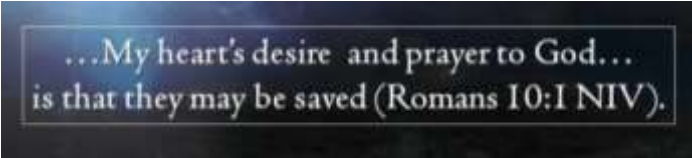

<b>Baby Callan</b>	Brucile's niece's baby home but needs round the clock care
<b>Rick Cole</b>	Cancer continues to spread Kile's friend
<b>Junior Davis</b>	Bone cancer, <b>still some pain, doesn't feel well &amp; sometimes can't sleep</b> Holly's uncle
<b>Ellen Dean (Kenny)</b>	stage 3 rectal cancer, will have chemo & radiation
<b>Anthony &amp; Debra Deason</b>	<b>Debra in wheelchair from car accident a few years ago</b>
<b>Lewell Deason</b>	94 losing more of his eye sight, blocked arteries but not a candidate for surgery Holly
<b>Shelby Deaton</b>	Ann C's sister-in law cancer spread to bones, stable right now
<b>Robert Eason</b>	Crystal Gulledege's Father esophageal cancer metastasized into gastric cancer; scan showed no signs of a tumor, will remain on chemo to prevent regrowth, all his numbers & organ function are great
<b>Kris Eddins (Kelly)</b>	Stage 4 melanoma in lungs, esophagus & lymph nodes; liver counts are down, not perfect but down, last PET showed 1 spot on lungs instead of 3 & it was smaller, spot on esophagus also smaller, <b>next PET scan January 11<sup>th</sup></b> Betty Hamby's SIL
<b>Jamie Farmer</b>	Daugherty's daughter spontaneous hearing loss, don't know cause, injections did not improve hearing, <b>MRI was normal &amp; hearing aid is working</b>
<b>Eugene Foshee</b>	Belinda's brother stage 3 esophageal gastrointestinal cancer, 1 <sup>st</sup> chemo Nov. 19 <sup>th</sup> (every 2 weeks for 2 months), then a scan, chemo is very aggressive; had severe reaction to first chemo that put him in ICU, still in A-fib but well enough to come home, oncologist wants him to build system back up before trying another chemo; had ablation; <b>had another chemo treatment last Monday, doing good</b>

Shelia Fuller	<b>Platelets low, cancer cells high, had chemo shots/treatment 26<sup>th</sup>, bloodwork 27<sup>th</sup>, bone marrow pull yesterday, doc appt. in 2 weeks for results</b> Holly's SIL
Kristie Garduno	Recovered from mastectomy, reconstruction & hysterectomy, broken foot has been very slow to heal, back in cast but can take off at home, going in to work some Sue Weldon's daughter
Garner Graham (Patrick & Hollin)	doing therapy & hyperbaric oxygen therapy treatments, still some issues with the part of brain healing that controls sight; back on seizure meds doing good; getting stronger & the new therapist is helping; <b>on a waiting list for stem-cell therapy in 2025, no idea when he will start</b> Graham's Grandson
Judy Hanna	Ronda's Aunt sepsis with gallbladder & blood clot in both lungs – both under control, dealing with mobility issues from being in bed so long; mass on kidney that is probably malignant, lost a lot of weight, <b>just got released from rehab but still having mobility issues, oncologist confirmed yesterday mass on kidney is stage 4 kidney cancer, doctors gave her 2-3 years, also has spots n her lungs, spirits are good &amp; she is reliant on the Lord</b>
Hunter Hayes	Around 10 leukemia, finished chemo, bone marrow transplant, he & his Mom are staying in B'ham for 50 days after bone marrow transplant per doctor orders to make sure it is working, seems to be doing well Belinda
Sandra Horton	feeling better, waiting on insurance approval for pacemaker; <b>getting a second opinion on broken bone in shoulder</b>
Gray Howard	Stage 4 small cell cancer Jeff Gulledege
Ed Huey	Cancer on back of tongue, finished chemo & radiation; recovering from left shoulder replacement, right knee next, then right shoulder, then left knee; doing great Huey's son
Sybil Humber	Busko's friend fell & hit her head, minor brain bleed but no surgery needed, getting better daily but still recovering
Ann Jennings	Shane's stepmother <b>doing much better</b> , pray she accepts Jesus as her Savior
Christopher Johnson	Rare form of lung cancer, on leave from military to begin strong treatments, <b>chemo is causing his lung capacity to drop too low, running tests to determine best chemo</b> Holly's cousin's grandson
Tyler Johnston	<b>Leukemia is in remission</b> Holly's cousin's grandson
Pat Lynch	Heart & lung issues, pray for shortness of breath to improve & increased energy, <b>doc appt today for results of ECHO &amp; her heart is fine!!</b>
Teddy & Bertha McGinty	Teddy was in a bad accident & broke back & neck, out of the hospital
Brandon McGuirt	severe headaches, numerous tests & MRI have not shown cause, pray they are able to find out what triggers his headaches Linda's grandson
Laura Miller (Stephen) Family	<b>Laura passed away January 1<sup>st</sup></b> Jean's DIL
Karen Mills	Breast cancer, double mastectomy & reconstruction surgery, lymph nodes negative, had surgery to remove one of her spacers due to infection; 28 radiation treatments started Dec. 9 <sup>th</sup> <b>doing great so far</b> Belinda's niece
Dwayne Nazworth	<b>lymph node biopsy</b> Linda McGuirt
Kay Nix	<b>Mantle cell lymphoma, cancer has come back, started radiation, mini stroke week before Christmas</b> Holly
Kyle Orr	stroke, home recovering with Home Health, doing good Carolyn Alexander's brother
Saylor Partridge	First open-heart surgery went well, doing good, waiting until next cath procedure to see when she can have second open-heart surgery
Thad Pate	Lung cancer metastasized to back; PET scan showed 2 new tumors on lungs, a tumor on spine and colon, reaction to chemo, took off chemo because kidneys not strong enough in a lot of pain; they have found a chemo he can tolerate

<b>Lee Patterson</b>	<b>Was hospitalized with diverticulitis but came home Monday</b> Josh's Dad
<b>Pauline Paxton</b>	Septic infection due to previous surgery, still in hospital, probably until first of the year, has a trach, can sit up & walk with assistance Ann C.
<b>Pat Peavy</b>	Hole in colon; surgery was risky but went well, ostomy bag working & hopefully will be temporary, home recovering, <b>doing better</b> Karla Teel's mom
<b>John Phillips</b>	Cancer, diabetic, 2 shots a day, stable right now Ann Clark
<b>Sharon Phillips</b>	leak in aorta, not a candidate for open heart surgery, <b>will put on a clamp to stop leakage January 15<sup>th</sup></b> Ann C
<b>Susan Price</b>	Cancer has spread to brain, treatments at MDA Nita K's daughter
<b>Margaret Robinson</b>	<b>Put device back in to help with bladder issues, recheck in March, kidney doctor January</b>
<b>Lyn Scarbrough</b>	Cancer stage 4, scan showed cancer present in lymph glands near original kidney cancer site; continuing early treatments (new genetic tailored med in tablet form), <b>CT scan showed cancer has not spread &amp; tumors are 50% smaller, another check in 3 months</b> Wayne Ingram
<b>Freddie Sherrell</b>	One of Shane's customers cancer & leukemia
<b>Benjamin Smith</b>	John Jernigan's 8 yr. old cousin battling cancer, <b>was able to resume treatments 23<sup>rd</sup> but was unable to get treatment 2<sup>nd</sup> due to platelet counts being too low, did receive a blood transfusion due to low hemoglobin, praying his counts yesterday allowed him to receive both meds, if not he will receive 1 &amp; go back Friday for the other;</b> recent pancreatitis attack was caused by one of the meds critical for his survival so difficult decisions had to be made to alter treatments temporarily
<b>Debbie Smith</b>	Spine/nerve problems; appt. went well, doctor said he thought he could help her but cannot schedule surgery until March, will do PT for now, please pray it helps with the pain Susan Tittle's sister
<b>Mike Stonebreaker</b>	reaction to anesthesia during foot surgery and almost died, recovering at Russell rehab Ann Clark
<b>Warren Thomas</b>	5-year-old leukemia, in school, treatments every 2 weeks Jane Kile
<b>Chase &amp; Kendall Turner</b>	Baby Catherine born March 26, lungs not completely developed so prone to infection, <b>weighs 8 pounds but still has lung problems &amp; can't go home</b> Kile's friend
<b>William Ware</b>	Dorothy Holdridge's brother Alzheimer's
<b>Mary Alys Washer</b>	Breast cancer, finished chemo & radiation; fell & broke knee cap again in 4 places, back at work on crutches Mary Beth Wingard's daughter
<b>Rowan Colby Washer</b>	Mary Beth Wingard's great grandson born Oct. 17 <sup>th</sup> at 5 lbs. 10 oz., they knew he had a heart issue & was facing surgery after he was born, 1 <sup>st</sup> surgery went well, working on gaining weight getting ready for another heart surgery
<b>Jolie Waters</b>	Jenning's daughter unborn baby, <b>Macie is no longer breach, back to doctor Thursday &amp; will possibly be induced sometime after that</b>
<b>Carter Webb</b>	lump on arm, MRI results showed vascular malfunction of veins or arteries in arm, <b>appt. with pediatric vascular doctor said prognosis is good but he wants to treat with sclerotherapy (possibly 2-3 treatments), if left untreated it will continue to grow &amp; could eventually cause pain &amp; loss of dexterity in hand, planning to schedule this summer when he is out of school.</b> Daugherty's great grandson
<b>Sue Weldon</b>	Cellulitis in leg not healing, sleep apnea test showed need for CPAP machine

<b>Derrell Wheeler</b>	two emergency back surgeries, then another to relieve compression to spinal cord; rehab in Columbus, strength is improving, skin tear not healing as quickly as it needs to which is causing issues, <b>In the final weeks of PT so we have some difficult decisions to make about whether he goes back to his home, comes here, or moves to a long-term care facility, pray for the Lord's guidance</b> Benitta Hall's Dad
<b>Jeremy White</b>	<b>Has recovered from the hernia surgery he had the 26<sup>th</sup></b>
<b>Karen Wilson</b>	cancer all over, had brain surgery, in induced coma
<b>David Woffard</b>	Bladder cancer, using as opportunity to share the gospel; in between treatments, cystoscopy showed fewer tumors (2) small, so another surgery soon Chuck L
<b>Elaine Wright</b>	Bronchitis, <b>doing a lot better</b> Holly's aunt
