Ann Atkins	recovering from spinal stenosis surgery neck, still has bone stimulator to promote healing, has been battling UTI, after 2 rounds of antibiotics, a round of injections & a hospital stay for IV antibiotics, white count is still up, referring to urologist, has large kidney stone, white count still up, Littman gave another oral antibiotic, urologist January 29 th , had to cancel back surgery, will see surgeon Feb. 12 th , will have to start over with insurance approval etc.
Paul Bowser	Recovering from another bout of double pneumonia, doing better
Bob Daniel	multiple myeloma; pray he stays in remission, immune system low so discouraged from going out; Cheryl having terrible back pain, PT helping some
Glen & Connie Elmore	cancer has spread to lymph nodes and hip; at last scan, cancer has not spread & appears to be dormant, going to MDA for a month
Bill Francis	Bill has been told he is not a candidate for surgery due to his heart condition and age, placement of stent went well but it has really not helped, multiple health issues
Mike Hammonds	Spinal stenosis, needs knee replacement; Dr. Sharma pleased with progress but still weak, wearing a heart monitor; Jeannie good report from cardiologist, turned in heart monitor Jan. 9, retina specialist checking for abnormal vein growth in eye, stroke in left eye, lost a 3 rd of her vision
Bill & Jan Holland	Still having some tummy issues, dementia is hard, struggling
Jerry Hughes	Dealing with infection in hip, starting to get better, off blood thinners in case they do surgery next week to clean out infection
Elizabeth McGukin	Kidney numbers better with a very strict diet, going through several MOHS procedures on 6 places on her legs, lungs are clear but heart is enlarged due to it holding fluid, lung scan today to determine amount of O² flowing through lungs and amount of blood flowing through lungs from heart
Amanda Motes	had atrial flutter (top part of heart went crazy, bottom normal) defibrillator shocked her 3 times, cardiologist increased meds to regulate it & lowered BP meds, vertigo possibly from BP dropping, waiting for an appointment for an ablation
Dan Robertson	Injured shoulder, back & neck at work, shoulder surgery went well, spinal surgery went great, neck improving, almost has complete range of motion back, shoulder is slow but steady progress, at follow up Monday doctor said he still can't use his left arm so he can't return to work, ordering MRI of shoulder due to amount of pain he is still having, pray PT continues to improve his shoulder & neck so he can return to work; this recovery has been tough physically & mentally!
Karla Teel	Biopsy of knots on neck showed recurrence of lobular breast cancer, 2 malignant spots on chest wall; doing treatments (3 weeks on, a week off for tests & after the 3 rd week a PET scan) follow up with oncologist today to see if numbers are up so she can finish the last 21 days of chemo, MDA Feb. 1 for a battery of tests & to schedule surgery
Sharon Traylor	Heart ablation January 12th went well, got her out of Afib & atrial flutter
Jim White	MRI results - needs surgery, looking for a doctor
John Wilcox	Broke arm, surgery not needed, can't cast due to location of break
David Williams	Back surgery last Wed. was a huge success, felt immediate relief, home Thurs., will be several weeks before he can start PT
Kathy Williams	Surgery went well, no stones, swelling is from previous surgery, put in stent to remain 2-3 weeks, saw urologist Monday, stent will stay in til mid March, gave meds to help with spasms, going to PT, very uncomfortable

Raymond Yancy (Laura)	Very ill, broke femur, required surgery, fell Monday, at EAMC, in a lot of pain & discouraged, please pray Humana will approve more rehab, much better today

Kris Eddins (Kelly) Betty H's SIL	Stage 4 melanoma lungs metastasized to brain, liver count almost normal
Shelia Fuller	Multiple Myeloma; cancer-free, off BP meds, on med for heart & kidneys; bronchitis is better, echocardiogram scheduled, doing maintenance chemo pills Holly's SIL
Garner Graham (Patrick & Hollin)	being referred to program at Vanderbilt, better as far as seizures go... new meds... but progress is not where we'd like it to be Graham's Grandson
Johnny Graham	Severe case of the flu, pray he will recover & regain his strength before Sue comes home from rehab
Sue Graham	Our ASL teacher regular room yesterday but may have to go back to ICU, concerns with oxygen levels, holding on to CO² will be allowed to stay in regular room as long as she agrees to go back on the oxygen mask, GOING TO REHAB TODAY
Chris Green	Prostate cancer, had surgery, not a candidate for chemo, hoping no radiation Carol S
Jerry Harvey	Brain tumor surgery, glioblastoma, terminal Nanci Speagle
Todd & Kaye Huddleston	Todd: Colon cancer metastasized, not best report at follow-up at MDA, trying a new chemo; Kaye breast cancer, surgery at MDA went well, no chemo, 20 rounds of radiation & hormone therapy for 5 years
Ed Huey	Cancer back of tongue, finished treatments; had left shoulder replacement & right knee replacement but decided no more surgery; PET scan was clear Huey's son
Paul Irvin	Lots of health problems – legally blind
Candi Johnson	Cancer started in colon, now in liver, finished first 6 chemos, did scan, results showed 1 of 3 spots on liver smaller & 1 barely visible, 2 nd round of 6 chemo treatments, great report at MDA, 2 spots barely visible and the other one smaller, hopefully even better results after next round of chemo June C.
Charles "Bugs" Jordan	Knee replacement, readmitted with pneumonia, sepsis & kidney failure, has bleeding ulcers, biopsies negative for cancer, home from rehab, improving but doesn't do much, PT, OT & Home Health Debra Knight's stepdad
Danny Lloyd (Danita)	Donna Padgett's brother kidney removed due to 4-inch mass, stage 3 cancer, doing immunotherapy as a precaution
Nancy Lloyd	Donna Padgett's Mother lung cancer (Dec.) Hospice pray for Donna as caretaker
Baby Callan Long Brucile's niece's baby	2-year-old, home but needs round-the-clock care, surgery helped, doing better

Brandon McGuirt	Still having severe migraines possibly due to growth spurt
Wesley Moran John Wilcox	Stroke caused loss of ability to swallow; tube feeding is challenging, has bleeding ulcer & possibly had another mild stroke, treating with meds, brain bleed not completely cleared, still can't eat; doc appt. today to check for healing of last brain bleed, neurologist at UAB Thursday, doing about the same, but not worse
Kay Nix	Mantle cell lymphoma, cancer came back, finished chemo, other health issues Holly
Kyle Orr	congestive heart failure Carolyn Alexander's brother
Sheree Orr	Valve replacement surgery, doing well back at work
Pam Patterson	Princeton Baptist B'ham with intestinal blockage, PRAISE will not require surgery, on a liquid diet, will keep her a couple of days Josh's Mom
John Phillips	Cancer, diabetic, 2 shots a day, Ann Clark
Sharon Phillips	Procedure for veins in legs
Glenda Pinckard	Myopic degeneration, losing her eyesight Russ' Mom
