Call our homebound members, nursing home residents, and those in the hospital. Send cards. Stay involved in ministry and make sure that people know that God loves them. And remember this: your lost friends and neighbors are scared to death. I know because we've already had opportunities to try to help some deal with their fear. Remind them that God is in control, and show them the**

**peace of mind you have because you know  
Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior.**
