Dorothy Holdridge	Knee replacement went well, knee is doing great, still does not feel well
Bill & Jan Holland	Still having some tummy issues, dementia is hard, struggling
Brenda Hughes	still having BP & heart rate issues, have to deal with AFIB first, cardiologist said pacemaker not needed at this time, changed meds
Jerry Hughes	Hip replacement was flawless according to Shiels, had a rough bout with his stomach and initial pain was rough but his mobility is getting better every day, good report at follow-up today, everything looks good, back Oct 6th
Mike Jones	due to spinal stenosis having severe muscle/nerve spasms in right leg, will schedule MRI but rep from pacemaker company to put it in MRI mode, Left leg weak & muscle atrophying, epidural is helping; Monday at PT had an issue with heart, (hard palpitations & light headed & dizzy) so ECHO scheduled for Sept 25 th and nuclear stress test Oct 2 nd , will get results for both Oct. 22 nd
Peggy Kelley	Still coughing and doesn't get ablation for back pain until Friday
Herman Kile	had MOHS on 2 places on arm, would only do 2 MOHS procedures last week, 1 on his leg & 1 on his face, 1 place on his arm has healed, 3 more to go
Ray & Carol Kuykendall	Carol is waiting on results of a PET scan
Linda McGuirt	Surgery on hand September 22nd went well, removed a golf ball-sized mass from her hand, trying to stay ahead of pain with the meds, follow-up 2 wks
Hamp McKelvey	severe break in radius bone in or near growth plate, got hard cast
Yvonne Petty	Cellulitis
Brucile Peoples	Shingles, doing better

Dan Robertson	Injured shoulder at work a couple of weeks ago, surgery went well, lot of pain but staying on top of it, pray for his recovery, at follow-up got stitches out & had PT evaluation, has a long painful recovery ahead, don't expect him to return to work for at least 12 weeks, if not longer, which will be really difficult for him
Billie Nell Sanford	pray for Harriet & Scoon as caretakers; fell & broke hip, replaced ball joint, rehab Dadeville HealthCare Rm 203, pray mobility improves
Karla Teel	Biopsy of knots on neck showed recurrence of lobular breast cancer, brain MRI showed no cancer, 2 malignant spots on chest wall; doing treatments (3 weeks on, a week off for tests & after the 3 rd week a PET scan) side effects are rough

Robert Eason Crystal Gullede's Father	esophageal cancer metastasized to gastric cancer, chemo every 2 weeks to prevent regrowth; doing well but chemo has taken a toll

Kris Eddins (Kelly) Betty H's SIL	Stage 4 melanoma in lungs; liver counts high, after radiation & surgery some tumors grew & has new ones, immunotherapy treatments; MRI showed no growth, but new small tumor, did targeted radiation, started having vision seizures, found new fast-growing tumor, did 3 targeted radiation treatments, some swelling so back on steroids, PET scan Friday

Chris Green	Prostate cancer, surgery this month, not a candidate for chemo, hoping doesn't need radiation Carol S

Todd & Kaye Huddleston	Todd: Colon cancer metastasized, good report, some tumors smaller, chemo every other week, bone infusions to help with fatigue & sickness; Kaye breast cancer, surgery Aug. 29 at MDA went well, home recovering, won't know treatment plan for a couple weeks
Ed Huey	Cancer back of tongue, finished treatments; had left shoulder replacement & right knee replacement but decided no more surgery Huey's son
