Geri Cochran	mass behind right eye is a tumor. It will stay contained, & our prayer is that it is not fast-growing. She does not want a biopsy done. She goes back in 2 months for another MRI. If it does appear to be fast-growing, there are meds she can take to slow it down

Jan Holland	Dadeville HealthCare rehab, Room 210; would like visitors
Jerry Hughes	infection in hip getting better, follow up once a month
Elizabeth McGukin (Jerry)	Kidney numbers better with a very strict diet, going through several MOHS procedures on 6 places on her legs, lung scan: lungs are clear but heart is enlarged due to holding fluid, follow up in 3 months (Jan.) good report from kidney doctor, kidney function up from 19 to 35, from stage 4 to stage 3B
Dan Robertson (Jennifer)	Injured shoulder, back & neck at work, shoulder surgery went well, spinal surgery went great, neck improving, 2 <sup>nd</sup> surgery to repair shoulder went well, in a lot of pain, but trying to hang in there; follow up 2/10/26, pain & meds continue, pray for his recovery
Karla Teel (Donnie)	Biopsy of knots on neck showed recurrence of lobular breast cancer, 2 malignant spots on chest wall; doing treatments (3 weeks on, a week off for tests & after the 3 <sup>rd</sup> week a PET scan) last PET showed no new spots, original 2 spots a little smaller, will do one more round of chemo before scheduling surgery, started another round of chemo, side effects are rough (pre surgery consults week of May 20)
Donna Turner	Diagnostic Test March 19 <sup>th</sup>
Jim White	Home from rehab on Monday, doing pretty good, appreciates the prayers; follow up Thursday, 3/12
David Williams	Home recovering from back surgery, it was a huge success, immediate relief, starts PT Friday, 3-13
Kathy Williams	Surgery went well, no stones, swelling from previous surgery, stent is out, doing better
Raymond Yancey (Laura)	Very ill, broke femur, put a rod in his leg & a plate in his hip, fell & broke arm but could not cast, they seem to be healing well; has someone to help at home and home health, doing ok

<b>Kris Eddins (Kelly)</b> Betty H's SIL	Stage 4 melanoma lungs metastasized to brain, cancer-free from the neck down, still has one tiny spot on his brain
<b>Shelia Fuller</b>	Multiple Myeloma; cancer-free, echocardiogram showed leak in aorta valve, heart rate 45, changed meds, <b>kidney issues related to having cancer, will see specialist in June, put her back on maintenance meds</b> Holly's SIL
<b>Tom &amp; Shelia Godfrey</b> 3/4/26	Duke Hospital NC Esophageal cancer metastasized to several places, almost done with last cancer treatment they can try, if scan in 2 weeks shows no progress they will stop, there is currently not a chemical trial for his type of cancer & could not do immunotherapy; Shelia is recovering from a 3 <sup>rd</sup> eye surgery resulting from a pressure washer injury

<b>Terry Holdridge</b>	White blood count up, <b>appt. 12<sup>th</sup></b>

<b>Candi Johnson</b>	Cancer started in colon, now in liver, scans after chemo showed 1 of 3 spots on liver smaller & 1 barely visible, great report at MDA, 2 spots barely visible and the other one smaller, finished chemo, back to MDA this month June C.
<b>Charles "Bugs" Jordan</b>	Issues after knee replacement, PT, OT & Home Health, can walk a little with the walker, he's depressed, which is understandable, but God has answered prayers Debra Knight's stepdad
<b>Timothy Kanne (Leanna)</b>	Abdominal cancer stage 4, appendix burst & it was full of cancer, medical student at AU, has a 13-month-old baby, late 20's Ginger met on last trip to MDA
<b>Danny Lloyd (Danita)</b>	Donna Padgett's brother kidney removed due to 4-inch mass, stage 3 cancer, immunotherapy every 6 weeks until August, side effects starting to be noticeable, pray they are tolerable
<b>Nancy Lloyd</b>	Donna Padgett's Mother lung cancer (Dec.) Hospice, doing ok, getting over bronchitis, cold winter days are hard cause she can't get out, pray for Donna as caretaker
<b>Marsha</b>	Removed kidney Monday, lot of pain initially but home Thursday; <b>doing great after surgery, still waiting on results of pathology report</b> Jane Kile
<b>Brandon McGuirt</b>	Still having severe migraines, new doctor took off all meds for a month 1/28/26 then he will start a new regimen
<b>Rita McKelvey</b>	Struggling with pain, <b>knee &amp; hip on left are full of arthritis, will treat with heavy meds but at huge disadvantage with best meds due to them causing kidney issues</b>
<b>Wesley Moran</b> John Wilcox	Stroke caused loss of ability to swallow; had brain bleed, still struggling, PT Mondays & Wednesdays in Opelika

<b>Judy Morgan</b>	Heart attack last Tuesday, heart cath with 2 stents Thursday, home Friday but passed out & hit head, so back to hospital, home recovering Brenda Hughes
<b>Kay Nix</b>	Mantle cell lymphoma, cancer came back, doing well Holly
<b>Kyle Orr (Sheree)</b>	congestive heart failure, kidney numbers not good, <b>home with Hospice</b> Carolyn Alexander's brother
<b>Jenny Peoples</b>	<b>gall bladder surgery scheduled for March 31<sup>st</sup></b>
<b>John Phillips</b>	Cancer, diabetic, 2 shots a day, Ann Clark

<b>Susan Price</b>	Cancer has spread to brain, <b>treatments at MDA</b> Nita K's daughter

<b>Margaret Robinson</b>	EAMC with gall bladder issues, stabilized & discharged, had follow-up with GP, <b>appt. with surgeon March 16<sup>th</sup></b>
<b>Billy Sanders</b>	Cancer returned in eye, not a candidate for surgery to remove eye because heart has too much damage, doctors gave him the choice of open heart surgery, if he doesn't, only has a couple months to live Susan Tittle
<b>Janice Sanders</b>	Recovering from car accident and fractured spine, <b>pray for her physical &amp; emotional health</b> Greg's Mom
<b>Lyn Scarbrough (Cindy)</b>	stage 4 kidney cancer, scan showed no new cancer & 27% reduction in tumor size Wayne I.
<b>Benjamin Smith</b>	John Jernigan 8-year-old cousin cancer, final phase of treatment, maintenance monthly, will finish Dec. 2026; treatment weeks are hard, side effects are brutal, had a few unplanned breaks from chemo due to low counts, 10 more months of active treatment
<b>Crystal Strickland</b>	Jerry's niece rare liver disease, was on active transplant list 1 day, has some kind of virus so off again, pray she will stay well so she can get back on the active list; <b>still on waiting list</b>
<b>Cooper Strickland</b>	<b>Parents Glen &amp; Kendra</b> , Open heart surgery at 2 months (his 5 <sup>th</sup> surgery), still has a long way to go, but got to go home Jenny Peoples
<b>Warren Thomas</b>	5-year-old leukemia, in school, treatments every 2 weeks, improving; <b>will have a test to make sure he is still in remission</b> Jane Kile
<b>Casey Turner</b>	rare cancer located in sweat gland in breast, surgery went well, removed mass & 1 lymph node, lymph node was benign, CT scan for pain in stomach, cancelled appt. with oncologist due to her Mom (Sharon) being hospitalized, she is primary caregiver for her mother who probably only has til end of year to live Kimberly Pitchford
