


Garner Graham (Patrick & Hollin)	doing therapy & hyperbaric oxygen therapy treatments, still issues with part of brain healing that controls sight; back on seizure meds; getting stronger; on waiting list for stem-cell therapy Graham's Grandson
Charlie Horton & Family	They lost Mrs. Sandra last week
Gray Howard	Stage 4 small cell cancer Jeff Gulledege
Ed Huey	Cancer on back of tongue, finished chemo & radiation; left shoulder replacement, released by surgeon; right knee next, then right shoulder, then left knee; having a lot of pain right now Huey's son
Jack Hubbard	Heart rhythm issues, doing better Horton's son
Christopher Johnson	Rare form of lung cancer, strong treatments causing lung capacity to drop, running tests to determine best chemo Holly's cousin's grandson
Brandon McGuirt	severe headaches, child neurologist upped meds, children's migraine specialist confirmed what other doctors said & offered additional suggestions Linda's grandson
Karen Mills	Breast cancer, double mastectomy & reconstruction surgery, lymph nodes negative, finished radiation, getting infusions that cause fever Belinda's niece
Bucky Nastria	Stage 4 lung & liver cancer Ed Allen
Kay Nix	Mantle cell lymphoma, cancer has come back, started radiation Holly
Saylor Partridge	First open-heart surgery went well, cath procedure 28 th determined meds did not work so will not be able to do a second surgery, home now, keeping her on same meds watching hypertension, needs heart transplant Emily A.
Thad Pate	Lung cancer has metastasized, found a chemo he can tolerate
Pauline Paxton	Septic infection due to previous surgery, still in hospital, is able to eat & get up & sit in chair, doing some PT, looking for a nursing home Ann C.
John Phillips	Cancer, diabetic, 2 shots a day, stable right now Ann Clark
Sharon Phillips	leak in aorta, not a candidate for surgery, procedure to put on a clamp to stop leakage went well, Doppler showed leak stopped, home feeling good Ann C
Susan Price	Cancer has spread to brain, treatments at MDA Nita K's daughter
David Robinson	stent in artery that was 80% blocked; back to ER with accelerated heart rate, chest pains, high BP, all tests indicated no issues with heart, primary doctor prescribed acid reflux meds, possible pinched nerve
Margaret Robinson	Put device back in to help with bladder issues, recheck in March, still some infection in kidneys, back in 4 weeks, iron a little low
Lyn Scarbrough	Eye issues & a detached retina, had surgery, pray for a positive outcome Wayne Ingram
