<b>Ann Atkins</b>	recovering from spinal stenosis surgery in the neck, doing great, everything looked good at follow-up, bone stimulator to promote healing for 6 weeks, <b>follow-up Sept. 2, will talk about back surgery</b>
<b>Butch Clark</b>	prostate cancer but contained; finished radiation; PSA levels came down 3 points, PSA levels dropped another point, recheck in 3 months
<b>Jim Clark</b>	biopsy on nose showed basal cell, <b>appt. to remove 9/5 in Montgomery</b>
<b>Bob Daniel</b>	multiple myeloma; infusions & meds weekly, PT Thursdays; immune system so low they are discouraged from going out, not finished with treatments but only has to see the doctor once a month now; <b>Bob is doing much better, but Cheryl has terrible back pain</b>
<b>Betty K Dyson</b>	elbow doing ok, nerves still angry; biopsy right breast benign, cancer grade 1 stage 2, lumpectomy with 3 lymph nodes removed on left, 3 duct glands removed on right, no cancer in lymph nodes, tumor removed had one area close to margin, surgeon may want to go back in & get larger margin, ducts in right breast pre-cancer noninvasive carcinoma & completely removed, starting hormone pill that blocks body from producing estrogen, surgeon said healing beautifully, <b>will see radiologist Aug. 6<sup>th</sup> about treatment</b>
<b>Sonny Dyson</b>	TAVR procedure (minimally invasive valve replacement) went well, no permanent pacemaker necessary, getting a little more energy every day; had follow-up at eye doctor, has new contacts, pray he adjusts to them & his sight improves, follow-up end of July
<b>Glen &amp; Connie Elmore</b>	cancer has spread to lymph nodes and hip; at last scan, cancer has not spread & appears to be dormant
<b>Pete Harris</b>	Had another seizure that affects speech, lasted a while but better now, has had a few episodes of slurred speech, speech is better
<b>Robert &amp; Gayle Hawkins</b>	Strokes in brain stem weakened right side, doing great; <b>Robert</b> has "fuchs dystrophy", requires surgery in both eyes, surgery on right eye went well, vision much better, good report at follow-up for right eye, <b>will do left eye Aug. 6<sup>th</sup> ; Robert has a blood clot behind his left knee; doctor is trying to dissolve it with medication which may take up to 6 months</b>
<b>Dorothy Holdridge</b>	<b>Knee replacement on Tuesday</b>
<b>Bill &amp; Jan Holland</b>	Still having some tummy issues, dementia is hard, <b>struggling</b>
<b>Don Irving</b>	<b>Needs a procedure to implant a device called an ILR (implantation of loop), which records heart rhythm. He had 3 incidents where he blacked out and fell; waiting on insurance approval.</b>
<b>Mike Jones</b>	coverings on nerves from spine fraying, pinched nerve & nerve damage in right leg; pacemaker procedure was a success, scope went well and everything was fine, there is a newish procedure for reducing size of prostate only done at UAB, they will discuss further with urologist here before deciding
<b>Nita Kendall</b>	Recovering from knee replacement, getting better each day, looked good at follow-up, PT at wellness center
<b>Mike McGill</b>	<b>Pray for Mike and family; his brother passed away last week</b>

<b>Jimmy Peoples</b>	Mailed heart monitor back, waiting to hear results
<b>Billie Nell Sanford</b>	pray for Harriet & Scoon as caretakers; fell & broke hip, replaced ball joint, rehab Dadeville HealthCare Rm 203, trying hard with PT, maintaining, still dealing with catheter, pray her mobility continues to improve
<b>Elaine Smith</b>	Bulging disc
<b>Joyce Smith</b>	Fell, has 2 breaks below left shoulder, doctor said take it easy for about 6 more weeks, no lifting heavy things
<b>Wayne Smith</b>	Non-small cell lung cancer, CT scan showed tumor on lung was gone; finished radiation treatments, doing immunotherapy treatments (11 <sup>th</sup> ) scans looked good, no new areas of concern, other areas smaller, was not able to do immunotherapy treatment last Wed., will do more radiation; <b>went for treatment Monday but fell and has fracture around his eye; cut below the eye and abrasions to chin and arm</b>
<b>Karla Teel</b>	Biopsy of knots on neck showed recurrence of lobular breast cancer, brain MRI showed no cancer, does have 2 malignant spots on chest wall, when all tests from MDA are in and evaluated, they will determine treatment plan
<b>Jacky Thompson</b>	Retinal detachment & tear surgery, great report at last follow-up, can sit up now & sleep on his side, no patch, gas bubble is finally GONE, <b>follow-up August 3rd</b>
<b>Ramona Thornton</b>	Recovering from broken hip, repaired with plates & screws, doing better
<b>Marie Tidwell</b>	Facial pain back, met with oral surgeon, CT scan showed fragments in gum where 2 teeth were removed last year which has triggered atypical face pain & it is horrible, will schedule surgery as soon as get biopsy results of nodule on thyroid
<b>Judy Waters</b>	breast cancer, had lumpectomy July 25 <sup>th</sup> RMC: <b>says she is feeling great; God has blessed her</b>

<b>Janet Baggett</b>	79 home invasion, she was beaten and abused, pray for her mental health
<b>Greer Bailey</b>	3-year-old leukemia still in remission; treatments every Tuesday, pray for minimal side effects Ann A
<b>Julia Bethea</b>	Gail Missildine's sister surgery to remove tumor in right leg went well, will do regular PET scans & watch, tumor in other leg was not cancer, radiation will start as a precaution- 5 a wk for 6 wks
<b>Nicky Brown</b>	Peggy Kelley's Aunt health issues
<b>Baby Callan</b>	Brucile's niece's baby home but needs round-the-clock care, some better, scoots around on his back, has crawled up on a chair, gets around pretty good, has another appt. in 6 months (Jan.)
<b>Mary Catherine</b>	<b>Mary Belser's great-granddaughter, very sick, and doctors can't find the problem. Had MRI and x-rays, but still can't determine what is wrong; they are eliminating certain foods from her diet to see if that helps prayers needed</b>
<b>Rick Cole</b>	Cancer is back, removed large tumor on kidney & part of colon, will be a long recovery, pray for healing Kile's friend
<b>Patrick Cox</b>	After 4 surgeries on ankle finally good news, has walking cast, is a lot stronger, working on building up strength Hawkins SIL
<b>Junior Davis</b>	Bone cancer, PSA high, cancer has spread to back & shoulders, started radiation, will have 8 treatments, doctor changed his pain meds Holly

<b>Shelby Deaton</b>	Ann C's sister-in law cancer spread to bones, chemo & immunotherapy, stable
<b>Billy Deloach</b>	Chris Delach's Father (wife of Stacy Carter) cancer, starting treatment, will be getting 2 <sup>nd</sup> opinion at MDA as soon as possible Terrell Haggerty
<b>Robert Eason</b>	Crystal Gullledge's Father esophageal cancer metastasized to gastric cancer, chemo every 2 weeks to prevent regrowth; kidney function improving, scans good
<b>Kris Eddins (Kelly)</b>	Stage 4 melanoma in lungs has spread; liver counts high, radiation & surgery did not give results hoped for, some tumors grew & has additional tumors, was sick for a couple days after immunotherapy treatment, pray it slows down cancer growth & does not attack liver like before Betty H's SIL
<b>Charlotte Fuller</b>	Scott & Kaylan's 5-year-old daughter, <b>had surgery to remove the cyst on her ovary Monday ; removed the cyst and the ovary was saved; she was discharged Tuesday</b>
<b>Shelia Fuller</b>	Multiple Myeloma; weak after treatments but doing great Holly's SIL
<b>Scott Fuller</b>	Recovering from partial thyroidectomy July 1 <sup>st</sup> , took out the bad side, left the good side, will follow up every 6 months to a year as a precaution, follow up with surgeon 14 <sup>th</sup>
<b>Chris Futral</b>	Ginger Head's brother Pancreatic cancer has spread to liver & lungs, continuing treatments here, back to MD Anderson August
<b>Garner Graham (Patrick &amp; Hollin)</b>	Has a break from intensive therapy until October, will have another stem cell infusion in August/September, shows some signs of improvement, but it's going to be a long battle, doing well overall Graham's Grandson
<b>Sue Graham</b>	ASL instructor <b>PET scan showed she was cancer-free</b>
<b>Chris Green</b>	<b>Prostate cancer</b> Carol S
<b>Todd Huddleston (Kaye)</b>	Colon cancer has metastasized, did some chemo treatments, MDA said did not qualify because cancer too advanced, will do infusions to strengthen hip bones instead of surgery, started back chemo 2 <sup>nd</sup> , doing ok on chemo this time, bone infusion side effects are rough; Kaye has been diagnosed with breast cancer
<b>Ed Huey</b>	Cancer back of tongue, finished treatments; had left shoulder replacement, doctor dismissed; doing well after right knee replacement, in PT Huey's son
<b>Gene Huff Family</b>	<b>Gene passed away last Thursday morning. Please pray for the family, especially Gayle.</b>
<b>Candi Johnson</b>	Removed obstruction from intestine, path report confirmed cancer, 8/22 lymph nodes were positive, appt. with oncologist 15 <sup>th</sup> but will get 2 <sup>nd</sup> opinion June C.
<b>Danny Lloyd (Danita)</b>	Donna Padgett's brother removed kidney due to 4-inch mass, stage 3 cancer, new scans in 3 months, will do immunotherapy as a precaution, EAMC for A-flutter but home now, changed up some meds

<b>Robbie Royster</b>	Stage 4 stomach cancer, doing treatments Jeff Gullledge
<b>Lyn Scarbrough</b>	Recent scan showed no progression of stage 4 kidney cancer, losing weight & doctors not sure why Wayne I.
