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Geri Cochran	mass behind right eye is a tumor, does not want a biopsy, mass has grown since last MRI, affecting vision
Bob Daniel (Cheryl)	multiple myeloma; in remission, immune system low, so discouraged from going out
Heath Daniel	Heart issues, stable right now
Glen & Connie Elmore	Pray Glen continues to feel good as they wait for results; Glen – melanoma on his arm was stage 1 and they were able to get it all
Bill Francis	open heart surgery consisted of 2 bypasses & nothing done to the aorta, home recovering, more energy & less shortness of breath, doing better
Tom & Shelia Godfrey Marcia Ware	Duke Hospital NC Esophageal cancer metastasized to several places, scan after last round of chemo showed no change, doing 4 more chemo then another scan the end of May, still looking for a chemical trial for his type of cancer; Shelia still having issues after 3rd eye surgery resulting from pressure washer injury, needs to heal before a 4th surgery, hoping they can save some of her sight in that eye
Johnny & Sue Graham	Found a mass in his colon, surgery scheduled for May 11th @ Grandview , Sue's oncologist is considering a newer treatment or maybe more chemo
Mike Hammonds	Spinal stenosis, needs knee replacement; finally have some answers – severe left carotid stenosis, heart cath was good so can proceed with carotid artery surgery, blockage in artery is very high which makes surgery risky BUT without surgery the risk of a stroke is very high, surgery for carotid blockage caused by radiation & scar tissue last Friday went great, he is still weak from all the blood thinners & has to be careful about falling but he is doing great
Pete Harris	Hip pain caused by sciatica, got another shot, feeling some better, exercises seem to be helping, using a walker; follow-up with cancer doctor tomorrow, pray for a good report
Jan Holland	home with home health
Brenda Hughes	follow up with cardiologist, urologist scheduled, at-home rehab
Jerry Hughes	infection in hip, follow up once a month (Monday 11 th)
Amanda Motes	Surgery to remove kidney stones yesterday went well, has a stent for 5 days
Jimmy Peoples	recovering from knee replacement surgery, PT is rough, doing ok
Dan Robertson (Jennifer)	Injured shoulder, back & neck at work, shoulder surgery went well, spinal surgery went great, neck improving, 2 nd surgery to repair shoulder, recovery not going as well as expected, changed meds & PT at follow-up 3/16/26, extremely discouraged, pray for complete healing & pray for his employer to treat him right
Liz Stark	Emergency surgery for a perforated bowel, ICU, Baptist East. It has been rough but improving slowly, may have to go to a rehab facility when she leaves the hospital
Karla Teel (Donnie)	Biopsy of knots on neck showed recurrence of lobular breast cancer, 2 malignant spots on chest wall; blood work results allowed her to start back another 21 days of chemo pills last night (pre-surgery consults week of May 20 at MDA)
Jim White	Had some heart complications Monday night, transferred to St. Francis ICU Columbus, with limited visitors, Jennifer is staying with him; Hospice to keep him comfortable
Vicki Wilcox	EAMC Monday waiting for gall bladder surgery, slightly septic, so treating with antibiotic first, gall bladder surgery today, probably late afternoon
Rita Woodham	Knee replacement went well, PT is challenging, had a little infection at last follow-up but doctor pleased with movement

Greer Bailey	3-year-old leukemia, in remission; chemo pills, Children's 1-2 times a month, Jimmy Bailey, her grandfather is doing chemo for pancreatic cancer Ann A

Kenny Davis	Carol Turner's Brother was ready to return to work after open heart surgery, fell 13 feet off a ladder, broke neck & fractured spine in 2 places, neurosurgeon said no surgery needed, has to wear new brace another month then he can return to work
Shelby Deaton	Ann C's sister-in law cancer spread to bones, scan showed small benign nodule on the pituitary gland, will do another scan & probably remove; chemo Ann C.
Robert Eason Crystal Gullledge's Father 5/3/26	esophageal cancer metastasized to gastric cancer, last 5 PET scans showed no cancer, reduced immunotherapy to 1 a month with no chemo; PET scan a couple of weeks ago showed green highlights, which indicate inflammation or potentially something else, a scope showed a mass, a biopsy was done, waiting on results
Jaime Farmer	Something going on with left side, nerve tests showed no muscle or nerve damage, MRI next
Kris Eddins (Kelly) Betty H's SIL	Stage 4 melanoma lungs metastasized to brain, cancer-free from the neck down, still has one tiny spot on his brain; transferred Sunday to UAB Rm. 8512; giving large doses of seizure meds to try to control, does have a brain tumor in front & some swelling which is probably causing the seizures, don't think it was a stroke but have not ruled out 100%, can't do surgery but possibly targeted radiation
Shelia Fuller	Multiple Myeloma; cancer-free, back on maintenance meds Holly's SIL
Kristie Garduno	Recovering from mastectomy of other breast due to cancer Sue Weldon's daughter
Garner Graham (Patrick & Hollin)	new meds... some improvement but some permanent issues Graham's Grandson
Jerry Harvey	Brain tumor surgery, glioblastoma, terminal Nanci Speagle
Todd Holdridge	Recovering from surgery to fix aorta , still doesn't feel well & trouble sleeping, had to have the surgery but didn't realize the recovery would be this rough
Candi Johnson	Colon cancer spread to liver, after chemo 2 spots barely visible and one smaller, needle ablation of liver 24 th at MDA, were able to get to all 3 spots, home recovering June C.
Connie Jones	Broken bone not healing, referred to an orthopedic surgeon for reverse shoulder replacement, a muscle had wrapped around the head of the bone Gail Missildine
Timothy Kanne (Leanna)	Abdominal cancer stage 4, appendix burst & it was full of cancer, medical student at AU, has a 13-month-old baby, late 20's Ginger met on last trip to MDA; doing great, got his placement in Minnesota - orthopedic oncology
Danny Lloyd (Danita)	Donna Padgett's brother kidney removed due to 4-inch mass, stage 3 cancer, immunotherapy every 6 weeks until August, pray side effects are tolerable
Nancy Lloyd	Donna Padgett's Mother lung cancer (Dec.) Hospice, doing ok, getting over bronchitis, cold winter days are hard cause she can't get out, pray for Donna as caretaker
Brandon McGuirt	severe migraines
Rita McKelvey	Left hip replacement May 11th, pray it will give her some relief
E.L. Moncrief	Stage 3 lung cancer & stage 3 kidney failure Ronda Jennings' Uncle

Casey Turner	rare cancer located in sweat gland in breast, removed mass & 1 lymph node, lymph node was benign, stomach biopsy was benign, started radiation
Chase & Kendall Turner	Baby Catherine , born March 26, 2024, still in hospital; lungs not completely developed so prone to infection; has tracheotomy, parents are training how to take care of her hoping she can go home soon, just turned 2; home Monday afternoon after a little over 2 years in the hospital, 3 nurses have volunteered to help them, please pray the transition goes smoothly Kile's friend
