<b>Pete Harris</b>	Hip pain caused by sciatica, doctor gave him a shot & steroids, <b>feeling some better, doing his exercises that seem to be helping and using a walker</b>
<b>Ginger Head</b>	<b>Was supposed to have knee replacement today, but has an open sore on the back of her calf &amp; it has to heal first, pray it heals quickly so she can have the surgery &amp; be ready for her next trip to MDA</b>

<b>Karla Teel (Donnie)</b>	Biopsy of knots on neck showed recurrence of lobular breast cancer, 2 malignant spots on chest wall; started another round of chemo the 19 <sup>th</sup> , 21 days of pills, then 7 days to get bloodwork (pre-surgery consults week of May 20 at MDA)
<b>Jim White</b>	Home from rehab, homebound, can't drive, appreciates the prayers

<b>Kathy Williams</b>	EAMC Sunday with severe pain, tests ruled out stones, treating for UTI, <b>scope, image &amp; a stent in urethra last Thursday, bladder was inflamed, kidney numbers going down, home Sunday</b>

<b>Tom &amp; Shelia Godfrey</b> 3/4/26	Duke Hospital NC Esophageal cancer metastasized to several places, almost done with last cancer treatment they can try, if scan shows no progress they will stop, there is currently not a chemical trial for his type of cancer, could not do immunotherapy; Shelia recovering from 3 <sup>rd</sup> eye surgery resulting from pressure washer injury

<b>Candi Johnson</b>	Colon cancer spread to liver, great report at MDA after chemo, 2 spots barely visible and the other one smaller, back to MDA 22 <sup>nd</sup> - 26 <sup>th</sup> , needle ablation of liver 24 <sup>th</sup> went well, were able to get to all 3 spots, <b>home from MDA, tough recovery, everything is painful</b> June C.
<b>Timothy Kanne (Leanna)</b>	Abdominal cancer stage 4, appendix burst & it was full of cancer, medical student at AU, has a 13-month-old baby, late 20's Ginger met on last trip to MDA; <b>doing great, got his placement in Minnesota - orthopedic oncology</b>
<b>Danny Lloyd (Danita)</b>	Donna Padgett's brother kidney removed due to 4-inch mass, stage 3 cancer, immunotherapy every 6 weeks until August, pray side effects are tolerable
<b>Nancy Lloyd</b>	Donna Padgett's Mother lung cancer (Dec.) Hospice, doing ok, getting over bronchitis, cold winter days are hard cause she can't get out, pray for Donna as caretaker

<b>Judy Morgan</b>	Heart attack, heart cath with 2 stents Thursday, home but passed out & hit head, so back to hospital, back home recovering Brenda Hughes
<b>DyWayne Nazworth</b>	Neurological problems, pray they can get a diagnosis Linda McGuirt
<b>Kay Nix</b>	Mantle cell lymphoma, cancer came back, doing well Holly
