<b>Wayne Daugherty</b>	<b>Hernia surgery Monday, August 18<sup>th</sup> Grandview Dr. Wood</b>
<b>Betty K Dyson</b>	elbow doing ok, nerves still angry; biopsy right breast benign, cancer grade 1 stage 2, lumpectomy with 3 lymph nodes removed on left, 3 duct glands removed on right, no cancer in lymph nodes, tumor removed had one area close to margin, surgeon may want to go back in & get larger margin, ducts in right breast pre-cancer noninvasive carcinoma & completely removed, starting hormone pill that blocks body from producing estrogen, surgeon said healing beautifully, <b>ready to begin radiation, 5 treatments starting soon (both breasts)</b>
<b>Sonny Dyson</b>	TAVR procedure (minimally invasive valve replacement) went well, no permanent pacemaker necessary, getting a little more energy every day, good report at follow-up with eye doctor, can see better with contacts than without, will continue pressure drops
<b>Glen &amp; Connie Elmore</b>	cancer has spread to lymph nodes and hip; at last scan, cancer has not spread & appears to be dormant
<b>Seth Foshee</b>	Kidney stone, put in a stent & broke up the stone home; <b>doing much better</b>
<b>Pete Harris</b>	Had another seizure that affects speech, lasted a while but better now, has had a few episodes of slurred speech, doing well
<b>Robert &amp; Gayle Hawkins</b>	Gail: Strokes in brain stem weakened right side, doing great; <b>Robert</b> has "fuchs dystrophy", requires surgery in both eyes, surgery on right eye went well, vision much better, good report at follow-up for right eye, <b>procedure to do left eye last Wed. went well; good report at follow-up on the 7<sup>th</sup>; had to add more oxygen in eye on 12<sup>th</sup> so had to lay flat 45/60 min. until noon today</b> ; has blood clot behind left knee; trying to dissolve it with meds, <b>follow up in Sept. for blood clot</b>

<b>Bill &amp; Jan Holland</b>	Still having some tummy issues, dementia is hard, <b>struggling</b>
<b>Jerry Hughes</b>	<b>Hip replacement Sept. 17<sup>th</sup> EAMC Shields</b>
<b>Don Irvin</b>	Needs a procedure to implant a device called an ILR (implantation of loop) which records heart rhythm, had 3 incidents where he blacked out and fell; <b>surgery August 19<sup>th</sup></b>
<b>Mike Jones</b>	coverings on nerves from spine fraying, pinched nerve & nerve damage in right leg; pacemaker procedure was a success, newish procedure for reducing size of prostate only done at UAB, will discuss with urologist here before deciding

<b>Kris Eddins (Kelly)</b>	Stage 4 melanoma in lungs has spread; liver counts high, radiation & surgery did not give results hoped for, some tumors grew & has additional tumors, was sick for a couple days after 1 <sup>st</sup> immunotherapy treatment, not so much with next one, pray it slows down cancer growth & does not attack liver like before; <b>MRI today to check progress of brain tumors</b> Betty H's SIL
<b>Charlotte Fuller</b>	Scott & Kaylan's 5-year-old daughter, had surgery to remove cyst on ovary, were able to save ovary; doing great, follow up Aug. 27 <sup>th</sup>

<b>Shelia Fuller</b>	Multiple Myeloma; weak after treatments but doing good, follow up in September Holly's SIL
<b>Chris Futral</b>	Ginger Head's brother Pancreatic cancer has spread to liver & lungs, continuing treatments here, back to MD Anderson August
<b>Garner Graham (Patrick &amp; Hollin)</b>	Has a break from intensive therapy until October, will have another stem cell infusion in August/September, shows some signs of improvement, but it's going to be a long battle, doing well overall Graham's Grandson

<b>Todd &amp; Kaye Huddleston</b>	Todd: Colon cancer has metastasized; Kaye: diagnosed with breast cancer went to MDA for tests, scans, and to meet with teams of doctors; <b>Todd got a good report, some of tumors are smaller, changed chemo to every other week, along with bone infusions to help with fatigue &amp; sickness; Kaye did get some clarity but back Tues. - Thurs. this week for more tests, as of now surgery is scheduled for Aug. 29 at MDA, won't know treatments necessary until a couple of weeks after surgery</b>
