<b>Mary Belser</b>	Broken wrist, fell on tennis court learning to play pickle ball, <b>3 more weeks (9/16/24) &amp; should get cast off</b>
<b>Joani Busko</b>	<b>Eye doctor said vision is stable, follow up in 6 weeks 9/17/24 to see if surgery is recommended</b>
<b>Butch Clark</b>	<b>Spot on prostate, PET scan last Thursday, waiting for results</b>
<b>Bob Daniel</b>	multiple myeloma; infusions & meds weekly, PT Thursdays; immune system so low they are discouraged from going out, He & Cheryl finally getting over crud
<b>Glen &amp; Connie Elmore</b>	cancer has spread to lymph nodes and hip; at last scan cancer has not spread & appears to be dormant
<b>Bill &amp; Debra Francis</b>	<b>Bill wears a nitro patch 24/7 now; Debra</b> recovering from knee replacement on left knee, done with PT due to insurance, surgery on right knee will have to be after first of year because she has used up all her PT insurance allowance, UTI lot better but staying on meds for now
<b>Vicki Griffin</b>	Fell, surgery for 7 breaks in left hand, had to fix with external fixator (screws in bones attached to outside device), doctor could not get pins out Monday due to extreme pain, had to put to sleep to remove, it's wrapped, in a splint and has a sling, <b>can't bend it or pick anything up, setting up PT; placement of trial "stimulator" for back pain October 9<sup>th</sup> @ 5:30 am</b>
<b>Christy Harrison</b>	No Cirrhosis, No cancer, praying for Leishmaniasis to be gone too; iron level really low, had different kind of infusion, still no energy
<b>Robert &amp; Gayle Hawkins</b>	<b>Prayers for Robert &amp; guidance for Gayle;</b> diagnosed with pancreatitis/gall bladder attack, saw Corbin, iron borderline, BP still very low so took off BP meds & Metformin until eating better, <b>surgeon was very thorough, doing CT scan &amp; bloodwork to be sure infection is gone, hoping to schedule surgery soon</b>
<b>Brenda Hughes</b>	Lost sight in right eye due to stroke; watchman procedure healed as expected but had AFIB & high BP, <b>had some set backs Monday with some irregular bloodwork that had to be counteracted with IV meds, so didn't start planned procedure until 7 pm, but all overnight EKG's &amp; tests &amp; Tuesday morning tests look very encouraging so meds seem to be working, no sign of AFIB, in good spirits &amp; very relieved, home Tuesday afternoon</b>
<b>Larry Iacobella</b>	<b>Watchman procedure rescheduled for October 2<sup>nd</sup></b>
<b>Judy Irvin</b>	Torn nerves in hand as a result of fall when she dislocated her shoulder are very painful but Shiels told her that means the nerves are waking up
<b>Cindy McGill</b>	Breast needle biopsy positive, surgery went well, chemo will be finished around April 2025; these treatments only make her feel bad for that day & her hair is growing back; mammogram pictures were clear
<b>Mike McGill</b>	Good report from MRI, does have a spot but PSA went way down, recheck in 3 months.
<b>Jimmy &amp; Brucile Peoples</b>	(Ortho doc Gomez Columbus) ortho doctor said no surgery right now, 3 discs damaged & one looks like it's bulging on a nerve, pain tolerable right now, will do PT for 8 weeks unless it flares, follow up Sept. 25, <b>stress test, nerve tests for legs</b> , great report from cancer center; <b>Brucile going to PT</b>
<b>Billie Nell Sanford</b>	prayers also for Harriet & Scoon as her caretakers

Kathy Williams	<b>Arbor Springs Rm. 510 Thursday Continues to improve, gaining strength &amp; endurance from PT, she is becoming more mobile &amp; can go to the bathroom by herself</b>

Matthew Alford	2 strokes paralyzed stomach, Memphis & Cleveland doctors decided since he had gastric surgery, they need to wait to do nasogastric tube, reevaluate progress in 2 months (first part of Sept.) after using a protein nutrient; PICC line in arm was infected & had to take out, home on IV antibiotics until infection clears & they can put PICC line back in Daugherty's friend
Greer Bailey	3-year-old diagnosed with leukemia still in remission but a long way to go; <b>treatments every Tuesday, please pray for minimal side effects</b> Granddaughter of Brock & Amy Hill (Ann Atkins)
<b>Caleb Belser (DJ &amp; Rachel)</b>	Mary's great grandchild EAMC <b>born Tuesday morning 9 lbs. 1 oz; low O2 due to inhaling fluid, will be in NICU for 5 days</b>
Rebecca Burton	(Clark's Mother) metastatic breast cancer coming back from cancerous tumor in small intestine 10 years ago, <b>in rehab in Bham</b> Carol Sellers
Shane Caldwell	had surgery on esophagus for bleeding, surgery went well, back at Brookwood, running tests, gave his heart to Jesus Holly
Baby Callan	Brucile's niece's baby home but needs round the clock care
Rick Cole	Cancer continues to spread Kile's friend
Junior Davis	Bone cancer Holly's uncle
Shelby Deaton	Ann C's sister-in law cancer spread to bones, scan results 9/11 showed very small spot on one lung, will just watch, another scan in 2 months
Robert Eason	Crystal Gulledge's Father esophageal cancer metastasized into gastric cancer; 6 mo. PET scan showed no signs of a tumor, will remain on chemo regimen to prevent regrowth, but all numbers & organ function are great
Kris Eddins (Kelly)	Stage 4 melanoma in lungs, esophagus & lymph nodes; <b>doing OK, up &amp; down days, more down lately, had labs this morning, throat scan &amp; biopsy on vocal cords rescheduled because didn't feel well, liver enzymes still high so needle biopsy next week, PET scan soon; Kelly had surgery on one hand &amp; will have to have surgery on the other one, tore 2 tendons</b> Betty Hamby's SIL
Shelia Fuller	2 shots a month for cancer treatment, partial remission; <b>having some back pain, appt. with back specialist Sept. 23<sup>rd</sup></b> Holly's SIL
Kristie Garduno	Recovered from mastectomy, reconstruction & hysterectomy, then broke foot, back in cast, can take cast off at home Sue Weldon's daughter
Betty Goodman	Mayor's wife Alzheimer's, good days & bad days
Garner Graham (Patrick & Hollin)	doing therapy & hyperbaric oxygen therapy treatments, still some issues with the part of brain healing that controls sight; back on seizure meds doing good; getting stronger & the new therapist is helping Graham's Grandson
Paul Gregory	One of the maintenance workers for Tallapoosa Schools, almost cut his thumb off on a table saw, UAB stopped bleeding & stitched up & sent home, had surgery to repair thumb & put in a pin, he will have a long recovery
Ed Huey	Cancer on back of tongue, finished chemo & radiation; working from home, gaining weight but still has no taste; lump still there but cancer cells are dead; doing good Huey's son
Hayes Hunter	Around 10 leukemia, 4-6 months of chemo depending on how he responds; <b>bone marrow transplant scheduled for 25<sup>th</sup></b> , his brother who is a 100% match had his check-up & he's clear for the transplant Belinda D

<b>Ronnie &amp; Gail Jones</b>	Ronnie has brain cancer; not doing well, did chemo & radiation, now doing immunotherapy, side effects from meds are rough, no quality of life, sleeps most of the time Marie Tidwell's sister
<b>Trent Keeber (McCall)</b>	Only 26, diagnosed with ALS, they just had their first child 2 months ago, lost job due to falling, they don't have a lot of family on either side Debra Francis
<b>Amber Logan</b>	major gastro issues & other related issues, moved PICC line to chest
<b>Laura Miller (Stephen)</b>	stage 4 lung cancer has spread, spread to 2 ribs & tumors are larger after clinical trial, put her on a tried & true chemo, <b>last scan showed cancer has progressed, starting a new chemo tomorrow</b> , prognosis not good, praying for a miracle, Jean M's DIL
<b>Karen Mills</b>	Breast cancer, double mastectomy & reconstruction surgery August 22 <sup>nd</sup> went well, all lymph nodes were negative, <b>still waiting on tumor board to decide on treatment</b> , hoping only radiation & not many treatments Belinda's niece
<b>Kyle Orr</b>	stroke, home from rehab, holding his own Carolyn Alexander's brother
<b>Thad Pate</b>	Lung cancer metastasized to back; PET scan last week showed 2 new tumors on his lungs, a tumor on his spine and his colon, put on a new immune med, will do radiation again & chemo once a month
<b>Ronnie Peach</b>	Stage 4 cancer has spread everywhere, <b>chemo is making very sick, can't keep balance &amp; falls quite a bit, has one more chemo treatment, will not cure but praying it prolongs life</b> Debra Francis' brother
<b>John Phillips</b>	Cancer, diabetic, 2 shots a day, feeling better Ann Clark
<b>Susan Price</b>	Cancer has spread to brain, had scans & immunotherapy at MDA, <b>did not get a good report</b> Nita K's daughter
<b>Terry &amp; Elizabeth Randolph</b>	Sharon Traylor's neighbors <b>health issues</b>
<b>David Robinson</b>	<b>Bursitis in shoulder</b>
<b>Freddie Sherrell</b>	One of Shane's customers just found out he has cancer & leukemia
<b>Warren Thomas</b>	5-year-old leukemia, bone marrow biopsy results good; can visit with friends and hopes to attend school in the fall Jane Kile
