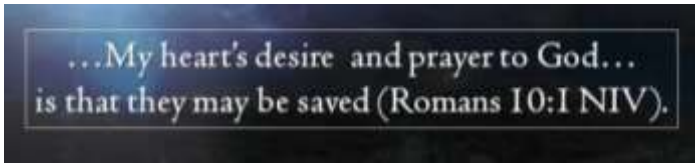

David Bridges	major back surgery will be scheduled soon , watching spots on kidneys Ann C

Ellen Dean (Kenny)	stage 3 rectal cancer, will have chemo & radiation, started chemo 1/10
Anthony & Debra Deason	Debra in wheelchair from car accident a few years ago
Lewell Deason	94 losing more eye sight, blocked arteries but not a candidate for surgery Holly
Shelby Deaton	Ann C's sister-in law cancer spread to bones, stable right now
Robert Eason	Crystal Gulledege's Father esophageal cancer metastasized into gastric cancer, will remain on chemo to prevent regrowth; had another PET scan 1/8/25 and everything still looked good
Kris Eddins (Kelly)	Stage 4 melanoma lungs, esophagus & lymph nodes; liver counts are down, not perfect but down, last PET showed 1 spot on lungs instead of 3 & it was smaller, spot on esophagus also smaller, next PET scan January 31st Betty Hamby's SIL
Eugene Foshee	Belinda's brother stage 3 esophageal gastrointestinal cancer, 1 st chemo Nov. 19 th (every 2 weeks for 2 months), then a scan, chemo is very aggressive; had severe reaction to first chemo that put him in ICU, still in A-fib, had ablation; had another chemo treatment Monday, doing well with no side effects, may leave the treatment at 50% & do them longer
Jimmy Foshee	Sharon Traylor's classmate, from Dadeville liver cancer, very sick
Shelia Fuller	Platelets low, cancer cells high, had chemo shots/treatment 26 th , bloodwork 27 th , bone marrow pull, doc appt. in 2 weeks for results Holly's SIL

Kristie Garduno	Recovered from mastectomy, reconstruction & hysterectomy, broken foot is finally better, had to get CPAP Sue Weldon's daughter
Garner Graham (Patrick & Hollin)	doing therapy & hyperbaric oxygen therapy treatments, still some issues with the part of brain healing that controls sight; back on seizure meds doing good; getting stronger & the new therapist is helping; on a waiting list for stem-cell therapy in 2025, no idea when he will start Graham's Grandson
Judy Hanna	Ronda's Aunt sepsis released from rehab but still having mobility issues, oncologist confirmed mass on kidney is stage 4 cancer, doctors gave her 2-3 years, also spots on lungs, spirits are good & she is reliant on the Lord
Sandra Horton	Back in hospital, some kind of lung disease, trying to wean her off O₂ to see how she does, shoulder still in bad shape from when she fell & broke a bone
Gray Howard	Stage 4 small cell cancer Jeff Gullledge
Ed Huey	Cancer on back of tongue, finished chemo & radiation; recovering from left shoulder replacement, should be released by surgeon next week ; right knee next, then right shoulder, then left knee; doing great Huey's son
Ann Jennings	Shane's stepmother doing much better , pray she accepts Jesus as her Savior
Mary Jennings	Blood work Friday at Grandview, colonoscopy will be scheduled
Christopher Johnson	Rare form of lung cancer, strong treatments causing his lung capacity to drop too low, running tests to determine best chemo Holly's cousin's grandson
Tyler Johnston	Leukemia is in remission Holly's cousin's grandson
Teddy & Bertha McGinty	Teddy was in a bad accident & broke back & neck, out of the hospital
Brandon McGuirt	severe headaches, child neurologist upped meds, went to children's migraine specialist who confirmed what other doctors had said & offered additional suggestions Linda's grandson
Karen Mills	Breast cancer, double mastectomy & reconstruction surgery, lymph nodes negative, had surgery to remove one of her spacers due to infection; 28 radiation treatments started Dec. 9 th having issues with a rash & itching from the radiation so not sleeping well Belinda's niece
Dwayne Nazworth	lymph node biopsy last Wednesday Linda McGuirt
Kay Nix	Mantle cell lymphoma, cancer has come back, started radiation Holly
Kyle Orr	stroke, recovering with Home Health, doing good Carolyn Alexander's brother
Saylor Partridge	First open-heart surgery went well, cath procedure 28th that will tell them if she is ready for her second open heart surgery
Thad Pate	Lung cancer metastasized to back; PET scan showed 2 new tumors on lungs, a tumor on spine and colon, reaction to chemo, took off chemo because kidneys not strong enough in a lot of pain; they have found a chemo he can tolerate
Pauline Paxton	Septic infection due to previous surgery, still in hospital, has a feeding tube, the family is praying for God's mercy Ann C.
Pat Peavy	Hole in colon; surgery was risky but went well, ostomy bag working & hopefully will be temporary, home recovering, finally starting to improve, eating some, feeling better Karla Teel's mom
John Phillips	Cancer, diabetic, 2 shots a day, stable right now Ann Clark
Sharon Phillips	leak in aorta, not a candidate for open heart surgery, procedure to put on a clamp to stop leakage went well, can't get p for 6 hours, will do Doppler echocardiogram tomorrow before she goes home Ann C
Susan Price	Cancer has spread to brain, treatments at MDA Nita K's daughter
Margaret Robinson	Put device back in to help with bladder issues, recheck in March, kidney doctor January

Lyn Scarbrough	Cancer stage 4 in lymph glands near original kidney cancer site; continuing early treatments (new genetic tailored med in tablet form), last CT scan showed cancer has not spread & tumors are 50% smaller, recheck in 3 months Wayne I.
Freddie Sherrell	One of Shane's customers cancer & leukemia
Benjamin Smith	John Jernigan's 8 yr. old cousin battling cancer, counts last Tues. allowed him to receive both meds, side effects have been fairly mild; he will have long treatment days Thurs. & Fri., Fri. he will receive the drug that put him in the hospital in November with pancreatitis, because it is an important med in his treatment, we are praying his body can withstand the side effects & receive the benefits of this critical med
Debbie Smith	Spine/nerve problems; appt. went well, doctor said he thought he could help her, insurance requires PT first, back to doc in Feb, will schedule surgery for March, still having pain & numbness Susan Tittle's sister
Mike Stonebreaker	reaction to anesthesia during foot surgery and almost died, recovering at Russell rehab Ann Clark
Warren Thomas	5-year-old leukemia, in school, treatments every 2 weeks Jane Kile
Chase & Kendall Turner	Baby Catherine born March 26, lungs not completely developed so prone to infection, weighs 8 pounds but lung problems prevent her from going home; tracheotomy surgery last Friday went well Kile's friend
William Ware	Dorothy Holdridge's brother Alzheimer's
Rowan Colby Washer	Mary Beth Wingard's great grandson born Oct. 17 th at 5 lbs. 10 oz., they knew he had a heart issue & was facing surgery after he was born, 1 st surgery went well, not going to have another surgery
Jolie Waters	Jenning's daughter induced Sunday, delivered by C-section Monday <i>Congratulations to Shane & Ronda Jennings on their new Granddaughter Macie Eloise Waters 7 lbs. 1 oz. 20" long</i>
Carter Webb	lump on arm, MRI showed vascular malfunction of veins/arteries, pediatric vascular doctor: prognosis good but wants to treat with sclerotherapy (possibly 2-3), if left untreated will continue to grow & could cause pain & loss of dexterity in hand, planning to schedule this summer Daugherty's great grandson
Sue Weldon	Cellulitis in leg not healing, got her CPAP machine, struggling with the crud
Derrell Wheeler	2 back surgeries, then a 3 rd to relieve compression to spinal cord; rehab in Columbus, still no feeling in feet, PT is scheduled to end Feb. 7th if he continues to make progress, pray for the Lord's guidance with difficult decisions about whether he goes back home, comes here, or moves to a long-term care facility Benitta Hall's Dad
David Woffard	Bladder cancer, using as opportunity to share the gospel; in between treatments, cystoscopy showed fewer tumors (2) small, back to MDA on 14th (pre-op/CT with contrast) & surgery on the 15th Chuck L
