Glen & Connie Elmore	cancer has spread to lymph nodes and hip; at last scan, cancer has not spread & appears to be dormant
Bishop Foshee	<b>cut his finger at school, it's not broken but the tendon is cut, stitches would not hold it closed so they just wrapped it</b>
Vicki Griffin	PT for hand & frozen shoulder twice a week, got permanent placement of "stimulator" for back pain Nov. 21 <sup>st</sup> , waiting for appointment to "reprogram" back stimulator
Gayle Hawkins	Strokes in brain stem weakened right side, PT is helping her regain strength, great report at check-up with Dr Corbin, way ahead of expected progress in 3 months, just going to take a while to get strength back, if you bring food, please just bring plates; <b>Robert</b> had appt 6 <sup>th</sup> in B'ham with eye surgeon, he has "fuchs dystrophy" which requires surgery in both eyes, has to use drops for several weeks, they will call with a surgery date 6 weeks out
Jan Holland	Still having some tummy issues, dementia is hard
Jerry Hughes	Heart doctor appt. 1/14 went pretty good, back on blood thinner, recheck in 30 days, possible ablation; <b>pain in hip, leg &amp; shoulder</b>

Judy Irvin	Fell & broke femur, had surgery, good attitude, <b>progressing nicely at Russell Rehab</b>
Mike Jones	cardiologist appt. went well, no ablation or pacemaker necessary; nerve study showed coverings on nerves from spinal column are fraying which can cause serious problems, <b>appt. with neuro spine specialist Feb. 27<sup>th</sup></b>
Robin Jones Family	<b>her Dad, Bob Bowie, passed away Friday</b>

<b>Rick Cole</b>	<b>New cancer medicine has stopped cancer from growing, continue to pray for healing</b> Kile's friend
<b>Junior Davis</b>	Bone cancer, some pain Holly's uncle
<b>Ellen Dean (Kenny)</b>	stage 3 rectal cancer, will have chemo & radiation, started chemo 1/10
<b>Shelby Deaton</b>	Ann C's sister-in law cancer spread to bones, stable right now
<b>Robert Eason</b>	Crystal Gulledege's Father esophageal cancer metastasized into gastric cancer, will remain on chemo to prevent regrowth; PET scan 1/8/25 everything still looked good
<b>Kris Eddins (Kelly)</b>	Stage 4 melanoma lungs, esophagus & lymph nodes; liver counts coming down, <b>PET scan showed 1 spot on esophagus &amp; 1 spot on lung was slightly bigger, 2 tumors on left side of brain &amp; 1 on right, some swelling has affected speech &amp; memory; when radiation face mask is ready they will treat all 4 tumors, surgery next Wednesday to remove the big one</b> Betty Hamby's SIL

<b>Eugene Foshee</b>	Belinda's brother stage 3 esophageal gastrointestinal cancer, 1 <sup>st</sup> chemo Nov. 19 <sup>th</sup> , chemo is very aggressive; severe reaction to first chemo; increased chemo, then a scan to see if cancer has shrunk enough for surgery
<b>Shelia Fuller</b>	Multiple Myeloma starting back treatments next Monday Holly's SIL
<b>Garner Graham (Patrick &amp; Hollin)</b>	doing therapy & hyperbaric oxygen therapy treatments, still some issues with the part of brain healing that controls sight; back on seizure meds doing good; getting stronger & the new therapist is helping; <b>on a waiting list for stem-cell therapy in 2025, no idea when he will start</b> Graham's Grandson
<b>Judy Hanna</b>	Ronda's Aunt stage 4 kidney cancer, doctors gave her 2-3 years, also spots on lungs, spirits are good & she is reliant on the Lord
<b>Olivia Hanna</b>	Possible ovarian cancer, waiting on blood work Holly's cousin
<b>Sandra Horton Family</b>	<b>Mrs. Sandra passed away Tuesday morning Visitation Friday 10:30-11:30 Langley Funeral Home Funeral will follow at noon.</b>
<b>Gray Howard</b>	Stage 4 small cell cancer Jeff Gulledege
<b>Ed Huey</b>	Cancer on back of tongue, finished chemo & radiation; recovering from left shoulder replacement, released by surgeon; right knee next, then right shoulder, then left knee; having a lot of pain right now Huey's son
<b>Jack Hubbard</b>	Heart rhythm issues, <b>doing better</b> Horton's son
<b>Christopher Johnson</b>	Rare form of lung cancer, strong treatments causing his lung capacity to drop too low, running tests to determine best chemo Holly's cousin's grandson
<b>Brandon McGuirt</b>	severe headaches, child neurologist upped meds, went to children's migraine specialist who confirmed what other doctors had said & offered additional suggestions Linda's grandson
<b>Karen Mills</b>	Breast cancer, double mastectomy & reconstruction surgery, lymph nodes negative, finished radiation treatments, <b>doing pretty good but weeping blisters on chest &amp; back, also getting infusions that cause her to run fever</b> Belinda's niece
<b>Bucky Nastria</b>	Stage 4 lung & liver cancer Ed Allen
<b>Kay Nix</b>	Mantle cell lymphoma, cancer has come back, started radiation Holly
<b>Saylor Partridge</b>	First open-heart surgery went well, cath procedure 28 <sup>th</sup> determined meds did not work & heart cath was the same so they will not be able to do a second open heart surgery, <b>home now, keeping her on the same meds watching her hypertension</b> , she needs a heart transplant Emily Atkins
<b>Thad Pate</b>	Lung cancer metastasized to back; PET scan showed 2 new tumors on lungs, a tumor on spine and colon, reaction to chemo, took off chemo because kidneys not strong enough in a lot of pain; they have found a chemo he can tolerate
<b>Pauline Paxton</b>	Septic infection due to previous surgery, still in hospital, <b>is able to eat &amp; they are getting her up &amp; doing some PT, looking for a nursing home</b> Ann C.
<b>John Phillips</b>	Cancer, diabetic, 2 shots a day, stable right now Ann Clark
<b>Sharon Phillips</b>	leak in aorta, not a candidate for surgery, procedure to put on a clamp to stop leakage went well, Doppler showed leak stopped, home feeling good Ann C
<b>Susan Price</b>	Cancer has spread to brain, treatments at MDA Nita K's daughter
<b>David Robinson</b>	<b>Heart cath Monday morning, they put a stent in an artery that was 80% blocked; back to ER Tuesday with same symptoms: accelerated heart rate, chest pains, high BP, he was admitted, all tests indicated no issues with his heart so he is being dismissed, advised him to go back to his primary doctor;</b> periodontist did not see anything except some minor bone loss
<b>Margaret Robinson</b>	Put device back in to help with bladder issues, recheck in March, still some infection in kidneys, back in 4 weeks, <b>iron a little low</b>

<b>Lyn Scarbrough</b>	<b>Eye issues &amp; a detached retina, had surgery, pray for a positive outcome</b> Wayne Ingram
<b>Freddie Sherrell</b>	One of Shane's customers cancer & leukemia
<b>Benjamin Smith</b>	John Jernigan's 8 yr. old cousin battling cancer, ANC was too low to get his treatment 28 <sup>th</sup> , <b>was able to complete part of his treatment last Friday, counts were still too low for full chemo; Rosie has been battling a terrible case of the flu but is better</b>
<b>Debbie Smith</b>	Spine/nerve problems; appt. went well, doctor said he thought he could help her, insurance requires PT first, back to doc in Feb, will schedule surgery for March, still having pain & numbness Susan Tittle's sister
<b>Mike Stonebreaker</b>	reaction to anesthesia during foot surgery and almost died, recovering at Russell rehab Ann Clark
<b>Warren Thomas</b>	5-year-old leukemia, in school, treatments every 2 weeks Jane Kile
<b>Chase &amp; Kendall Turner</b>	Baby Catherine born March 26, lungs not completely developed so prone to infection, weighs 8 pounds but lung problems prevent going home; had to have tracheotomy Kile's friend
<b>William Ware</b>	Dorothy Holdridge's brother Alzheimer's
<b>Lynne Warren</b>	Biopsy showed tumor in throat is malignant, <b>going to MD Anderson Feb. 11<sup>th</sup></b> Brenda Bagley's SIL
<b>Jolie Waters</b>	Severe headache, doctor thinks it's due to spinal leakage after the epidural, <b>still has a headache but it is not as strong</b>
<b>Sue Weldon</b>	Cellulitis in leg not healing, got her CPAP machine, struggling with the crud
<b>Derrell Wheeler</b>	2 back surgeries, then a 3 <sup>rd</sup> to relieve compression to spinal cord; rehab in Columbus, still no feeling in feet, cardiologist will test blood flow to feet & determine how stenosis is affecting recovery, still has open wound on back & staff infection in wounds on both feet; plan was to bring him home Feb. 7 <sup>th</sup> with 24/7 care, pray the infection does not change that Benitta Hall's Dad
<b>David Woffard</b>	Bladder cancer, using as opportunity to share the gospel; in between treatments, cystoscopy showed fewer tumors (2) small, back to MDA on 14 <sup>th</sup> (pre-op/CT with contrast) & surgery on the 15 <sup>th</sup> results will determine course of action Chuck L
