neuropathy, hoping it is a short-term side effect from one of his meds, still has swelling & still losing weight, no feeling in fingers & toes which is very frustrating, 6 mo. PET scan last Thursday
Kris Eddins (Kelly)	Stage 4 melanoma in lungs, esophagus & lymph nodes; started immunotherapy infusions, has lost from 187 down to 158; could not do 2 nd infusion due to elevated liver enzymes & still has a bad rash from the infusions, going to do another round of steroids & will get another infusion med approved by insurance, long day at the ER Monday, kidney stones in both kidneys, no idea about heart issues, CT scan Friday, has not felt well in several weeks, pray for guidance with decisions & treatment Betty Hamby's SIL
Shelia Fuller	2 shots a month for cancer treatment, partial remission Holly's SIL

Kristie Garduno	Recovered from mastectomy, reconstruction & hysterectomy, then broke foot, back in cast, CT scan of leg & foot showed it was trying to heal, it's been 9 months Sue Weldon's daughter
Betty Goodman	Mayor's wife Alzheimer's, good days & bad days
Garner Graham (Patrick & Hollin)	doing therapy & hyperbaric oxygen therapy treatments, still some issues with the part of brain healing that controls his sight; back on seizure meds doing good; Doing good but still has a ways to go, he is getting stronger & the new therapist is helping Graham's Grandson
Brett Harrison	Christy's son home recovering from knee replacement last week, 1st PT Monday, going well
Matthew Hood	17 yrs. 50% of body burned in car accident, amputated both legs; measured for prosthetics but needs to heal first, doing rehab pray for all the adjustments he has to make Jeff G
Ed Huey	Cancer on back of tongue, finished chemo & radiation; working from home, gaining weight but still has no taste ; lump still there but cancer cells are dead Huey's son
Hayes Hunter	Around 10 leukemia, finished first round of chemo & tolerated well, will have 4-6 months of chemo depending on how he responds to treatment; needs a bone marrow transplant; his brother is a match, was able to go home for a few days but has to go back for more tests Belinda Daugherty
Ronnie & Gail Jones	Ronnie has brain cancer; not doing well, did chemo & radiation, now doing immunotherapy, side effects from meds are rough Marie Tidwell's sister
Amber Logan	major gastro issues & other related issues, inserted PICC line, on 24/7 feeds & blood thinners to prevent clots; continues to gain weight
Laura Miller (Stephen)	stage 4 lung cancer has spread, stopped chemo, after clinical trial cancer has spread to 2 ribs & tumors are larger, time to try something else, putting her on a tried & true chemo, had first treatment, 2 more clinical trials available within 2 months, she can switch depending on how treatment is going; prognosis not good Jean M's DIL
Karen Mills	Breast cancer, double mastectomy & reconstruction surgery August 22nd, hoping only radiation & no chemo but it will depend on what it looks like when they open her up Belinda's niece
Randy Moran (Leanne)	Carotid artery surgery for 90% blockage, home recovering, improving; possible diverticulitis, B12 really low & BP low, did CAT scan, adjusted BP meds, gave antibiotics & B12 shot, side effects of antibiotics are rough but feeling better, great report at follow up Tuesday, doing so much better Sharon Patterson's nephew
Jim Murray	Pacemaker, will have to replace aortic valve end of July or beginning of August, still waiting for decision on how to do procedure (carotid artery or groin) because he has an aortic aneurysm as well Whitney's Dad
Kay Nix	in remission, taking chemo as a precaution Holly
Kyle Orr	Just got out of rehab, non-responsive Monday night – conscious but could not talk), transported to Dadeville by ambulance, had a seizure after he got there, transported to ICU Brookwood, CT scan showed no stroke but a neurological problem, doctors concerned because won't wake up, still running tests Carolyn Alexander's brother
Thad Pate	Lung cancer metastasized to back; on a break from chemo & radiation, PET scan in Sept. to determine plan, still in a lot of pain, back pain doc Thurs., hoping for something to relieve pain
Ronnie Peach	Stage 4 cancer has spread everywhere, chemo is making very sick, speech is slurred Debra Francis' brother

Maddy Petite	Stage 4 lung cancer metastasized to brain, 28, MDA did 4 radiation treatments & a biopsy to decide on best treatment options, home & heard from doctors at MDA, started immunotherapy; really bad weekend with unbearable pain, doctors said it looks like fractures surrounding lesion area but can't tell if it's old or new, ordered an MRI & admitted her to USA for pain control (Facebook Jennifer Jo: her Mom)
John Phillips	Cancer, diabetic on 2 shots a day, not doing well; could not do stomach surgery due to his health, gave 2 mega doses of IV antibiotics & will go back for 3 rd dose, had AFIB but got heart back in rhythm, home Ann Clark
Wesley Phillips	denying God, prayers for salvation Ann C's nephew
Bill Ponder	transported from Grandview to Rehab, collapsed during PT, transported to Piedmont Columbus, pneumonia & COVID, receiving dialysis, still very weak, mouth, lips, & tongue dry & inflamed due to fungal infection, can't swallow even liquids, feeding tube giving him nutrition while waiting for mouth to heal, waiting to hear back from tongue tissue biopsy
Susan Price	Cancer has spread to brain, treatments at MDA in August Nita K's daughter
Lillian Robbins	Jim White's sister nursing home
Margaret Robinson	Health issues Holly
Gina Speagle	Nanci's DIL diagnosed with closed-angle glaucoma (pressure builds because fluid isn't flowing out of the eye) appt. today to see if it can be treated with meds or surgery required, doctor did not feel surgery was necessary today since there are some concerns with side effects, gave her "watch out for" signs that could indicate an "attack" which would mean surgery needed within 24 hours, praying for no "attack"
Warren Thomas	5-year-old leukemia, bone marrow biopsy results good; can visit with friends and hopes to attend school in the fall Jane Kile
Chase & Kendall Turner	Baby Catherine born early, still having lung issues, not completely developed, causing heart issues, not doing good, running tests on heart Kile's friend
William Ware	Dorothy Holdridge's brother Alzheimer's
Carter Webb	Found lump on arm, CT scan inconclusive, MRI couldn't get image, will sedate & try again; MRI results showed vascular malfunction of veins or arteries in arm, sending to pediatric vascular doctor as precaution, pray visit goes well Daugherty's grandson
Sue Weldon	Cellulitis in leg is not healing, heart cath results were good; back in 6 months , sleep apnea test August 15, will spend night at Russell
Burl Whitlock (Jamie)	Extensive injuries in car accident, Doing great, doctor released him today to go back to work
Erin Wilder	emergency surgery for extensive infection, home recovering, much better but must take it easy for several more weeks Jim & Gail Wilder's daughter
Tiffany Rice Womble	at 28 weeks gestation Hazel was only 8% on growth percentile chart, now considered high risk, may take baby early if they think she will thrive better outside womb; 31.5 weeks, appt. Thursday, praying Hazel's growth is enough to let her stay & keep growing
Cynthia Wombles	Breast cancer, double mastectomy with reconstruction July 3 went well in LaGrange Donnie Teel's friend's wife
Lynn Wright	Holly's Uncle gout, more tests, will get him set up for infusions
Javeon Young	ATV accident, fell on his legs, reconstructed knee, doing PT, long recovery ahead; walked for the first time, doing good but will home school this year
