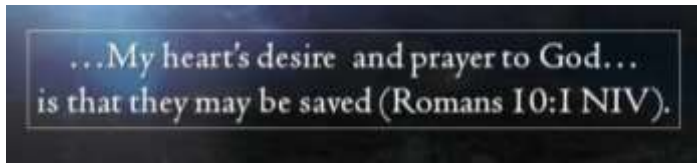

<b>Butch Clark</b>	prostate cancer but contained; 28 radiation treatments; started 12 <sup>th</sup> , will receive 2 treatments on Wednesdays, doing well so far; finished treatments; <b>back Jan. 30<sup>th</sup> to check PSA levels; pray for normal levels</b>
<b>Bob Daniel</b>	multiple myeloma; infusions & meds weekly, PT Thursdays; immune system so low they are discouraged from going out, finishes treatments in April
<b>Glen &amp; Connie Elmore</b>	cancer has spread to lymph nodes and hip; at last scan, cancer has not spread & appears to be dormant
<b>Bill &amp; Debra Francis</b>	Bill wears a nitro patch 24/7; <b>Debra</b> right knee replacement 31 <sup>st</sup> went well but PT is tough
<b>Vicki Griffin</b>	PT for hand & frozen shoulder twice a week, got permanent placement of "stimulator" for back pain Nov. 21 <sup>st</sup> , <b>appointment to "reprogram" back stimulator Tuesday at 3:20</b>
<b>Pete &amp; Sue Harris</b>	Respiratory virus, <b>MUCH better</b>
<b>Gayle Hawkins</b>	Strokes in brain stem weakened right side, PT is helping her gain strength, <b>making good progress</b> , if you bring food, please just bring plates; <b>Robert</b> had appt 6 <sup>th</sup> in B'ham with eye surgeon, he has "fuchs dystrophy" which requires surgery, they will do both eyes, he has to use drops for several weeks, they will call with a surgery date 6 weeks out; <b>Stephanie</b> hernia surgery postponed, back to surgeon in 6 months
<b>Jan Holland</b>	Still having some tummy issues, dementia is hard
<b>Jerry Hughes</b>	Heart doctor appt. 1/14 went pretty good, back on blood thinner, recheck in 30 days, possible ablation
<b>Larry Iacobella</b>	pray for healing & health
<b>Mike Jones</b>	cardiologist appt. went well, right now no ablation or pacemaker necessary; nerve study showed coverings on nerves from spinal column are fraying which can cause serious problems, <b>appt. with neuro spine specialist Feb. 27<sup>th</sup></b>
<b>Mike Kilgore</b>	MOHS procedure on ear rescheduled for Feb. 17 <sup>th</sup> at hospital surgery center instead of doc office because it may be more surgery than expected
<b>John Marcell</b>	Diagnosed with leukemia Charissa Reynold's Dad
<b>Mark McClendon</b>	foot surgery went well, no weight on it for 8 weeks, doing well, <b>got hard cast off, now has boot, started PT last week</b>
<b>Elizabeth McGukin</b>	<b>RSV feels better but still has an awful cough</b>
<b>Davis McKelvey</b>	<b>Back pain</b>
<b>Jimmy Peoples</b>	Ortho doc Gomez Columbus surgery went well, very good report at ortho follow up, doctor very pleased, next appt. 6 months July; <b>heart doctor follow up 20<sup>th</sup></b>
<b>Regina Porter</b>	Tested positive for Flu A; <b>better except for cough</b>
<b>Billie Nell Sanford</b>	prayers also for Harriet & Scoon as her caretakers
<b>Wayne Smith</b>	Non-small cell lung cancer, only immunotherapy now for minimum 2 years; treatments every 3 wks., Alternating between 2 different immunotherapies; <b>having some health issues, prayers for him to regain strength &amp; continued healing</b>
<b>Sharon Traylor</b>	<b>RSV is finally better; at doc appt. Monday heart still in rhythm after procedure but BP sky high</b>
<b>Joann Vaughn</b>	Several nodules on lungs & enlarged lymph nodes, <b>tissue biopsy Friday EAMC</b>

<b>Marcia Ware</b>	Severe back, hip and leg pain, doctor said it was all coming from her back

<b>Matthew Alford</b>	Only 44, 2 strokes paralyzed stomach, still having major issues with his stomach, was in hospital for a week but didn't help, still very weak, has palliative care once a week at home; Lisa (his wife) had 2 melanomas removed, good right now, recheck every 6 months Daugherty's friend
<b>Greer Bailey</b>	3-year-old diagnosed with leukemia still in remission but a long way to go; <b>treatments every Tuesday, please pray for minimal side effects</b> Granddaughter of Brock & Amy Hill (Ann Atkins)
<b>Gail Baker</b>	<b>Pneumonia</b> Susan Tittle
<b>Roger &amp; Donna Beam</b>	advanced pancreatic cancer, no treatment available, she has Alzheimer's Ann Clark's neighbors
<b>David Bridges</b>	major back surgery will be scheduled soon, watching spots on kidneys Ann C
<b>Arthur Lee &amp; Renee Caldwell</b>	he has Parkinsons and <b>Renee</b> has stage 1 breast cancer; had partial mastectomy & 2 lymph nodes removed, finished radiation, on Tamoxifen for 10 years, swollen lymph nodes throughout body doctor will just watch Holly
<b>Shane Caldwell</b>	Liver damage, no better no worse, accepted Jesus as his Savior Holly
<b>Baby Callan</b>	Brucile's niece's baby home but needs round the clock care
<b>Rick Cole</b>	Cancer continues to spread Kile's friend
<b>Junior Davis</b>	Bone cancer, some pain Holly's uncle
<b>Ellen Dean (Kenny)</b>	stage 3 rectal cancer, will have chemo & radiation, <b>started chemo 1/10</b>
<b>Shelby Deaton</b>	Ann C's sister-in law cancer spread to bones, stable right now
<b>Robert Eason</b>	Crystal Gulledege's Father esophageal cancer metastasized into gastric cancer, will remain on chemo to prevent regrowth; PET scan 1/8/25 everything still looked good
<b>Kris Eddins (Kelly)</b>	Stage 4 melanoma lungs, esophagus & lymph nodes; liver counts are down, not perfect but down, last PET showed 1 spot on lungs instead of 3 & it was smaller, spot on esophagus also smaller, <b>next PET scan January 31<sup>st</sup></b> Betty Hamby's SIL
<b>Eugene Foshee</b>	Belinda's brother stage 3 esophageal gastrointestinal cancer, 1 <sup>st</sup> chemo Nov. 19 <sup>th</sup> (every 2 weeks for 2 months), then a scan, chemo is very aggressive; severe reaction to first chemo; last chemo was at 80%, doing well with no side effects
<b>Jimmy Foshee</b>	Sharon Traylor's classmate, from Dadeville liver cancer, very sick
<b>Shelia Fuller</b>	Platelets low, cancer cells high, had chemo shots/treatment 26 <sup>th</sup> , bloodwork 27 <sup>th</sup> , bone marrow pull, <b>back to B'ham this week</b> Holly's SIL
<b>Garner Graham (Patrick &amp; Hollin)</b>	doing therapy & hyperbaric oxygen therapy treatments, still some issues with the part of brain healing that controls sight; back on seizure meds doing good; getting stronger & the new therapist is helping; <b>on a waiting list for stem-cell therapy in 2025, no idea when he will start</b> Graham's Grandson
<b>Judy Hanna</b>	Ronda's Aunt sepsis released from rehab but still having mobility issues, oncologist confirmed mass on kidney is stage 4 cancer, doctors gave her 2-3 years, also spots on lungs, spirits are good & she is reliant on the Lord
<b>Sandra Horton</b>	Back in hospital, some kind of lung disease, trying to wean her off O <sub>2</sub> , shoulder still in bad shape from when she fell & broke a bone
<b>Gray Howard</b>	Stage 4 small cell cancer Jeff Gulledege
<b>Ed Huey</b>	Cancer on back of tongue, finished chemo & radiation; recovering from left shoulder replacement, <b>released by surgeon</b> ; right knee next, then right shoulder, then left knee; doing great Huey's son
<b>Ann Jennings</b>	Shane's stepmother doing much better, pray she accepts Jesus as her Savior

<b>Mary Jennings</b>	Blood work/check-up at Grandview went well, colonoscopy scheduled Apr. 25 <sup>th</sup>
<b>Christopher Johnson</b>	Rare form of lung cancer, strong treatments causing his lung capacity to drop too low, running tests to determine best chemo Holly's cousin's grandson
<b>Brandon McGuirt</b>	severe headaches, child neurologist upped meds, went to children's migraine specialist who confirmed what other doctors had said & offered additional suggestions Linda's grandson
<b>Karen Mills</b>	Breast cancer, double mastectomy & reconstruction surgery, lymph nodes negative, had surgery to remove one of her spacers due to infection; 28 radiation treatments started Dec. 9 <sup>th</sup> having issues with a rash & itching from the radiation so not sleeping well Belinda's niece
<b>Bucky Nastria</b>	<b>Stage 4 lung &amp; liver cancer</b> Ed Allen
<b>Dwayne Nazworth</b>	lymph node biopsy last Wednesday Linda McGuirt
<b>Kay Nix</b>	Mantle cell lymphoma, cancer has come back, started radiation Holly
<b>Kyle Orr</b>	stroke, recovering with Home Health, doing good Carolyn Alexander's brother
<b>Saylor Partridge</b>	First open-heart surgery went well, <b>cath procedure 28<sup>th</sup> that will tell them if she is ready for her second open heart surgery</b>
<b>Thad Pate</b>	Lung cancer metastasized to back; PET scan showed 2 new tumors on lungs, a tumor on spine and colon, reaction to chemo, took off chemo because kidneys not strong enough in a lot of pain; they have found a chemo he can tolerate
<b>Pauline Paxton</b>	Septic infection due to previous surgery, still in hospital, has a feeding tube, the family is praying for God's mercy Ann C.
<b>Pat Peavy</b>	Hole in colon; surgery was risky but went well, ostomy bag working & hopefully will be temporary, home recovering, finally starting to improve, eating some, feeling better Karla Teel's mom
<b>John Phillips</b>	Cancer, diabetic, 2 shots a day, stable right now Ann Clark
<b>Sharon Phillips</b>	leak in aorta, not a candidate for surgery, procedure to put on a clamp to stop leakage went well, <b>Doppler showed leak stopped, home feeling good</b> Ann C
<b>Susan Price</b>	Cancer has spread to brain, treatments at MDA Nita K's daughter
<b>David Robinson</b>	<b>Pain in left shoulder &amp; chest area, radiates through his back, doc prescribed anti-inflammatory and ce packs TMJ, Bleeding around gums, dentist referring to periodontist</b>
<b>Margaret Robinson</b>	Put device back in to help with bladder issues, recheck in March, still some infection in kidneys, back in 4 weeks, TMJ
<b>Lyn Scarbrough</b>	Cancer stage 4 in lymph glands near original kidney cancer site; continuing early treatments (new genetic tailored med in tablet form), last CT scan showed cancer has not spread & tumors are 50% smaller, & brain scan was also clear, recheck in 3 months Wayne I.
<b>Freddie Sherrell</b>	One of Shane's customers cancer & leukemia
<b>Benjamin Smith</b>	John Jernigan's 8 yr. old cousin battling cancer, <b>counts last Tues. allowed him to receive both meds, side effects have been fairly mild; he will have long treatment days Thurs. &amp; Fri., Fri. he will receive the drug that put him in the hospital in November with pancreatitis, because it is an important med in his treatment, we are praying his body can withstand the side effects &amp; receive the benefits of this critical med</b>
<b>Debbie Smith</b>	Spine/nerve problems; appt. went well, doctor said he thought he could help her, insurance requires PT first, <b>back to doc in Feb, will schedule surgery for March, still having pain &amp; numbness</b> Susan Tittle's sister
<b>Mike Stonebreaker</b>	reaction to anesthesia during foot surgery and almost died, recovering at Russell rehab Ann Clark
<b>Warren Thomas</b>	5-year-old leukemia, in school, treatments every 2 weeks Jane Kile

<b>Chase &amp; Kendall Turner</b>	Baby Catherine born March 26, lungs not completely developed so prone to infection, weighs 8 pounds but lung problems prevent her from going home; <b>tracheotomy surgery last Friday went well</b> Kile's friend
<b>William Ware</b>	Dorothy Holdridge's brother Alzheimer's
<b>Rowan Colby Washer</b>	Mary Beth Wingard's great grandson born Oct. 17 <sup>th</sup> at 5 lbs. 10 oz., they knew he had a heart issue & was facing surgery after he was born, 1 <sup>st</sup> surgery went well, <b>not going to have another surgery</b>
<b>Sue Weldon</b>	Cellulitis in leg not healing, got her CPAP machine, struggling with the crud
<b>Derrell Wheeler</b>	2 back surgeries, then a 3 <sup>rd</sup> to relieve compression to spinal cord; rehab in Columbus, still no feeling in feet, PT is scheduled to end Feb. 7 <sup>th</sup> if he continues to make progress, pray for the Lord's guidance with difficult decisions about whether he goes back home, comes here, or moves to a long-term care facility Benitta Hall's Dad
<b>David Woffard</b>	Bladder cancer, using as opportunity to share the gospel; in between treatments, cystoscopy showed fewer tumors (2) small, <b>back to MDA on 14<sup>th</sup> (pre-op/CT with contrast) &amp; surgery on the 15<sup>th</sup></b> Chuck L
<b>Elaine Wright</b>	Bronchitis, doing a lot better Holly's aunt
