<b>Sonny Dyson</b>	Cardiologist appt. & CT scan showed he is in severe range not critical, must be clear of any UTI's before even think about valve replacement, finishes meds 12 <sup>th</sup> , <b>urologist wants to get another culture this week &amp; if it's good he may get another one Monday, pray the meds cleared up infection &amp; he stays infection free so he doesn't have to reach critical stage before they will do valve replacement</b>
<b>Glen &amp; Connie Elmore</b>	cancer has spread to lymph nodes and hip; at last scan, cancer has not spread & appears to be dormant
<b>Robert &amp; Gayle Hawkins</b>	Strokes in brain stem weakened right side, doing great; <b>Robert</b> has "fuchs dystrophy", requires surgery in both eyes, surgery on right eye went well, vision much better, good report at follow-up for right eye, <b>will do left eye done Aug. 6<sup>th</sup></b>
<b>Bill &amp; Jan Holland</b>	Still having some tummy issues, dementia is hard, struggling
<b>Sonny Huey</b>	ulcer in stomach & hiatal hernia, so far all tests have come back good, <b>had a vascular test on his legs today</b>
<b>Jerry Hughes</b>	watchman procedure came loose, did emergency surgery to remove, pacemaker procedure went well, home recovering, <b>excellent report at follow up today even though he still has a long recovery, heart healed its ability to beat on its own, they were able to turn pacemaker down &amp; use as supplemental only</b>
<b>Mike Jones</b>	coverings on nerves from spine fraying, pinched nerve & nerve damage in right leg; heart monitor implanted, electrical function of heart degenerating, pacemaker procedure was a success, <b>experienced some heart palpitations over the weekend but cardiologist said that is normal, after 3 good days started experiencing bladder issues again, urologist will do scope next Thursday to see what's going on with bladder &amp; check on enlarged prostate</b>
