<b>Mike Hammonds</b>	Spinal stenosis, needs knee replacement; <b>GP released to start PT, stress test &amp; carotid ultrasound scheduled, appt. with Rajendra yesterday, pray they can figure out why he has no energy</b>
<b>Jan Holland</b>	<b>LMCH Sunday afternoon, dehydrated &amp; diverticulitis, doing well physically, started on some fruit Tuesday &amp; not handling food well yet, can't go home until she can</b>
<b>Jerry Hughes</b>	infection in hip getting better, follow up every 3 weeks
<b>Elizabeth McGukin (Jerry)</b>	Kidney numbers better with a very strict diet, going through several MOHS procedures on 6 places on her legs, lung scan: lungs are clear but heart is enlarged due to holding fluid, follow up in 3 months (Jan.) <b>good report from kidney doctor, kidney function up from 19 to 35, from stage 4 to stage 3B</b>
<b>Dan Robertson (Jennifer)</b>	Injured shoulder, back & neck at work, shoulder surgery went well, spinal surgery went great, neck improving, 2 <sup>nd</sup> surgery to repair shoulder went well, in a lot of pain, but trying to hang in there; follow up yesterday 2/10/26, pain & meds continue, in a sling for at least 6 more weeks, <b>started passive PT last week, it's going well, painful but grateful to be making progress although it's slow</b>
<b>Holly Robinson</b>	OT for hands, PT for knees
<b>Karla Teel (Donnie)</b>	Biopsy of knots on neck showed recurrence of lobular breast cancer, 2 malignant spots on chest wall; doing treatments (3 weeks on, a week off for tests & after the 3 <sup>rd</sup> week a PET scan) last PET showed no new spots, original 2 spots a little smaller, will do one more round of chemo before scheduling surgery, <b>started chemo last Friday</b> (pre surgery consults week of May 20)
<b>Jim White</b>	<b>Phoenix City Rehab 3715 US 431 Phoenix City, AL 36867 Rm. 106</b> <b>Update from Jennifer Monday... doing much the same but no worse, PT is exhausting him but they are going at his speed, his cough adds to feeling worn out, still weak, praying he will get stronger every day</b>
<b>David Williams</b>	Home recovering from back surgery, it was a huge success, felt immediate relief, will be several weeks before he can start PT; gaining a little strength every day
<b>Kathy Williams</b>	Surgery went well, no stones, swelling from previous surgery, stent is out, <b>doing better</b>
