Bill & Jan Holland	Still having some tummy issues, dementia is hard, <b>struggling</b>
<b>Brenda Hughes</b>	still having BP & heart rate issues but have to deal with AFIB first, <b>results of heart monitor showed she needs a pacemaker ASAP</b>

<b>Baby Callan</b> Brucile's niece's baby	home but needs round-the-clock care, some better, scoots around on his back, has crawled up on a chair, gets around pretty good, has another appt. in Jan.
<b>Rick Cole</b>	Cancer is back, removed large tumor on kidney & part of colon, <b>has liver cancer, will start chemo Monday</b> Kile's friend
<b>Junior Davis</b>	Bone cancer, PSA high, cancer spread to back & shoulders, finished radiation Holly
<b>Shelby Deaton</b>	Ann C's sister-in law cancer spread to bones, chemo & immunotherapy, stable
<b>Billy Deloach</b> Chris Deloach's Father (wife of Stacy Carter)	cancer, original nodule is bigger causing sharp pain when coughs, pray the pain meds they gave him help, pray new chemo (6 weeks) he helps, back to MDA mid-October Terrell Haggerty
<b>Robert Eason</b> Crystal Gullledge's Father	esophageal cancer metastasized to gastric cancer, chemo every 2 weeks to prevent regrowth; doing well but chemo has taken a toll
<b>Kris Eddins (Kelly)</b> Betty H's SIL	Stage 4 melanoma in lungs; liver counts high, after radiation & surgery some tumors grew & has new ones, immunotherapy treatments; MRI showed no growth, but new small tumor, did targeted radiation, started having vision seizures, found new fast-growing tumor, <b>did 3 targeted radiation treatments, some swelling so back on steroids, PET scan end of September</b>
<b>Shelia Fuller</b>	Multiple Myeloma; doing good Holly's SIL
<b>Chris Futral</b>	Ginger's brother Pancreatic cancer spread to liver & lungs, home with Hospice
<b>Garner Graham (Patrick &amp; Hollin)</b>	<b>Has had a couple of seizures, they are milder, but he is being referred to a program at Vanderbilt. He is better as far as seizures go... new meds... but his progress is not where we'd like it to be</b> Graham's Grandson
<b>Chris Green</b>	Prostate cancer, surgery this month, not a candidate for chemo, hoping doesn't need radiation Carol S
<b>Todd &amp; Kaye Huddleston</b>	<b>Todd:</b> Colon cancer metastasized, good report, some tumors smaller, chemo every other week, bone infusions to help with fatigue & sickness; <b>Kaye</b> breast cancer, surgery Aug. 29 at MDA went well, home recovering, won't know treatment plan for a couple weeks
<b>Ed Huey</b>	Cancer back of tongue, finished treatments; had left shoulder replacement & right knee replacement but decided no more surgery Huey's son

<b>Candi Johnson</b>	Removed obstruction from intestine, path report confirmed cancer, lymph nodes were positive, had PET scan, doing chemo, <b>at MDA all this week</b> June C.
