Jerry Hughes	Hip replacement surgery went well, mobility is getting better, staples out, few infected spots so on antibiotics, slightly anemic & still little dehydrated, weak, tired, and bored to death, doing ok but wants to be better yesterday

Mike Jones	due to spinal stenosis having severe muscle/nerve spasms in right leg, will schedule MRI, Left leg weak & muscle atrophying, epidural is helping; had an issue with heart, (hard palpitations & light headed & dizzy) so ECHO scheduled and nuclear stress test, results for both Oct. 22nd
Peggy Kelley	got ablation for back pain , EAMC overnight Monday due to O2 being lower than they would like, found a small pocket of mucus which had started to form pneumonia, CT scan of sinuses looked good, home recovering, cough is better but still having back pain
Herman Kile	had several MOHS procedures & still has 3 more to go; leg still has not healed
Ray & Carol Kuykendall	Carol Grandview B'ham blockage in bowel, surgery went well & were able to do laparoscopic; doing better but really weak, still getting oxygen treatment & draining fluid
