Butch Clark	prostate cancer but contained; finished radiation; PSA levels came down 3 points, PSA levels dropped 1 point, recheck in 3 months
Cocks Family	Stomach virus running through the family
Bob Daniel	multiple myeloma; infusions & meds weekly, PT Thursdays; immune system so low they are discouraged from going out, not finished with treatments but only has to see the doctor once a month now
Ann Davis	Unspoken prayer request
Betty K Dyson	Fell & broke elbow 21 st , replacement surgery, doctor pleased with range of motion & progress, doing ok, nerves are still angry ; grade 2 invasive ductal carcinoma left breast, biopsy results right breast benign, cancer is grade 1 stage 2, very small tumor in left breast, less than 5% chance it has spread, CURABLE! , lumpectomy & radiation choice of treatment, running more tests to see if chemo or hormone treatment would be better choice, will address whatever problem there is with right breast at time of lumpectomy; outpatient surgery tentatively scheduled for June 20th

Sonny Dyson	Heart cath & TEE yesterday, cath was good, TEE showed stenosis is worth, appt. with cardiologist next week to discuss options for valve replacement, this is something they have been watching for several years
Glen & Connie Elmore	cancer has spread to lymph nodes and hip; at last scan, cancer has not spread & appears to be dormant
Ivory Foshee	stress test results were normal, waiting on heart monitor results
Robert & Gayle Hawkins	Strokes in brain stem weakened right side, doing better every day; Robert has “fuchs dystrophy”, requires surgery in both eyes, surgery on right eye went well, doing good, vision much better, next follow up June 5th
Bill & Jan Holland	Still having some tummy issues, dementia is hard, struggling
Sonny Huey	has an ulcer in the stomach & a hiatal hernia, treating with meds, follow up in a month (4/30), did nuclear test, stress test and ECHO May 15th, will see doctor tomorrow for results
Jerry Hughes	watchman procedure came loose, had to go back into emergency surgery to remove, procedure to put permanent pacemaker in yesterday went well, will be very weak for a couple of weeks, can't walk without help & has a long recovery but hopefully a good one, having a hard time with excruciating pain in his left shoulder and hip that were giving him trouble before this procedure, but overall he is improving. Being released to come home late this afternoon, he will need round-the-clock care for the immediate future
Mike Jones	coverings on nerves from spine fraying, pinched nerve & nerve damage in right leg; heart monitor implanted, electrical function of heart degenerating, scheduled to get pacemaker June 5th at RMC
Tanya McCullars	Knee replacement Monday, June 2nd Dr. Howorth Alex City
Elizabeth McGukin	shoulder torn again after 2 surgeries to repair, shots did not give the relief she hoped for; 3 squamous cell carcinomas removed on shins, places are better but still healing, trying to make it through the summer before she has reverse shoulder replacement
Gail Missildine	Another compression fracture, had kyphoplasty procedure done last Wednesday, also did lumbar work on L1 which caused pain initially, pain is much better, follow up May 29th
Holly Robinson	Great deal of pain from possible broken rib
Billie Nell Sanford	pray for Harriet & Scoon as caretakers; fell & broke hip, replaced ball joint, rehab Dadeville HealthCare Rm 203, trying hard with PT, pray her mobility continues to improve
Wayne Smith	Non-small cell lung cancer, CT scan showed tumor on lung was gone; finished radiation treatments 15 th on arm, head & adrenal gland, started back immunotherapy, admitted to RMC ICU Tuesday, going to keep him a few days to get the fluid off his legs & feet
Karla Teel	Biopsy of knots on neck showed cancer, it is a recurrence of lobular breast cancer, it is on chest wall, in peck muscle & possibly muscles in armpit, radiation would be first course of treatment if she has not reached her limit, major complicated surgery making sure chest wall can hold organs, depending on how much is involved, would be next option; brain MRI showed no cancer, appt. at MDA June 21, prayers for anxiety for the waiting

Patrick Cox	After 4 th surgery on ankle, it's still not good; may have to amputate the foot Hawkins SIL
Junior Davis	Bone cancer, PSA #'s up Holly's uncle
Shelby Deaton	Ann C's sister-in law cancer spread to bones, last scan showed she is stable
Robert Eason	Crystal Gullledge's Father esophageal cancer metastasized to gastric cancer, chemo every 2 weeks to prevent regrowth; kidney function improving, scans good
Jeff East	Jean Gravette's brother's surgery on March 21 st C5 & C6, went through the neck, at work half days but still struggling with pain
Kris Eddins (Kelly)	Stage 4 melanoma in lungs has spread; liver counts high, PET scan showed spot on esophagus, 1 spot on lung slightly bigger, 2 tumors left side of brain & 1 on right, had radiation then surgery to remove biggest tumor, MRI showed new tumors & the ones they did radiation on grew, one tumor is where it cannot be treated or removed, had a targeted radiation treatment last Tuesday 13th, back in 30 days for MRI to see if it helped Betty Hamby's SIL
Candy Enkeboll	Breast cancer has metastasized, choosing not to do more treatments, pray for peace & comfort Jenny Hall
Shelia Fuller	Multiple Myeloma; still doing treatments Holly's SIL
Scott Fuller	ER with chest pains, heart OK, ultrasound showed nodule on thyroid, it was bigger than they thought, did a needle aspiration Friday 16 th , also has a spot on larynx, follow up June 9th; follow up with heart doctor Friday 23rd
Garner Graham (Patrick & Hollin)	therapy & hyperbaric oxygen therapy treatments, still issues with part of the brain healing that controls sight; had stem-cell infusion which gives a 40-80% chance of improvement, pray for the best results Graham's Grandson
Sarah Hosford	Enlarged liver; still having to drain fluids off stomach, not a candidate for a liver transplant right now due to not making necessary diet & exercise changes Julie's niece
Todd Huddleston	Colon cancer Carol Sellers
Ed Huey	Cancer back of tongue, finished treatments; had left shoulder replacement, doctor dismissed; doing well after right knee replacement, in PT; released to drive Huey's son
Gale Jones	Shoulder surgery last Monday went well, pain is much better but can't do anything
Danny Lloyd (Danita)	Donna Padgett's brother 4-inch mass on kidney, most likely cancer, will remove kidney Monday thinking that will take care of it but will do further tests to make proper determination, pray for his wife & stepson, her first husband died of cancer & this is hitting hard, plus his Mother is battling cancer
Nancy Lloyd	Donna Padgett's Mother has lung cancer, Hospice
Lawrence McCoy	Josh & Brandi P.'s grandson born May 13th a month early, on a ventilator among other things and a blood pump, lots of issues. Children's Birmingham

Brandon McGuirt (11)	severe headaches, upped meds, becoming more frequent; will have adenoids & tonsils out in June when school is out, pray that helps Linda's grandson
Elizabeth Mosley	Tina Bryan's DIL's Mother had breast cancer several years ago & it has come back, now in 8 lymph nodes, doing ok, good days & bad days from chemo
Kay Nix	Mantle cell lymphoma, cancer has come back, started radiation Holly
Saylor Partridge	Born 6/18/24 had 1 open-heart surgery, cannot do a 2 nd , needs heart transplant Emily A
Pauline Paxton	Home doing well, procedure last Friday went well, drained the site where the infection was, follow up this week, doing good Ann C.
John Phillips	Cancer, diabetic, 2 shots a day, not doing well Ann Clark
Sharon Phillips	Ablation for back pain 21st went well & gave relief from pain, will have right side done in 3 weeks Ann C
