<b>Bob Daniel</b>	multiple myeloma; infusions & meds weekly, PT Thursdays; immune system so low they are discouraged from going out, not finished with treatments but only has to see the doctor once a month now
<b>Betty K Dyson</b>	elbow doing ok, nerves still angry; biopsy right breast benign, cancer grade 1 stage 2, very small tumor left breast, less than 5% chance it has spread, lumpectomy with 3 lymph nodes removed on left, 3 duct glands removed on the right, surgeon said everything looked good, <b>waiting on pathology report</b>
<b>Sonny Dyson</b>	TAVR procedure last Wed. at UAB (minimally invasive valve replacement) went well, <b>no permanent pacemaker necessary, will discharge with a monitor just to make sure for the next few days</b>
<b>Glen &amp; Connie Elmore</b>	cancer has spread to lymph nodes and hip; at last scan, cancer has not spread & appears to be dormant
<b>Robert &amp; Gayle Hawkins</b>	Strokes in brain stem weakened right side, doing great; <b>Robert</b> has "fuchs dystrophy", requires surgery in both eyes, surgery on right eye went well, vision much better, good report at follow-up for right eye, <b>will do left eye done Aug. 6<sup>th</sup></b>
<b>Bill &amp; Jan Holland</b>	Still having some tummy issues, dementia is hard, struggling
<b>Sonny Huey</b>	ulcer in stomach & hiatal hernia, so far all tests have come back good, had a vascular tests on his legs
<b>Brenda Hughes</b>	<b>Eye infection in right eye, doctor not sure what's going on, back Thursday for exploratory to figure out what's going on.</b>
<b>Jerry Hughes</b>	<b>Feels much better, energy level still low, issues with arthritis</b>
<b>Mike Jones</b>	coverings on nerves from spine fraying, pinched nerve & nerve damage in right leg; pacemaker procedure was a success, <b>scope went well and everything was fine, there is a newish procedure for reducing size of prostate only done at UAB, they will discuss further with urologist here before deciding</b>
<b>Nita Kendall</b>	Recovering from knee replacement, <b>getting better each day, looked good at follow-up, started PT at wellness center</b>
<b>Elizabeth McGukin</b>	Procedure to implant an ICD (Internal Cardioverter Defibrillator) to keep her heart in rhythm went well, <b>surgery site still tender but healing, upper respiratory infection, really bad cough, getting some better</b>
<b>Jimmy Peoples</b>	<b>Mailed heart monitor back, waiting to hear results, doing ok, just tired</b>
<b>Billie Nell Sanford</b>	pray for Harriet & Scoon as caretakers; fell & broke hip, replaced ball joint, rehab Dadeville HealthCare Rm 203, <b>trying hard with PT, maintaining, still dealing with catheter, pray her mobility continues to improve</b>

Joyce Smith	Fell, has 2 breaks below left shoulder, good report at follow-up 24 <sup>th</sup> , keep doing what she is doing for 3 more weeks then come back to see if it is completely healed, may not need PT
Wayne Smith	Non-small cell lung cancer, CT scan showed tumor on lung was gone; finished radiation treatments 15 <sup>th</sup> on arm, head & adrenal gland, doing immunotherapy treatments (11 <sup>th</sup> ) had 2 CT scans, <b>MRI last Thursday, no results from either yet</b>
Karla Teel	Biopsy of knots on neck showed cancer, recurrence of lobular breast cancer, on chest wall, in peck muscle & possibly muscles in armpit, radiation first course of treatment if limit not reached, next option major complicated surgery making sure chest wall can hold organs; brain MRI showed no cancer, <b>ran all kinds of tests at MDA last Thursday, does have 2 spots on chest wall, sees radiologist today for a treatment plan</b>
Debbie Thompson	gall bladder surgery Monday went well, home Monday afternoon, very sore but ok, <b>follow up July 10<sup>th</sup>, liver biopsies were negative, no cirrhosis, scarring due to chronic gall bladder disease, pathology report on gall bladder showed it was full of stones so thankful it's gone</b>
Jacky Thompson	<b>Retinal detachment &amp; tear, surgery last Friday, has to keep head down for 2 weeks - 50 minutes of each hour due to placement of gas bubble, getting a little more sleep but this is a tough recovery, follow up tomorrow</b>
Marie Tidwell	Facial pain has come back, <b>met with oral surgeon, CT scan July 2<sup>nd</sup>, pain is not as bad as it was last year</b>
Judy Waters	<b>breast cancer, lumpectomy July 25<sup>th</sup> RMC</b>
Kathy Williams	surgery to replace entire spinal stimulator & properly locate went well, improving slowly each day, <b>follow up July 3<sup>rd</sup></b>

Patrick Cox	After 4 surgeries on ankle <b>finally good news, has walking cast, working on building up strength</b> Hawkins SIL
Junior Davis	Bone cancer, PSA very high, great deal of pain, testing to see options for additional treatment, <b>fell again yesterday, hit head, back &amp; shoulder</b> Holly
Shelby Deaton	Ann C's sister-in law cancer spread to bones, chemo & immunotherapy, stable
Robert Eason	Crystal Gullledge's Father esophageal cancer metastasized to gastric cancer, chemo every 2 weeks to prevent regrowth; kidney function improving, scans good
Kris Eddins (Kelly)	Stage 4 melanoma in lungs has spread; liver counts high, radiation & surgery did not give results hoping for, some tumors grew plus & has additional tumors, <b>immunotherapy treatment last week, very sick for a couple of days, pray it slows down cancer growth &amp; does not attack liver like before</b> Betty H's SIL
Shelia Fuller	Multiple Myeloma; doing treatments Holly's SIL

<b>Scott Fuller</b>	ER with chest pains, heart OK, needle aspiration of nodule on thyroid came back benign, <b>partial thyroidectomy yesterday went well, experiencing some pain, should go home today</b> , took out the bad side, left the good side, will follow up every 6 months to a year as a precaution; <b>did stress test &amp; ECHO at heart doctor 30<sup>th</sup>, results 13<sup>th</sup></b>

<b>Ed Huey</b>	Cancer back of tongue, finished treatments; had left shoulder replacement, doctor dismissed; doing well after right knee replacement, in PT Huey's son
<b>Danny Lloyd (Danita)</b>	Donna Padgett's brother 4-inch mass on kidney, most likely cancer, surgery to remove kidney went well, stage 3 cancer, new scans 3 months, will do immunotherapy as a precaution, pray for continued good results
