Jim Clark	biopsy on nose showed basal cell, appt. to remove 9/5 in Montgomery
Bob Daniel	multiple myeloma; infusions & meds weekly, PT Thursdays; immune system so low they are discouraged from going out, not finished with treatments but only has to see the doctor once a month now; Bob is doing much better, but Cheryl has terrible back pain
Wayne Daugherty	Hernia surgery Monday, August 18th Grandview Dr. Wood went well & they were able to do it all robotically, had a good night Monday night, slept some, feels weak, but it was a major surgery, graduating to a thicker diet today, if he tolerates it well, he may be able to go home tomorrow
Betty K Dyson	elbow doing ok, nerves still angry; biopsy right breast benign, cancer grade 1 stage 2, lumpectomy with 3 lymph nodes removed on left, 3 duct glands removed on right, no cancer in lymph nodes, tumor removed had one area close to margin, surgeon may want to go back in & get larger margin, ducts in right breast pre-cancer noninvasive carcinoma & completely removed, taking hormone pill that blocks body from producing estrogen, surgeon said healing beautifully, started radiation Monday & finishes Friday
Sonny Dyson	TAVR procedure (minimally invasive valve replacement), no permanent pacemaker necessary, good report at follow-up with eye doctor, can see better with contacts than without, will continue pressure drops
Glen & Connie Elmore	cancer has spread to lymph nodes and hip; at last scan, cancer has not spread & appears to be dormant
Christy Harrison	some dental work was a little more than she bargained for, only soft foods
Robert & Gayle Hawkins	Gail: Strokes in brain stem weakened right side, doing great; Robert has "fuchs dystrophy", requires surgery in both eyes, surgery on right eye went well, vision much better, procedure to do left eye went well; good report at follow-up on the 7th; had to add more oxygen in eye on 12th so had to lay flat 45/60 min. for a couple days; has blood clot behind left knee; trying to dissolve it with meds, follow up in Sept. for blood clot

Dorothy Holdridge	Knee replacement surgery went well, her knee is doing great but she does not feel well, doctor gave her a steroid shot today
Bill & Jan Holland	Still having some tummy issues, dementia is hard, struggling
Brenda Hughes	Admitted to LMCH Friday with very high BP & low heart rate, discharged Sunday, still having BP & heart rate issues but have to deal with AFIB first
