Bill Francis	Bill has been told he is not a candidate for surgery due to his heart condition and age, back Friday for a stent in his widow-maker artery, had too much dye in his system from the tests to do it last Wednesday
Mike Hammonds	Spinal stenosis, trying PT; needs knee replacement; Dr. Sharma pleased with progress but still weak, appt. with Rajendra 23 rd , depending on what he says about Afib, he may do some cardiac rehab, PET scan scheduled for December 11th; Jeannie test results from cardiologist today, retina specialist wants to make sure there is no abnormal vein growth in her eye, she did have a stroke in that eye & has lost a 3rd of her vision
Mike Hilyer	Recovering from left shoulder replacement Nov. 21, first PT was rough, learning to take the Tylenol and not overdo, working some
Bill & Jan Holland	Still having some tummy issues, dementia is hard, struggling
Jerry Hughes	good report at last follow-up after hip replacement, having some back pain
Mike Jones	due to spinal stenosis having severe muscle/nerve spasms in right leg, Left leg weak & muscle atrophying, epidural is helping
Elizabeth McGukin	Kidney numbers better but still in dire straits, MOHS procedure could not be stitched; CT scan with contrast showed heart & lungs are good, scan showed a mass on pancreas, biopsy of pancreas showed no cause for concern
Dan Robertson	Injured shoulder, back & neck at work, shoulder surgery went well, spinal surgery went great, neck is improving, almost has complete range of motion back, shoulder is slow but steady progress
Karla Teel	Biopsy of knots on neck showed recurrence of lobular breast cancer, 2 malignant spots on chest wall; doing treatments (3 weeks on, a week off for tests & after the 3 rd week a PET scan) white blood cell count is so low have stopped chemo until the 18th when she sees the doctor for bloodwork, feeling ok
Sharon Traylor	Heart ablation rescheduled for January 12 th feeling much better after having to reschedule due to pneumonia Dr. Rejenda at Grandview outpatient
John Wilcox	Broke his arm Tuesday afternoon, appt. with ortho doctor Thursday afternoon, doing ok as long as the pain meds keep working

Kris Eddins (Kelly) Betty H's SIL	Stage 4 melanoma lungs; only 2 of original 4 spots on lungs visible, they are smaller, only 3 of original 5 spots on the brain, they are significantly smaller, some swelling but not as much; prednisone through IV, liver count is through the roof, doing much better
Shelia Fuller	Multiple Myeloma; cancer-free, off BP meds, on med for heart & kidneys, stress test was good, waiting on additional test results, COVID Holly's SIL
Garner Graham (Patrick & Hollin)	being referred to program at Vanderbilt, better as far as seizures go... new meds... but progress is not where we'd like it to be Graham's Grandson
Chris Green	Prostate cancer, had surgery, readmitted to hospital with infection, home recovering, not a candidate for chemo, hoping no radiation Carol S
Terry Holdridge	Mrs. Dorothy's son
Todd & Kaye Huddleston	Todd: Colon cancer metastasized, not best report at follow-up at MDA, trying a new chemo; Kaye breast cancer, surgery at MDA went well, no chemo, 20 rounds of radiation & hormone therapy for 5 years
Ed Huey	Cancer back of tongue, finished treatments; had left shoulder replacement & right knee replacement but decided no more surgery Huey's son
Paul Irvin	Lots of health problems – legally blind
Mary Jennings	LMCH last Sunday with virus & went to rehab, transferred to Grandview last Thurs., out of ICU but still a long way to go
Candi Johnson	Cancer started in colon, now in liver, finished first 6 chemos, did scan, results showed 1 of 3 spots on liver smaller & 1 barely visible, started 2 nd round of 6 chemo treatments, MDA this week June C.
Charles "Bugs" Jordan Debra Knight's stepdad	Knee replacement, readmitted with pneumonia, sepsis & kidney failure, has bleeding ulcers, biopsies negative for cancer, home from rehab, improving but doesn't do much, PT, OT & Home Health
Danny Lloyd (Danita)	Donna Padgett's brother kidney removed due to 4-inch mass, stage 3 cancer, doing immunotherapy as a precaution
Nancy Lloyd	Donna Padget's Mother lung cancer (Dec.) Hospice pray for Donna as caretaker
Baby Callan Long Brucile's niece's baby	2-year-old, home but needs round-the-clock care, surgery helped, doing better

Brandon McGuirt	Still having severe migraines possibly due to growth spurt
Sophia Joy Missildine Missildine's unborn granddaughter (Mom Amanda)	Delivered by C-section last night, Amanda is still at UAB doing ok; Sophia was transferred to Children's Cardiac Unit to prep for surgery (pulmonary atresia: lack of pulmonary valve keeps blood from reaching lungs) no word yet on time of surgery
Wesley Moran John Wilcox	Stroke caused loss of ability to swallow; tube feeding is challenging, has bleeding ulcer & possibly had another mild stroke, treating with meds, brain bleed not completely cleared, another CT scan in 4 weeks, no energy, still can't eat
Elizabeth Mosley Tina Bryan's DIL's Mother	recurrence of breast cancer, finished chemo, removed 8 lymph nodes, just finished 24 radiation treatments and is in remission
Kay Nix	Mantle cell lymphoma, cancer has come back, doing treatments Holly

Sheree Orr	Valve replacement surgery, doing well but not released to go back to work yet
