Ann Atkins	recovering from spinal stenosis surgery neck, still has bone stimulator to promote healing, has been battling UTI, after 2 rounds of antibiotics, a round of injections & a hospital stay for IV antibiotics, white count is still up, referring to urologist, has large kidney stone, white count still up, Littman gave another oral antibiotic, can't see urologist til end of January, had to cancel back surgery, will see surgeon Feb. 12 <sup>th</sup> , will have to start over with insurance approval etc.

<b>Paul Bowser</b>	in hospital again with double pneumonia, <b>home on O<sup>2</sup> &amp; antibiotics, not doing well</b>
<b>Bob Daniel</b>	multiple myeloma; pray he stays in remission, immune system low so discouraged from going out; Cheryl having terrible back pain, PT helping some
<b>Glen &amp; Connie Elmore</b>	cancer has spread to lymph nodes and hip; at last scan, cancer has not spread & appears to be dormant, <b>going to MDA for a month</b>
<b>Bill Francis</b>	Bill has been told he is not a candidate for surgery due to his heart condition and age, <b>placement of stent went well but it has really not helped, multiple health issues</b>
<b>Mike Hammonds</b>	Spinal stenosis, needs knee replacement; Dr. Sharma pleased with progress but still weak, <b>wearing a heart monitor; PET Jeannie good report from cardiologist, wearing a heart monitor until Jan. 9</b> , retina specialist checking for abnormal vein growth in eye, stroke in left eye, lost a 3 <sup>rd</sup> of her vision
<b>Mike Hilyer</b>	Recovering from left shoulder replacement Nov. 21, <b>PT days are rough</b> , learning to take the Tylenol and not overdo, working some
<b>Bill &amp; Jan Holland</b>	Still having some tummy issues, dementia is hard, <b>struggling</b>
<b>Jerry Hughes</b>	<b>Dealing with infection in hip, starting to get better, Shiels will give another week</b>
<b>Elizabeth McGukin</b>	Kidney numbers better but still in dire straits
<b>Amanda Motes</b>	had atrial flutter (top part of heart went crazy, bottom normal) defibrillator shocked her 3 times, cardiologist increased meds to regulate it & lowered BP meds, vertigo possibly from BP dropping, <b>waiting for an appointment for an ablation</b>
<b>Doug Reid</b>	Recovering from shoulder replacement Dec. 12 <sup>th</sup>
<b>Dan Robertson</b>	Injured shoulder, back & neck at work, shoulder surgery went well, spinal surgery went great, neck improving, almost has complete range of motion back, shoulder is slow but steady progress
<b>Karla Teel</b>	Biopsy of knots on neck showed recurrence of lobular breast cancer, 2 malignant spots on chest wall; doing treatments (3 weeks on, a week off for tests & after the 3 <sup>rd</sup> week a PET scan) <b>CT scan came back atypical pneumonia, waiting this week to try to get appointments, they said the breast area looked better</b>
<b>Sharon Traylor</b>	<b>Heart ablation January 12<sup>th</sup></b> Dr. Rejenda at Grandview outpatient
<b>John Wilcox</b>	<b>Broke arm, surgery not needed, can't cast due to location of break</b>
<b>David Williams</b>	<b>Back surgery today EAMC, surgery started at 3:16, will stay one night</b>
<b>Kathy Williams</b>	Surgery went well, no stones, swelling is from previous surgery, put in stent to remain 2-3 weeks, <b>saw urologist Monday, stent will stay in til mid March, gave meds to help with spasms</b>
<b>Raymond Yancy (Laura)</b>	Very ill, broke femur, required surgery, <b>will be in rehab until Tues. Jan. 13<sup>th</sup>, checking on home rehab &amp; assistance</b>

<b>Wayne Counts</b> Seth Foshee's stepdad	kidneys only functioning at 14%. When gets to 10% he will need dialysis which he says he will not do, based on previous lab results will be 10% by January
<b>Kenny Davis</b>	Carol Turner's Brother recovering from triple bypass surgery, <b>doing well</b> , can go back to work Feb 19
<b>Shelby Deaton</b>	Ann C's sister-in law cancer spread to bones, chemo & immunotherapy, stable
<b>Jerry Deaton</b>	<b>ICU St. Vincent with heart &amp; liver issues</b> Ann Clark's brother
<b>Robert Eason</b> Crystal Gullledge's Father	esophageal cancer metastasized to gastric cancer, finished chemo treatments, last 3 PET scans showed no cancer, due to cancer being stage 4 & inoperable he will continue immunotherapy once every other week for maintenance, 2 years of chemo has taken a toll & it will take a while for residual side effects to go away

<b>Shelia Fuller</b>	Multiple Myeloma; cancer-free, off BP meds, on med for heart & kidneys; <b>struggling with acute bronchitis</b> Holly's SIL
<b>Garner Graham (Patrick &amp; Hollin)</b>	being referred to program at Vanderbilt, better as far as seizures go... new meds... but progress is not where we'd like it to be Graham's Grandson
<b>Sue Graham</b>	Our ASL teacher <b>back in ICU due to some concerns with oxygen levels</b>
<b>Chris Green</b>	Prostate cancer, had surgery, not a candidate for chemo, hoping no radiation Carol S
<b>Todd &amp; Kaye Huddleston</b>	<b>Todd:</b> Colon cancer metastasized, not best report at follow-up at MDA, trying a new chemo; <b>Kaye</b> breast cancer, surgery at MDA went well, no chemo, 20 rounds of radiation & hormone therapy for 5 years
<b>Ed Huey</b>	Cancer back of tongue, finished treatments; had left shoulder replacement & right knee replacement but decided no more surgery; <b>PET scan this afternoon</b> Huey's son
<b>Paul Irvin</b>	Lots of health problems – legally blind
<b>Candi Johnson</b>	Cancer started in colon, now in liver, finished first 6 chemos, did scan, results showed 1 of 3 spots on liver smaller & 1 barely visible, 2 <sup>nd</sup> round of 6 chemo treatments, MDA last week June C.
<b>Charles "Bugs" Jordan</b>	Knee replacement, readmitted with pneumonia, sepsis & kidney failure, has bleeding ulcers, biopsies negative for cancer, home from rehab, improving but doesn't do much, PT, OT & Home Health Debra Knight's stepdad
<b>Danny Lloyd (Danita)</b>	Donna Padgett's brother kidney removed due to 4-inch mass, stage 3 cancer, doing immunotherapy as a precaution
<b>Nancy Lloyd</b>	Donna Padgett's Mother lung cancer (Dec.) Hospice <b>pray for Donna as caretaker</b>
<b>Baby Callan Long</b> Brucile's niece's baby	2-year-old, home but needs round-the-clock care, surgery helped, doing better
<b>Brandon McGuirt</b>	Still having severe migraines possibly due to growth spurt
<b>Wesley Moran</b> John Wilcox	Stroke caused loss of ability to swallow; tube feeding is challenging, has bleeding ulcer & possibly had another mild stroke, treating with meds, brain bleed not completely cleared, another CT scan in 3 weeks, no energy, still can't eat
<b>Elizabeth Mosley</b>	recurrence of breast cancer, finished chemo, removed 8 lymph nodes, just finished 24 radiation treatments and is in remission Tina Bryan's DIL's Mother
<b>Kay Nix</b>	Mantle cell lymphoma, cancer came back, finished chemo, other health issues Holly
<b>Kyle Orr</b>	congestive heart failure Carolyn Alexander's brother
<b>Sheree Orr</b>	Valve replacement surgery, doing well but not released to go back to work yet
<b>John Phillips</b>	Cancer, diabetic, 2 shots a day, Ann Clark
<b>Glenda Pinckard</b>	Myopic degeneration, losing her eyesight Russ' Mom
<b>Susan Price</b>	Cancer has spread to brain, <b>treatments at MDA</b> Nita K's daughter
<b>Janice Sanders</b> Greg's Mom	flipped car several times, fell & fractured her spine, at home from rehab, in a brace, <b>physically she is doing better, please pray for her emotional &amp; spiritual health</b>
<b>Lyn Scarbrough (Cindy)</b>	stage 4 kidney cancer, doing well with new chemo other than bouts of low energy Wayne I.
