Bob Daniel	multiple myeloma; pray he stays in remission, immune system low so discouraged from going out; Cheryl having terrible back pain, PT helping some
Nick Davis	Car wreck 10/15, broken sternum, broken ribs, fractures in back, no surgery needed; still very painful
Glen & Connie Elmore	cancer has spread to lymph nodes and hip; at last scan, cancer has not spread & appears to be dormant; good report at MDA
Mike Hammonds	Spinal stenosis, trying PT; needs knee replacement; EAMC ICU, still no definite answers, have not found anything with heart except pericarditis, will not draw off fluid because it can cause other issues since it is not congestive heart failure, still no answers for why he gets confused & disoriented, scheduling an MRI of the brain & some other tests, discharged Saturday
Pete Harris	Follow up today, good report from doctor, official results were very good
Robert & Gayle Hawkins	Gayle: Strokes in brain stem weakened right side, doing great; Robert "fuchs dystrophy" required surgery both eyes, right eye vision much better; bad news at follow up for left eye, eye graft went well, good report at follow-up but had to add oxygen, can see some out of that eye, next follow-up Dec. 2
Bill & Jan Holland	Still having some tummy issues, dementia is hard, struggling Bill's DIL contractions 7 weeks early, admitted & tried to stop but sent her home with meds, readmitted due to leaking amniotic fluid, home on bed rest
Jerry Hughes	Hip replacement surgery, good report at follow-up 3rd, next visit Dec 1
Mike Jones	due to spinal stenosis having severe muscle/nerve spasms in right leg, Left leg weak & muscle atrophying, epidural is helping; had an issue with heart, ECHO was good but nuclear stress test showed abnormality, results of CT scan on heart were great, nuclear stress test gave a false negative
Peggy Kelley	Still having back pain
Herman Kile	had several MOHS procedures & still has 3 more to go; leg beginning to heal, taking longer due to poor circulation
Ray & Carol Kuykendall	Laparoscopic surgery for blockage in bowel; rehab at Adam's Nursing, struggling with several health issues, transferred to Sylacauga, no visitors
Elizabeth McGukin	Kidney numbers better but still in dire straits, MOHS procedure could not be stitched; Grandview Rm. 722 – difficulty breathing, low BP, & low O2, blood clots in both lungs, on meds to dissolve them, did CT scan with contrast, heart & lungs are good, kidney function was good enough for them to go home Friday, scan showed a mass on the pancreas, biopsy Friday Dec. 5th outpatient at Grandview Dr. Dugum

Sophia Joy Missildine	pulmonary atresia: lack of pulmonary valve keeps blood from reaching lungs, labor induced Jan. 8 at UAB, surgical team will be ready to correct condition Missildine's unborn granddaughter
Butch Pierce Family	Butch passed away Tuesday night, please remember Beth & the girls
Dan Robertson	Injured shoulder, back & neck at work, shoulder surgery went well, has a long painful recovery ahead, can't return to work for at least 12 weeks, had oral surgery 29 th to close up a hole that opened into sinus cavity from an extraction a couple of years ago, soft foods for a week; outpatient spinal surgery went great, other than typical surgery pain he is doing great, he already has feeling back in his hand & arm for the first time in 9 weeks & even has some pain relief in his shoulder, follow-up x-ray & appt. with neurosurgeon Nov. 20th, will decide when he can resume PT
Karla Teel	Biopsy of knots on neck showed recurrence of lobular breast cancer, 2 malignant spots on chest wall; doing treatments (3 weeks on, a week off for tests & after the 3 rd week a PET scan) having a rough time, sleeping a lot

Billy Deloach Chris Deloach's Father	cancer, original nodule is bigger causing sharp pain when coughs, pray new chemo (6 weeks) helps, tests at MDA last week, still there due to having an episode while he was there Terrell Haggerty
Robert Eason Crystal Gullledge's Father	esophageal cancer metastasized to gastric cancer, finished chemo treatments, last 3 PET scans showed no cancer, due to cancer being stage 4 & inoperable he will continue immunotherapy once every other week for maintenance, 2 years of chemo has taken a toll & it will take a while for residual side effects to go away
Kris Eddins (Kelly) Betty H's SIL	Stage 4 melanoma in lungs; only 2 of original 4 spots on the lungs are visible and they are much smaller, blood work looked pretty good, MRI showed there were only 3 of original 5 spots on the brain and they are significantly smaller, still some swelling but not as much; UAB Thurs. 6 th for infusion therapy & bloodwork, and prednisone through IV, his liver count is through the roof, doing much better

Shelia Fuller	Multiple Myeloma; cancer-free, cardiologist said heart is weak, took off BP meds & put on med for heart & kidneys, stress test was good, waiting on additional test results Holly's SIL
Megan Giles Family	19-year-old killed when she was hit by car while crossing street in Tuscaloosa (Parents David & Callie) Ann Atkin's neighbors
PJ Godwin Family	She went to be with Jesus last Wednesday night, please pray especially for her mother Beverly Alexander (Jerry Strickland's friend)
Garner Graham (Patrick & Hollin)	being referred to a program at Vanderbilt. He is better as far as seizures go... new meds... but his progress is not where we'd like it to be Graham's Grandson
Chris Green	Prostate cancer, had surgery, readmitted to hospital with infection, home recovering, not a candidate for chemo, hoping no radiation Carol S
Terry Holdridge	Mrs. Dorothy's son
Todd & Kaye Huddleston	Todd: Colon cancer metastasized, not best report at follow-up at MDA, trying a new chemo; Kaye breast cancer, surgery at MDA went well, no chemo, 20 rounds of radiation & hormone therapy for 5 years
Ed Huey	Cancer back of tongue, finished treatments; had left shoulder replacement & right knee replacement but decided no more surgery Huey's son
Paul Irvin	Lots of health problems – legally blind, appt. in B'ham
Margie James	94 years old, adjusting to assisted living Wayne D's aunt
Candi Johnson	Cancer started in colon, now in liver, tumors in lungs not cancer, finished first 6 chemos, did scan, results showed 1 of 3 spots on liver is smaller & 1 is barely visible, had 7th chemo yesterday June C.
Charles "Bugs" Jordan Debra Knight's stepdad	Knee replacement, readmitted with pneumonia, sepsis & kidney failure, rehab for a month without much progress, needed blood transfusions due to internal bleed, coded & was life flighted to UAB, has bleeding ulcers, biopsies were negative for cancer, back at Lineville rehab doing better
Danny Lloyd (Danita)	Donna Padgett's brother kidney removed due to 4-inch mass, stage 3 cancer, doing immunotherapy as a precaution
Nancy Lloyd	Donna Padgett's Mother lung cancer (Dec.) Hospice pray for Donna as caretaker
Baby Callan Long Brucile's niece's baby	2-year-old, home but needs round-the-clock care, cannot walk, recent surgery, 100 stitches in head
Scott Medlen	Bill Turner's friend surgery to insert LVAD (left ventricle assist device) went well, in hospital for a couple of weeks; has heart failure, hopefully this will prepare him for a heart transplant
Wesley Moran John Wilcox	Stroke caused loss of ability to swallow; still losing weight, tube feeding is challenging, currently in hospital, transferred to St. Vincents, his stomach is the issue not his intestines, there is a pocket of air & infection, neurosurgeon found area of concern (blood & hemorrhaged area on CT) not still bleeding so no surgery, ulcer & possibly another mild stroke, still weak & dizzy, treating with meds

Kay Nix	Mantle cell lymphoma, cancer has come back, doing treatments Holly

Sheree Orr	Valve replacement surgery went well, home recovering
John Phillips	Cancer, diabetic, 2 shots a day Ann Clark
Sharon Phillips	large hematoma on leg got infected, skin grafts went well Jim Clark's sister
Glenda Pinckard	Myopic degeneration, losing her eyesight Russ' Mom

William Ware	Dorothy Holdridge's brother Alzheimer's, at The Phoenix, continue prayers
Lynne Warren Brenda B. SIL	terminal stage 4 cancer throat & tailbone; finished 5 chemo's & 13 radiations, radiation helped cancer in esophagus, no cancer in organs or bones, increasing immunotherapy to two every 3 weeks
