<b>Christy Harrison</b>	No Cirrhosis, No cancer, praying for Leishmaniasis to be gone too; iron level really low, had different kind of infusion, seems to have a little more energy
<b>Gayle Hawkins</b>	<b>Stroke in brain stem that weakened right side, little stronger, appt. with Corbin today, he scheduled her for a CT scan in the morning to make sure there is no bleeding, therapy tomorrow afternoon</b>
<b>Jan Holland</b>	Still having some tummy issues
<b>Brenda Hughes</b>	New meds seem to be working, doctor was pleased with progress; Jerry got a good report, changed meds, feels great
<b>Jerry Hughes</b>	Fell and hit face, bruised and banged up, knocked out 2 teeth, had to pull other 2 so he could get a plate, <b>back again Monday, needed another week to heal</b>
<b>Larry Iacobella</b>	Watchman procedure went well but his legs gave out on him; Watchman device broke loose & migrated through two heart valves & lodged near a kidney where it blocked blood flow to legs; surgery to remove it went well; <b>still weak</b>

<b>Robert Eason</b>	Crystal Gullledge's Father esophageal cancer metastasized into gastric cancer; scan showed no signs of a tumor, will remain on chemo to prevent regrowth, all his numbers & organ function are great
<b>Kris Eddins (Kelly)</b>	Stage 4 melanoma in lungs, esophagus & lymph nodes; liver counts are down, not perfect but down a lot, PET showed only 1 spot on lungs instead of 3 and it was smaller, spot on esophagus also smaller, hoping to head back to Mexico for more treatments soon; Kelly had surgery on one hand & will have to have surgery on the other one, tore 2 tendons Betty Hamby's SIL
<b>Jamie Farmer</b>	Daugherty's daughter spontaneous hearing loss, don't know what caused, first steroid injection last Friday into her ear drum, 50/50 chance it will restore her hearing, she will have 2 more injections (15 <sup>th</sup> & 22 <sup>nd</sup> )
<b>Eugene Foshee</b>	Belinda's brother stage 3 esophageal gastrointestinal cancer, laparoscopy with abdominal lavage procedure yesterday went well, doctor did not see any anymore cancer in the abdomen, he did do a liver biopsy because it was enlarged but he thinks it's just a fatty liver, results Friday, PET scan today, got port for chemo & it will start next week, chemo every 2 weeks for 2 months, then a scan, the aggressive chemo will have a lot of side effects
<b>Shelia Fuller</b>	2 shots a month for cancer treatment, partial remission; back pain Holly's SIL
<b>Kristie Garduno</b>	Recovered from mastectomy, reconstruction & hysterectomy, broken foot has been very slow to heal, back in cast but can take off at home, going in to work some Sue Weldon's daughter

<b>Garner Graham (Patrick &amp; Hollin)</b>	doing therapy & hyperbaric oxygen therapy treatments, still some issues with the part of brain healing that controls sight; back on seizure meds doing good; getting stronger & the new therapist is helping Graham's Grandson
<b>Charlie Horton</b>	<b>appears he had a TIA, better, BP where it should be, home recovering</b>
<b>Sandra Horton</b>	feeling better, waiting on insurance approval for pacemaker
<b>Gray Howard</b>	<b>Stage 4 small cell cancer</b> Jeff Gullledge
<b>Ed Huey</b>	Cancer on back of tongue, finished chemo & radiation; recovering from left shoulder replacement, right knee next, then right shoulder, then left knee; doing great Huey's son
<b>Hayes Hunter</b>	Around 10 leukemia, 4-6 months of chemo, bone marrow transplant, his brother was a perfect match, he rang the bell and is home Belinda
<b>Ronnie &amp; Gail Jones</b>	Ronnie has brain cancer; <b>not doing well, has another brain tumor, have called in Hospice</b> Marie Tidwell's sister
<b>Amber Logan</b>	major gastro issues & other related issues, moved PICC line to chest
<b>Brandon McGuirt</b>	Severe headaches, <b>have done numerous tests but can't find anything, possibly growth spurt (hormones)</b> Linda's Grandson
<b>Laura Miller (Stephen)</b>	<b>Battling cancer</b> Jean's DIL
<b>Karen Mills</b>	Breast cancer, double mastectomy & reconstruction surgery Aug. 22 <sup>nd</sup> , all lymph nodes negative, will need radiation, not sure how many or if she will need chemo, tumor board only examined specimen on breast with least amount of cancer so radiation is still on hold; <b>had surgery to remove one of her spacers due to infection</b> Belinda's niece
<b>Kyle Orr</b>	stroke, home recovering with Home Health, <b>doing good</b> Carolyn Alexander's brother
<b>Saylor Partridge</b>	First open-heart surgery went well, Pulmonary hypertension which is causing pressure in her lungs, hoping to get her lungs better so she can have second open-heart surgery, <b>doing better, keeping her at Children's to keep an eye on her since she has had a cold</b>
<b>Thad Pate</b>	Lung cancer metastasized to back; PET scan showed 2 new tumors on lungs, a tumor on spine and colon, reaction to chemo, kidneys started shutting down, probably have to put feeding tube back in; started back on immunotherapy, can't take chemo because kidneys not strong enough, in a lot of pain
<b>Pauline Paxton</b>	Septic infection due to previous surgery, still in hospital, probably until the first of the year, has a trach, can sit up & walk with assistance Ann C.
<b>Pat Peavy</b>	Hole in colon; surgery was risky but went well, ostomy bag working & hopefully will be temporary, <b>back in the hospital, surgery sight is very infected, moved to a floor that has a wound care doctor, fixed 2 small holes near the surgery site to prevent bleeding out, can't go home until those places are better</b> Karla Teel's mom
<b>John Phillips</b>	Cancer, diabetic, 2 shots a day, feeling better Ann Clark
<b>Sharon Phillips</b>	<b>TEE &amp; Arteriogram November 12<sup>th</sup> results will determine what they will do about leak in heart, not a candidate for surgery, possible stent</b> Ann C
<b>Andrew Poole</b>	Recurring cancer requires surgery; <b>Cancer free!</b> Josh Burks
<b>Susan Price</b>	Cancer has spread to brain, had scans & immunotherapy at MDA, did not get a good report Nita K's daughter
<b>Terry &amp; Elizabeth Randolph</b>	Sharon Traylor's neighbors' health issues
<b>David Robinson</b>	having a tough time with pain after second root canal due to virus in mouth, doing better but not over virus, had first crown, still some inflammation so waiting to get second crown until it clears up
<b>Margaret Robinson</b>	Removed device to help with bladder issues due to infections, recheck Dec.

<b>Lyn Scarbrough</b>	Cancer stage 4, scan showed cancer present in lymph glands near the original kidney cancer site; continuing early treatments (new genetic tailored med in tablet form), another CT scan in Dec. to determine if meds are helping, pray cancer is receding Wayne Ingram
<b>Freddie Sherrell</b>	One of Shane's customers just found out he has cancer & leukemia, <b>still doing treatments</b>
<b>Rod Siggers</b>	<b>heart cath today showed no blockages but still need answers for fatigue &amp; always short of breath</b>
<b>Benjamin Smith</b>	John Jernigan's 8 yr. old cousin battling cancer, <b>pray for Benjamin &amp; his parents (Mark &amp; Rosie) and 5 yr. old sister Eliza as they deal with all the challenges physically &amp; emotionally &amp; continue to press forward with what must be done</b> , after a week off chemo, he began a repeat of 4 weeks of profound side effects from chemo, <b>did have to return to the hospital for 1 night due to an anaphylactic episode while receiving platelets, very scary few minutes, had to use epi pen so had to be observed for 24 hours to make sure the reaction didn't return</b>
<b>Debbie Smith</b>	<b>Spine/nerve problems; appt. December 4<sup>th</sup></b> Susan Tittle's sister
<b>Warren Thomas</b>	5-year-old leukemia, bone marrow biopsy results good, doing well Jane Kile
<b>Chase &amp; Kendall Turner</b>	Baby Catherine born March 26, lungs not completely developed so prone to infection, weighs enough to go home (5 pounds) but can't because of lung issues Kile's friend
<b>Darrell Wheeler</b>	had two emergency back surgeries, then another to relieve compression to spinal cord; moved to new rehab in Columbus on 10/31, <b>at follow up with surgeon got staples &amp; wound therapy system removed, working hard in therapy to increase upper body strength, has some sensations in legs and slight flexing in feet, he can't feel them moving but can make them flex, hopefully therapy can build on this</b> , mobility must improve significantly before he can go home Benitta Hall's Dad
<b>David Woffard</b>	Bladder cancer, he is using as an opportunity to share the gospel; <b>in between treatments, cystoscopy on the 26<sup>th</sup>, will know more then</b> Chuck L
<b>William Ware</b>	Dorothy Holdridge's brother Alzheimer's
<b>Mary Alys Washer</b>	Breast cancer, stopped chemo, she can't take anymore, recovery is slow but back at work; <b>finished radiation, fell yesterday and broke her knee cap again in 4 places, her husband Robbie is supposed to have hernia surgery Thursday</b> Mary Beth Wingard's daughter
<b>Rowan Colby Washer</b>	Mary Beth Wingard's great grandson born Oct. 17 <sup>th</sup> at 5 lbs. 10 oz., they knew he had a heart issue & was facing surgery after he was born, surgery went well, <b>doing great, weaning him off oxygen</b>
<b>Carter Webb</b>	lump on arm, MRI results showed vascular malfunction in arm, waiting for appt with pediatric vascular doctor Daugherty's great grandson
<b>Sue Weldon</b>	Cellulitis in leg not healing, sleep apnea test showed need for CPAP machine, waiting to get machine
